While backing out of your driveway, please stop and look before entering the street. There have been close calls with residents backing out and not looking.

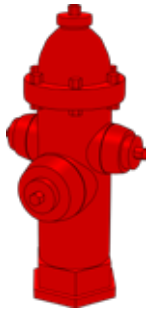
We strongly urge residents to obey the one-way arrows. We have seen many instances where someone has almost gotten hit because of someone going against the arrows.

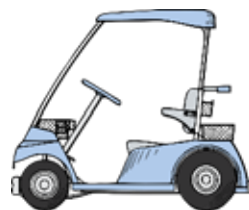
The Hot Tub is for Adults Only

Don't be afraid to ask for help

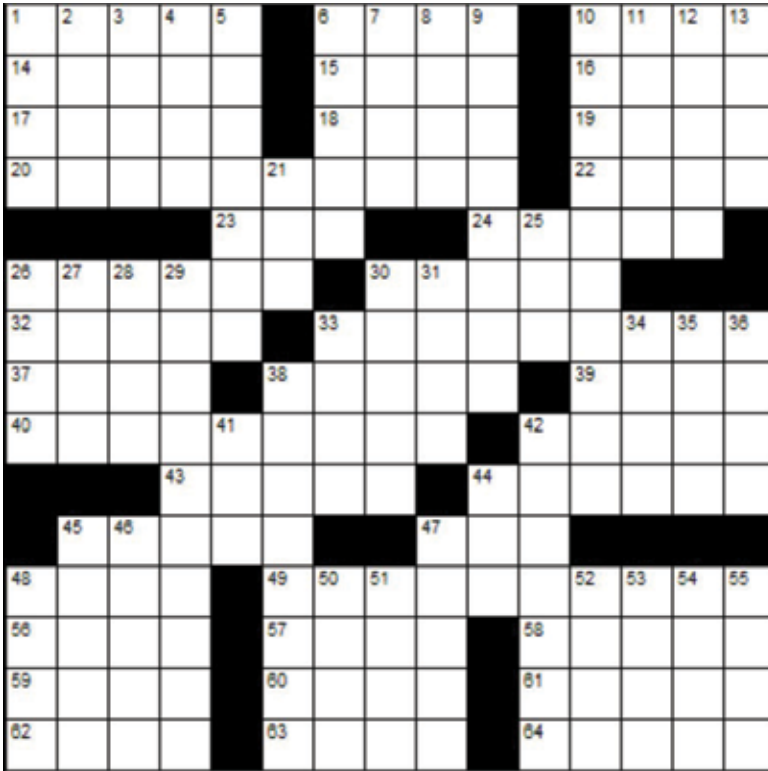

Make sure your dog, cat, or other animal friend always wears a current identification tag. Pet supply catalogs, stores, veterinary offices, and animal shelters often have forms to order ID tags.
