PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Our 2026 team of board of directors and committee volunteers is now in place, and meeting regularly to carry out the business of the association. A total of 11 volunteers have stepped up to serve across five different committees, some on multiple committees. This does not count all the volunteers working with the Social Committee across the many activities we have here at Sunset Palms.

The Walmart gate project is now complete and should be operational by mid-March. Final wiring to establish Duke Energy connectivity has taken place. The office and the board are aware of the challenges any electronic gate has and by the time you read this, a special communication will have been sent regarding how this gate works and helps to keep us safer, while allowing the access we need for ourselves, Golden Gate, and other special situations.

An analysis of the condition of our roads is in process with a study of the asphalt thickness in hand at the time of this writing and core samples approved by the board that will show us the condition of our road base. Once we have all that in hand, we will compare that information with the terms of our contract with our road contractor, ACPLM, and see what options we have to insure we get the life we expected from this multi-million-dollar asset.

Another project in flight at the time of this writing is the front lift station redesign, where we have additional quotes coming in and should be able to award a contract within the next month or so. This redesign will make our front lift station much more reliable, safer, and easier to reach and repair the pumps when necessary.

Other projects mentioned last month, shuffleboard window repair, and final work on the front generator by the clubhouse are now complete.

On Friday, March 6, the Governing Documents Review committee, under the leadership of Jan McCoy and Maggie Stokes, met for the first time. Jan provided an overview of the documents that regulate our association:

1. Those we control (our Prospectus consisting of our Articles of Incorporation, Master Form Proprietary Lease, By Laws, Rules & Regulations, etc.), and
2. Those imposed from the outside; Federal Laws, Florida State laws (specifically FL Statute chapters 617 Corporations Not-For Profit, 719 Cooperatives, 723 Mobile Home Park Tenancies and the FL Administrative Code).

Spring is finally upon us and hopefully the cold weather goes back north. It will be nice to see all the flowers and trees in bloom.

Dog owners, while you have permission to have a dog on property, it is your responsibility to pick up after your dog. You agreed to this when you signed your Emotional Support Animal (ESA) paperwork. When walking your dog, please be respectful of other homes and sitting areas. Don't let your dog do their business in someone else's yard or on their planter. Don't let them go around the sitting benches throughout the property. If you're enjoying the bench and your dog does relieve itself, pick it up. Dogs are NOT allowed to be off leash at any time, and they certainly aren't allowed to be running loose by the lake. REMINDER: ALL potted plants, yard art and loose items must be stored inside prior to leaving. These items can become projectiles in a storm.

THOUGHT FOR THE MONTH

... so you will not grieve like people who have no hope.

Most recently I have been officiating "Celebrations of Life" often. I tell people that officiating "funerals" has been one of my special parts of ministry. You may ask why. Personal experiences and mostly the reality of death is when most people become sober about life. Last Saturday I officiated for two families. One of those was one of our special residents, Pat Schwan whose daughter, Laura, set up an absolutely beautiful setting of refreshments for a fellowship time. During this celebration there were several tributes which are the best part of every memorial and one spontaneous song by Phyllis MacEachern. These



are favorite gatherings which remind me that we do not grieve like people who have no hope. Later on Saturday, Peggiann, a mother said goodbye to her 34-year-old son, Matthew. You might imagine that there was a very large number of young friends who gathered. The wonderful thing about this experience was the impact of Matthew's life, even though he suffered in life, he wanted to follow Jesus in the midst of the addiction. I heard several share spontaneous tributes and memories saying, "He literally saved my life at my lowest". Another said, "He talked me into going to treatment when I was done". And another who said, "We would read the Bible every morning". I had leaned into Matthew's life. I had hope that he would have greater influence. And yet in his death, I told his mother that he did not die in vain. If you had been with us, you would have been amazed at the LIFE we experienced. Tributes and memories reminded me of the HOPE we have. We grieve differently as we know what Jesus said to His disciples before He died, "I'm going to prepare a place for you."

