Did You Know? – The Story Behind Independence Day

Every year on July 4th, Americans celebrate Independence Day with fireworks, parades, cookouts, and family gatherings. But did you know the actual vote for independence took place on July 2, 1776? The Declaration of Independence was officially adopted two days later, on July 4th, which became the date we celebrate today.

The Declaration announced that the 13 American colonies were free from British rule and would become the United States of America. Written primarily by Thomas Jefferson, the document emphasized liberty, equality, and the right to self-government.

Another fun fact: three U.S. Presidents — Thomas Jefferson, John Adams, and James Monroe — all passed away on July 4th. Jefferson and Adams even died on the same day in 1826, exactly 50 years after the Declaration was adopted.

Today, Independence Day remains a time to celebrate freedom, honor our nation's history, and enjoy time together with family, friends, and neighbors.

July 4, 2026 also marks our 250th Anniversary.

PLEASE TAKE CARE WHEN DRIVING AROUND PALM HILL

SPEED LIMIT IS 15 MILES-PER-HOUR; STOP AT STOP SIGNS

Watch speed especially as you get close to the Park's exits/entrances or go around vehicles parked on streets.

Neighbors chatting, pets on a stroll with their humans, people walking or bicycling, golf carts or cars parked in the street or pulling out of driveways and delivery vehicles all may be on the streets while you are traveling around the Park.

People are bicycling, walking/running for exercise and just meandering around Palm Hill.

Please be cautious and take care.

Effective April 1, overnight street parking is prohibited from 1:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. per article X(D) of Rules & Regulations. In addition, vehicles may not park in front of their house. Overnight parking is permissible at overflow spaces and clubhouses. Vehicles parked at the North Club House must be removed by 7:00 am on Mondays. Vehicles may be towed at owners' risk and expense(s). This rule is in effect to allow emergency vehicles to reach a home needing immediate attention without being blocked.

MESSAGE FROM BOARD PRESIDENT HENRY KLAIN

President's Message – Solar Panel Project Update



I am pleased to share that the solar panel installation project on both recreational buildings is nearing completion. Final inspections by Duke Energy are expected shortly, after which both systems will be brought online and begin generating power for our cooperative

This has been a long and detailed project involving many stages, including governance review, technical specifications, vendor selection, contract evaluation, permitting, installation, and the required inspections. I would like to thank everyone involved for their time, effort, and patience throughout this process.

I would also like to extend sincere thanks to our hard-working committees and their volunteers, whose dedication and countless hours of effort helped move this project forward. In addition, the continued support of our shareholders has been instrumental in accomplishing this vision for Palm Hill

The new solar systems represent an important investment in Palm Hill's future. In addition to providing environmentally friendly energy generation, the project is expected to provide meaningful cost relief through reduced electrical expenses for the next 25-30 years. Based on current projections, the anticipated payback period for the investment is approximately 6 to 7 years. With utility costs continuing to rise annually, it is possible that the actual payback period could be even shorter.

This project reflects our continued commitment to responsible planning, long-term financial stewardship, and exploring opportunities that benefit our community.

UPDATE ON RESOURCE PROPERTY MANAGEMENT

Fellow Shareholders, Following the Property Management Research Team's completion of its information gathering and analysis, and the subsequent town hall presentation in December, the Board of Directors (BOD) determined it was important to obtain direct feedback from the community regarding both the findings and the potential path forward for Palm Hill.

This outreach generated more than 200 responses, reflecting a broad range of perspectives—from concerns to positive feedback, and everything in between. Upon review, several key themes emerged.

There was a clear preference for maintaining a full-service management model, with limited support for either self-management or a hybrid approach. Additionally, the number of homeowners advocating for a change in property management companies was approximately equal to those who preferred to retain our current provider, subject to meaningful improvements. The Board itself found its views similarly divided.

In light of this, and in recognition of the long-standing relationship with our current management company, the BOD elected to focus on strengthening and improving the existing partnership with Resource Property Management (RPM), contingent upon addressing the concerns that led to the original research initiative.



As a next step, members of the Board developed a comprehensive deficiencies report identifying 30 specific items requiring attention. This report was formally submitted to RPM on February 6, 2026.

An in-person meeting between BOD Officers and RPM leadership was held on February 23, 2026, to review these concerns. RPM subsequently provided a detailed corrective action matrix on March 4, 2026, outlining each issue along with proposed solutions. These actions include improvements to response times, process enhancements, reassignment of certain responsibilities, additional training, and staffing adjustments.

