 - Plastic** – should be labeled on the container #'s 1-7, should be **cleaned out and lids and labels can stay on.** If your plastic bottles are not cleaned out they are rejected from the recycling process.
 - Cardboard** – first and foremost make sure you break up any boxes you place in our “blue” dumpsters. Do not put boxes with plastic liners or waxy coatings in the recycling dumpster.
 - Paper** – mixed papers including junk mail, magazines, paperboard like shoe boxes. No shredded, waxy or metallic papers.
 - Glass** – colored bottles and jars that **have been cleaned without lids or caps.**
 - No Bags, Clothes, Styrofoam or Yard Waste.**

Lincolnshire Estates Water Shutoffs

Those of us that have lived here in Lincolnshire for a time, are aware there are usually about 6-10 water shutoffs each year. It is something that we have learned to accept due to accidents, frailty of the water lines, etc. The shutoffs can be for Potable water (drinking water) or Non-Potable water (outside spicket behind your home), or both.



Managers use multiple means to notify us as soon as possible. Sometimes it is through emails, block captains, Facebook, etc. There are times we have advance warning and times we do not get notified in advance because of emergency situations. Please be aware that all repairs or maintenance **cannot be given an exact period of time for the outage.**

If you get a notification with a “shutoff” time please do not wait till the last minute to throw in a load of wash or hop in the shower. The Park Manager cannot control when the outside vendor will arrive on site for the repair. When it comes to **potable water**, it would be wise to always have a few gallon water jugs ready in your home available for use, especially for your toilets and urgent needs like taking medicine. Plan ahead, if you can.

If you have a neighbor, you know of that is not “connected” to automatic notifications such as e-mails or Facebook give them a call or knock on their door to make sure they know about the water shutoff.

Words of wisdom we received from a community resident when we first moved into Lincolnshire. You can also turn your water shut off valve OFF (outside water meter) after the park shuts main valve off. This is good idea because when water pressure has been reinstated, the water pressure to your home **MAY** do some damage to your home plumbing or appliances. After the Park has reinstated the main lines, turn your water valve on slowly in graduated turns to reinstate the water to your home.

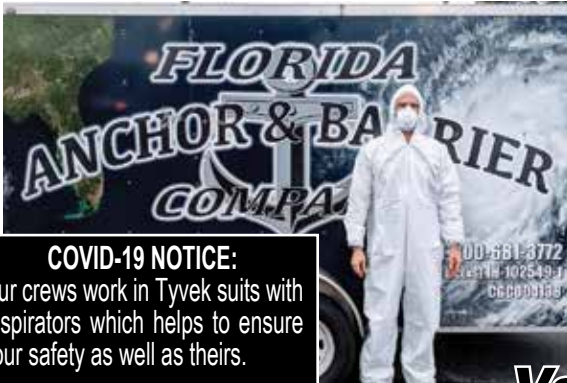

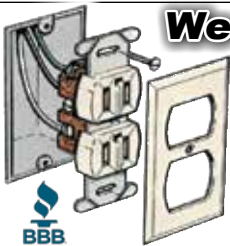

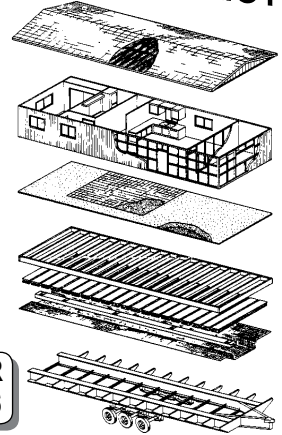

What's New and What to Know for May 2024 News and Updates:

- ❖ 2024 LHOA Membership Dues: LHOA representatives are still accepting renewal dues and new Members. The yearly dues are \$15. LHOA is a Florida non-profit corporation and is tenant homeowner centered.
 - ✓ Payment can be by check (please make out to LHOA) or cash to the following HOA Officers: Jane Johnson (President) Lot 1215, Renee Culp (Treasurer) Lot 1506 and Jody Brown (Secretary) Lot 620. And the weekly Wednesday clubhouse coffee meetings.
- ❖ Lincolnshire Estates is eligible for the coach tie down program (updated anchoring of the coach to the ground) through Gulf Coast State College (Panama City, FL.). There are other Florida parks who are in front of us. There is no cost for homeowners. This is a grant program and beneficial to all homeowners. LHOA does not currently have a timetable. As we get closer to a start date there will be further communication by letter to all homeowners.
- ❖ LHOA Board of Director meetings are on the 2nd Sunday of each month. Agendas are posted on the LHOA bulletin board in the post office box/laundry building.

