



Spring Vegetable Lasagna

' R R R R R R R R R R R R R R

Ingredients

- 1 tablespoon unsalted butter, plus more for the pan
- $2\frac{1}{2}$ cups low-sodium vegetable or chicken broth
- $1\frac{1}{2}$ cups mascarpone cheese
- 1 teaspoon chopped fresh thyme
- ½ teaspoon chopped fresh oregano
- 1 ¹/₄ teaspoons kosher salt
- 8 cups tightly packed fresh spinach leaves (about 10 ounces)
- 9 ounces no-boil lasagna noodles
- 3 cups thinly sliced carrots, turnips and/or radishes
- 8 ounces crumbled farmer's cheese

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F. Coat a 9-by-13-inch baking dish with butter.
- 2. Whisk broth and mascarpone in a medium saucepan over medium-low heat until smooth, about 5 minutes. Add thyme, oregano and salt; remove from heat.
- 3. Heat the remaining 1 tablespoon butter in a large skillet over medium heat. Add spinach and cook, stirring, until wilted, 2 to 3 minutes. Remove from heat.
- 4. Arrange 4 noodles in the prepared baking dish, slightly overlapping. Top with 1/4 cup I of the spinach and 3/4 cup vegetables. Pour on 1 cup of the mascarpone mixture and top with 1/3 cup farmer's cheese. Repeat to make 4 layers. Cover with a piece of foil coated with cooking spray.
- 5. Bake the lasagna for 25 minutes. Uncover and bake until the edges start to crisp, about 15 minutes more. Let stand for 10 minutes before serving.

Strawberry Cobbler

Ingredients

- $\frac{1}{4}$ cup cornstarch
- ¹/₂ cup sugar, plus 3 tablespoons, divided
- ³/₄ teaspoon salt, divided
- 4 pounds fresh strawberries, hulled and halved (about 9 cups)
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1 cup whole-wheat pastry flour
- 1 tablespoon baking powder
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup whole milk
- ¹/₄ cup unsalted butter, melted

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Coat a 9-by-13-inch baking dish lightly with cooking spray. Whisk cornstarch, 1/2 cup sugar and 1/4 teaspoon salt in a large bowl. Add strawberries and vanilla; stir until thoroughly coated. Spoon the mixture into the prepared dish. Bake for 15 minutes.
- 2. Meanwhile, whisk all-purpose flour, pastry flour, baking powder and the remaining 3 tablespoons sugar and 1/2 teaspoon salt in a medium bowl. Add milk and melted butter; stir until well combined.
- 3. Remove the strawberry mixture from the oven. Drop 12 rounded spoonful's (about 2 tablespoons each) of batter evenly over the mixture. Bake until the biscuits are golden brown and the strawberry mixture is bubbly, about 35 minutes Let cool for 20 minutes before serving.






