














# RECOGNIZING VOLUNTEERS PALM HILLERS STEP UP TO THE PLATE FOR FOOD DRIVE

# COMMUNICATIONS: How to Get to Know Palm Hill and Keep Up To Date on News, Fun and Park Business

iewing the Palm Hill website is a great way to familiarize yourself with Palm Hill – palmhillcountryclub.net.

**Communications starts at Orientation,** meetings with the Real Estate Committee members who are a welcome wagon for new residents. Great information is given out.

**Email web blasts** will go out from the Webmaster and/or Megan DiBello, Palm Hill Park Manager to the emails provided by residents. These are blasts with critical announcements and important information.

**Channel 732** on your television also provides a great music track and a multitude of slides in a PowerPoint with timely information about events and Palm Hill.

The LINK is a monthly Palm Hill magazine that is delivered to your door. It is also on the Palm Hill website with editions back to 2014.

The Palm Hill website – **palmhillcountryclub.net** – is an invaluable source of information including all business and governance information. Photo Albums on the site feature residents enjoying all the events ats Palm Hill. Rules and Regulations, Board and Committee minutes and videos, a member directory, and other governance documents and history is also on the website.

**Coffees with announcements are held weekly at** both the North and South Clubhouses. Bulletin boards also showcase posted information in both clubhouses.

**Videos of Board of Directors and Committee meetings** are available on the Palm Hill website for about a month after the meetings. Attendance is available through ZOOM, in person or by watching live on Ch. 732.

# **RENTERS – WEB BLASTS and WEB ACCESS**

Renters can receive Park web blasts from the Office and the Webmaster, but must contact the Webmaster when they arrive and send their name, email address, Palm Hill address, and the day they will be leaving Palm Hill. The Office does not forward the renters' info to the Webmaster for this purpose.

Renters may also request limited access to the website.

Previous renters still receiving Palm Hill blasts may contact the webmaster to end the blasts. Renters may email the webmaster at palmhill.webmaster1@gmail.com.

Parts of the website are open to the public. That includes the Real Estate For Sale and Rent sections – both accessible from the Home Page. Another location to access information is from the drop down "About" on the Home Page. ABOUT and other categories of information are at the top of the website, in the black bar across the top.

#### PALM HILL RULES AND REGULATIONS, SECTION 6 – Q:

Use of Sanitation Area: The sanitation area is available for the purpose of material handling of recyclables, non-recyclables, vegetation, and construction materials.

The use of the construction bin shall be used strictly for the purposes of construction material and household items such as furniture. Renovation debris, such as kitchen cupboards, shall be broken down as to minimize the volume required of the construction bin. Electronics, tires, paints, oil, metals including aluminum, and hazardous materials are not permitted. Items that can be recycled should be separated and placed by the appropriate refuse or recycle bin. Recycled items are not to be taken/removed by a resident or individual. No dumping of construction material or refuse directly on the ground is permitted under any circumstance(s).

Should the construction bin be filled, the office shall be notified, and appropriate arrangements made for disposal.

Should such abuse of the sanitation area occur, the cost of such cleanup will be borne by the resident and may include suspension of access and associated fining. Sanitation facilities are restricted to Palm Hill homes only. All others, including commercial use by contractors, individuals outside the corporation, will be considered unauthorized and trespassing.