Silver Star Awarded to Army Ranger Who Came to Aid of Fellow Troops During Battle of Mogadishu:

A true Hero finally gets his award! More than three decades after his actions during the infamous Battle of Mogadishu, retired Army Maj. Larry Moores has been awarded the Silver Star, the nation's third-highest award for acts of valor. Moores was presented with the medal in a ceremony March 25 for his role in the fight as a young Army Ranger with 3rd Battalion, 75th Ranger Regiment, which included coming to the aid of other troops who were pinned down while under fire. "Mr. Moores, I personally salute you for your tenacity, your toughness in a crucible combat, and your commitment to our Army, and your fellow soldiers," Gen. Gary Brito, commanding general of U.S. Army Training and Doctrine Command, said while presenting the award. "Your actions in Somalia were for them, your brothers in arms, and are a living tribute to the Ranger Creed, which I know that you hold dearly."

Immortalized by the 2001 blockbuster movie "Black Hawk Down," the real battle between U.S. troops and Somali militiamen occurred from Oct. 3 to Oct. 4, 1993. Moores was assigned to Task Force Ranger, which had been deployed that summer to capture Somali warlord Mohamed Farrah Aidid and included Rangers, special operations troops and aviators. What started as an overnight firefight between militiamen and U.S. forces quickly went south when two U.S. Black Hawk helicopters were shot down while conducting a raid aimed at capturing two of Farrah Aidid's lieutenants.

According to retired Army Col. Larry Perino, a fellow Ranger platoon leader who served alongside Moores during the battle, Moores played an active role in saving other service members' lives that night. "Larry deserves it because he chose to go back to that street to try and break us out," Perino said at the ceremony, according to a statement from the Army. "Despite going out there and getting riddled with bullets time and time again and losing Rangers, he had the intestinal fortitude to lead his men to help us." Moores recalled the battle at the ceremony, saying, "We lost 18 soldiers in battle and had more than 70 Rangers wounded. That was a tough experience because we were overwhelmed, with the odds against us. But it was amazing to watch the young Rangers still executed under very difficult circumstances."

For his service, Moores was inducted as a distinguished member of the 75th Ranger Regiment in 2005 and into the U.S. Army Ranger Hall of Fame in 2017. In 2021, the Army upgraded 60 awards for troops injured and killed in the battle, including 58 Silver Stars and two Distinguished Flying Crosses for heroism displayed during "aerial flight." Sgt. 1st Class Randall Shughart and Master Sgt. Gary Gordon, both Delta operators, were posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor for attempting to protect one of the downed Black Hawk pilots, Chief Warrant Officer Michael Durant, as Somalis closed in around them.

Although more than 30 years has passed since the infamous battle, the U.S. has maintained a tumultuous presence in Somalia. Between 2019 and 2021, the U.S. drew back its physical presence in the African country. The following year, then-U.S. Africa Command commanding officer Gen. Stephen Townsend told lawmakers that the drawdown was a mistake, citing the need for a continued counterterrorism force, which the U.S. maintains to this day.

"In East Africa, al-Qaida's al-Shabab remains the greatest threat to U.S. persons and interests in the region as well as the homeland, while undermining peace, security and political progress in Somalia," Townsend told the Senate Armed Services Committee in a 2022 hearing. "If left unchecked, al-Shabab will soon expand beyond Somalia's borders and become an even greater threat to regional stability and American interests."

Most recently, Rep. Matt Gaetz, R-Fla., introduced a resolution in April 2023 to the House floor that would have required the U.S. withdraw entirely from its counterterrorism efforts in Somalia. The resolution was shot down in a 102-321 vote. Just shy of five hundred troops -- mostly special operations personnel -- made up the U.S. military's remaining presence in Somalia as of June 2023.