We have something to look forward to. The grave does not have the last word. I've officiated at funerals where people had no hope. The difference is dramatic and drastic. There is a great divide between those who have hope and those without hope.

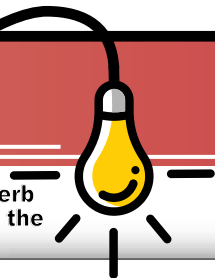
I've been privileged to help people in the process. Grief is real. It can be quite heavy. At the same time there is real HELP and a real HELPER. This is the real blessing in my life. I'm not a Bible thumper. I'm not a "label" promoter. I'm simply a God guy. There are people who need and desire meaning in life. Death and dying is a subject for us to consider before it happens. We need conversations with our loved ones. We need to open our hearts to each other.

This thought for the month is sobering and yet it comes from experience that all of us have had. May this be helpful for you. And if you would desire to have a conversation, just know let's talk over a cup of coffee.

I trust you are someone who knows this HOPE.
God bless you all. Remember I welcome a conversation.

LIFT STATION MONTHLY REMINDER - IMPORTANT

Submitted from the Management

URGENT ACTION REQUESTED - FLUSH TOILET PAPER ONLY

Our system is being clogged because people are flushing wipes down their toilets. The product packaging states the wipes are flushable, but they are not septic safe. They are clogging our system and will burn out our pumps.

LIFT STATION – PLEASE remember that the only thing that goes into your toilets is toilet paper. When checking on the lift station recently, maintenance found a “Potpourri” bottle floating. This type of thing CANNOT be put down the toilet. It can do major damage to the pumps and pipes of the system which can be expensive to repair.

PLEASE ALSO INFORM YOUR SUBLETTERS OF THIS LIMITATION!

When we flush, the waste goes into a **holding tank** that has two pumps to expel the waste **UP and OUT** into the Pinellas Park sewage system. When any of the above gets flushed, it clogs the pump, overheats it and burns out the motor.

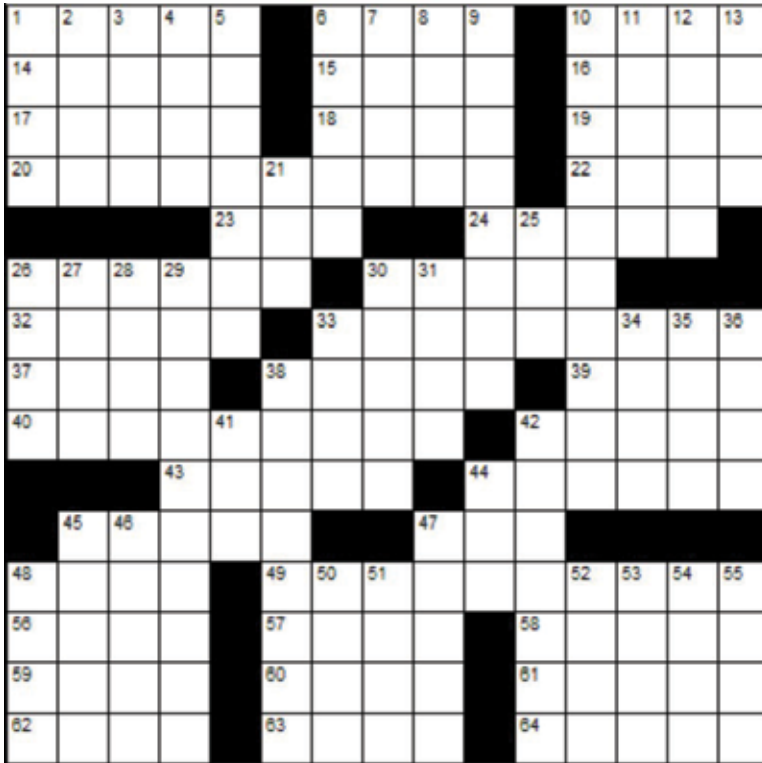