A follow-up in-person meeting was held on March 31, 2026, to assess progress. Several items have been resolved, while others remain in progress. This is an ongoing effort that will continue to be closely monitored in the coming months. RPM has expressed a strong commitment to delivering meaningful improvements, and the BOD will continue working collaboratively with them to achieve the desired outcomes for Palm Hill.

A further evaluation, including consideration of alternative management options if called for, will take place later this year.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS – BUDGET AND MONTHLY HOMEOWNER FEE – 2026-2027

\$ 595 is the approved monthly fee shareholders must pay April 1, 2026 through March 31, 2027.

The Board approved an annual budget of \$8,037,785.

Palm Hill's income covering expenses comes from the monthly shareholders' fees, Golf Course income, Storage Lot rentals, and other income – including interest on accounts and late fees.

Details of the budget were mailed to all shareholders.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS – MEETING SCHEDULE AND KEY DATES

Regular Board meetings are usually scheduled for the last Wednesday of the month at 1 p.m. and held by ZOOM and in person in one of the Rec Halls (as well as on the Community TV Channel. Agendas are posted on bulletin boards in the Rec Halls and sent out via web blast prior to the meetings.

Any changes on time or dates (especially in the case of holidays) will be announced via web blast, ZOOM and on Ch. 732 or the new Community Channel.

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ONGOING STRATEGIC FUTURE PLANNING INITIATIVE

VIDEO ON WEBSITE: POSSIBLE PURCHASE OF PALM HILL FROM THE TAYLOR FAMILY

A video is now posted on the Palm Hill website explaining potential financial scenarios if the shareholders were to offer to purchase Palm Hill from the Taylor Family. The video was shot February 22 at a Town Hall presentation by Dave Kohli, Finance Committee Co-Chair. A question and answer (Q and A) session with members of the audience is part of the video. Two more informational sessions occurred.

The possibility of the purchase was cited in the Carbon Design and Architecture consultant report about the future of Palm Hill. Planning and Environmental Committee Co-Chair Mike Leahy sent out a web blast reporting that Dave will work with and report to his committee, and that the community will be kept informed and engaged throughout the evaluation process. Information will be shared through Town Halls, web blasts and communications from the Planning and Environmental Committee.

RULES REMINDERS AND ADVICE

- Any work that is visible on the outside of your home **MUST** have an exterior architectural request submitted and approved prior to completing the work. There is a 30-day window to review and approve these applications so please ensure you are submitting them with enough time to allow for the review process.
- A reminder that homeowners should be parking primarily in their driveway. Parking spaces in the community are limited and are to be used only after driveway spaces have been utilized. Rule section X., subsection H. “Residents shall park their own vehicles

on their own unit and shall not park the same on the streets overnight. In the event all parking spaces are occupied on one’s unit, then visitors, guests or residents are allowed to park in the guest parking area or clubhouse parking lot...” Rule section VI., subsection I.: “Because of limited parking in the park, a unit carport must be used such that it always allows space to park at least one automobile passenger vehicle.”

- Please remember that if you are renting your home, you must have your tenants complete an application with the Association and be approved prior to moving in. Rentals have a minimum timeframe of 3 months.
- If you witness a crime, please contact the Largo Police Department. Staff are not trained to handle criminal matters. The non-emergency number for Largo PD is 727-587-6730.
- When you sell your home, you will need to cancel your ACH at the time of closing. ACH is not cancelled otherwise until the paperwork is processed which may not occur until after another payment is pulled. Additionally, please make sure that you are transferring your mailbox keys and fobs to new homeowners.

RECYCLING VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

First things first—a big thank you to everyone who has been doing their parts to recycle! It truly makes a difference, and it shows that this community knows how to take care of its home (and the planet) with style.

Now, if you’ve ever thought, “I’d love to help, but I’m not sure how,” here’s your moment: If you would like to volunteer to help with sorting, please reach out to Elroy (574 -971-6769). It’s a great way to meet neighbors and finally settle the age-old debate: *Is that recyclable, or just wishful thinking?*

A few friendly reminders to keep things running smoothly:

- Pizza boxes may bring us joy, but grease does not bring them into the recycling bin. If there’s **any grease at all**, the Pinellas Recycling Center says it’s a no-go.
- Jars and cans need a quick rinse before recycling—especially peanut butter and mayo jars (we see you). If you’d rather save water, no problem—just toss them in the trash instead of recycling.
- Paper products that have touched food, liquids, or... anything else (yes, even *that*) cannot be recycled. If it’s been in close contact with your lunch—or your sinuses—it belongs in the trash.
- Please separate **aluminum cans** from other recyclables. Tin cans can go in regular recycling, but aluminum gets special treatment.
- And here’s a fun one: the community actually makes money from **wires, cables, and cords**. Drop them on the back table in the sanitation field—those funds go right back into events and maintenance around the park. Your old charger could help fund your next social!