Very soon the 2024 hurricane and severe storm season will begin for us. Starting sooner and ending a bit longer in the fall. Ignoring either will not make this yearly weather go away or consequences either. Most find their roots in West Africa in late August through October. For year-rounders like me (there are more now in the park) this is our storm and wet season. We want the rain though not always how it finds us. Let the storms find us prepared.

Without being specific to any chronic condition let us say that you must have certain medications, oxygen, nursing services, dialysis, just had major surgery, batteries for equipment vital to your survival that require replenishment within 14 days. Why 14 days? In a major weather event or disaster, the supply of what you absolutely need to live is not around the corner anymore, plus the supply lines to vendors, pharmacies, hospitals, clinics, home health can be threatened. They just do not carry extra inventory on the shelves. We live in a new supply world where large expensive reserves of everything are no longer close to us. Dependence on USPS, UPS and FedEx is pervasive and not always able to respond quickly. We are fortunate in we live in a location where supplies most seniors need is more plentiful but not endless. Being a global economy, our medical supplies still and often come from outside the U.S! Especially generics.

As an RN in Florida's Disaster response team, we start with preparing **TODAY!** Preparing is not as hard as we think. Take it one step at a time. Starting now means you will not rush and forget something vital.

- The first is life sustaining equipment. Oxygen and the equipment required to deliver is #1. Find an invoice from the vendor who brings the oxygen and maintains the devices. Put the invoice in an envelope that you will fill in with other information. Take a picture with your phone too. If you have large oxygen canisters, they will be hard to transport. Oxygen concentrators can be heavy though newer versions are much lighter. You cannot expect every shelter will have unlimited oxygen available. If any.
 - ***Always register early with the shelters.** Also shelters may not have consistent electricity to power equipment. If your equipment has rechargeable batteries, then keep them charged! **The Pinellas County Disaster management can help you know** where the best shelters are for you! Staying at home may not be an option and can be deadly. Mandatory evacuations mean emergency services have shutdown. The police will drive through our park numerous times and tell us still here that we are now on our own.
- ✓ The second is medications. If you do not have a current list of your medications, then you can write down your own or better have your pharmacy print your list.
 - Medication organizers can be helpful. However, the downside is that someone else has no idea what each pill is. Believe me. So, keep at least one pill in their original container from the pharmacy with you. Do not ever wait until the last minute to have your medications, including syringes refilled. Remember, shelters do not have pharmacies.
 - Get a plastic container with a locking lid to store all your medications. Put your full name on the container. Got a pet on meds? Do the same! More pets are diabetic now than ever.
- ✓ Often liquid medications require refrigeration. Keep one Styrofoam container. Put your name on it. Do not toss the ice bag either.

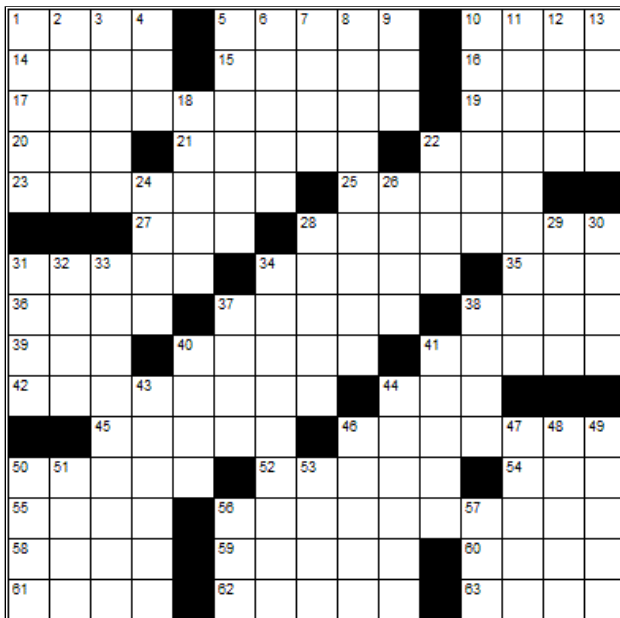