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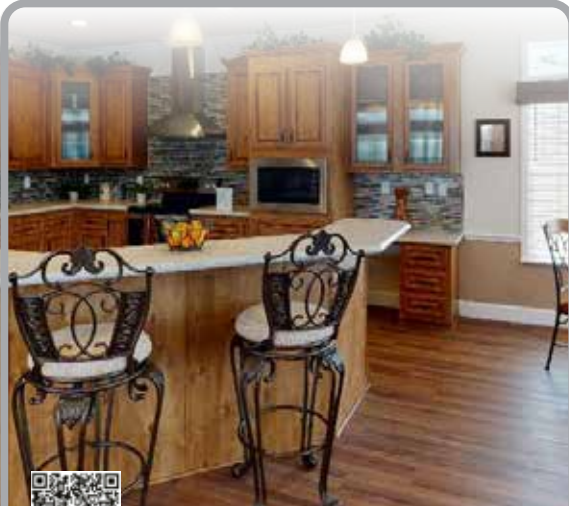
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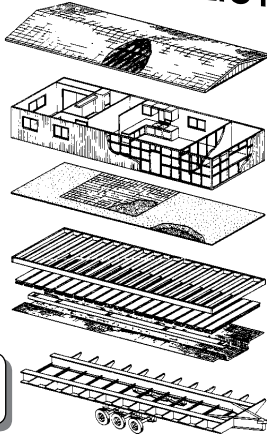

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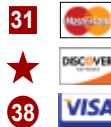

You can receive free alerts about emergencies and other important community news by signing up for ALERT PINELLAS? (<https://pinellas.gov/alert-pinellas/>) Alert Pinellas is an emergency notification service for Pinellas County, local municipalities and the Sheriff's Office that allows you to receive urgent messages about a variety of situations, such as severe weather, flooding events or evacuations.

- When you sign up, you choose how to receive alerts. This could be a cell phone, landline, text or email. You can enter multiple methods.
- Enter the location that you want to receive alerts about. You can choose up to five different locations. This way, you can be alerted if there is something you need to know about in your neighborhood, job, children's school, etc.
- This system is shared by partner agencies throughout the county, so you only have to sign up once.
- Once you create your own account, you can change your settings any time.
- It's easy to sign up for this FREE service.

VOLUNTEERS WILL HELP TEST TOILETS

From Chuck Silcox, Board Member

Water and sewer bills cost \$25 per every 1,000 gals of water. Toilets provide a way to reduce Palm Hill water costs. When a toilet or faucet etc. is changed, there are where options to purchase devices that use less water.

The Palm Hill Board of Directors has agreed to pay to repair the toilets that are wasting water. The cost to repair one toilet is about \$15. In four months, we will save \$300 on water and sewer expenses for the one toilet. Since that toilet should not leak for the next five years, that would be an additional \$300 in savings every four months for five years – **a savings of \$4,500** for that one leaking toilet.

Dye tablets are distributed regularly and are available at the Office. The dye tablet test shows your toilet is leaking water, go to the Palm Hill Office and fill out a consent form with your contact info so a volunteer can call and come by to make the repair.

When the volunteer comes to make the repair, he will retest the toilet and if it needs repair, he will repair it. He is instructed not to spend time and money repairing toilets that are not leaking.

If for some reason you can't test your toilet, volunteers are available to perform the test. Just call the OFFICE (727-581-8729) and ask to put your name on the list for a toilet test.

SANITATION FIELD

PALM HILL RULES AND REGULATIONS, SECTION 6 – Q:

Use of Sanitation Area: The sanitation area is available for the purpose of handling of recyclables, non-recyclables, vegetation, and construction materials.

The use of the construction bin shall be used strictly for the purposes of construction material and household items such as furniture. Renovation debris, such as kitchen cupboards, shall be broken down as to minimize the volume required of the construction bin. Electronics, tires, paints, oil, metals including aluminum, and hazardous materials are not permitted. Items that can be recycled should be separated and placed by the appropriate refuse or recycle bin. Recycled items are not to be taken/removed by a resident or individual. No dumping of construction material or refuse directly on the ground is permitted under any circumstance(s).

Should the construction bin be filled, the office should be notified, and appropriate arrangements made for disposal.

Should such abuse of the sanitation area occur, the cost of such cleanup will be borne by the resident and may include suspension of access and associated fining. Sanitation facilities are restricted to Palm Hill homes only. All others, including commercial use by contractors, individuals outside the corporation, will be considered unauthorized and trespassing.
