It has been another busy year and some of our family and friends are once again flying North for the season. There have been many changes since last year, including the long-awaited Traffic Light that was finally installed and now this benefit, to our community, is now being enjoyed by all of us and our guests. The on-site realty office has recently closed and the Co-Op office has moved to a proper location at lot 1 and it has been setup to service the Paradise Island community now and into the future. The Co-Op, Social Committee, HOA and the Church in the Park have all been working hard together to promote the enjoyment of the community, please take the time to enjoy and support the offerings. Get involved, volunteers are always needed and it makes all this possible. The revitalized of the park entrance island was also completed, and with a newly established volunteer beautification committee, we hope to continue to enhance the community over the next couple years, to make Paradise even more attractive.

The Not-for-Profit PI Co-Op works diligently to keep the fees for all well below other 55+ communities in Pinellas County, while at the same time, suppling great benefits for all to enjoy life here. All this, if promoted correctly, should help with home sales and a realization by many, as to how good we all have it here. I think Paradise Island is to doing Great! Please submit suggestions for things you think will make it even better.

We do ask for your support to help keep the rates low, thus helping all of us, with things like: not wasting city water (fix that running toilet or leaks), take care of the outside look of



your home and just generally following the rules and using safe practices (too many concerns are being expressed about speeders and those not stopping at Stop signs). We are just asking everyone to try to be a good citizen of the community, so that we all can fully enjoy our time here together. The “Quiet and Peaceful Enjoyment” expressed in our bylaws, and is desired in any community, is mostly up to each and every one of us on a daily basis, please do your part and call out those that don’t. Overall, I think we do well here in Paradise.

As it has been announced, the entire pool area will be closed for required repairs from July 20th for about 4 weeks, but will reopen as soon as possible. This is a must do project, but it was anticipated, it is being delayed to July 20th, to allow for our residents to plan around this closure. You might want to avoid having guests down, or to plan that trip away, or just plan for other alternatives during that timeframe. Sorry for any inconvenience this may present.

Overnight street parking was better this year or so, but with new residents and a lack of interest by some residents, the need for a new towing company has emerged. All new parking permits, for those showing a real need to park on the street overnight, will be required soon. As a reminder, parking on the street at any time of day or night (with or without a permit) also includes Not parking on the sidewalks or on the grass, but parking with the right-side tires in the concrete rain gutter is perfect. Also, no overnight parking at the clubhouse, except for those specially marked spots by the shuffleboard courts are reserved for your unexpected guests. Please keep our streets clear for emergency vehicles and to prevent damage to our sidewalks and storm drains.

Due to a recent event, please remember that no open fires are allowed in the community and the city / county will issue fines. If you see any open fires, please call 911 immediately. An open fire in a community like ours, is dangerous. Please, always consider the safety of you and all of your neighbors in everything you do. Thank You!

Did You Know?

Paradise Island became a fully pet-friendly park when the new Rules & Regulations were updated as of March 1, 2026. The only exception is that pets are not allowed in the Community Clubhouse, recreation areas, or common areas at any time.

There is still a limit of two (2) pets per unit. Dogs and cats are pets. Small birds and fish may also be kept. No exotic animal may be kept as a pet. Any animal that is not a dog, cat, small bird, or fish shall be considered exotic. Pets must not weigh more than 40 pounds at maturity.

Each animal must be registered and identified by the owner in the Management office.

Pets must always be on a leash outside the Unit unless in a fenced backyard. Pets must be kept inside if unattended.

As a reminder, pet owners must clean up after their pets in the community and properly dispose of waste at their unit

Please refer to section VII, Pets, for further requirements.

We hope that you and your furry best friends love our expanded pet-friendly environment.

PARKING PERMITS EXPIRE / PARKING POLICY REMINDER

As it has been 2 years since we last issued overnight street parking permits, those **existing permits will expire July 31, 2026**. If you currently have a resident permit, which is about to expire, or if you think you are in need of one, please apply at the office for a new or renewal of your current permit. Management will review your application and notify you when your new permit is ready for pick up.

We have contracted with a new towing company and they will start enforcing our parking rules effective after that date, so make sure you get a new permit and follow the parking rules to **avoid having your car towed at your expense!**

Just a reminder of some of the parking rules as published in the Paradise Island Co-op Rules and Regulations, Effective March 1, 2026.

1. **No more than 2 motor vehicles per lot.** This includes motorcycles, but not golf carts. Limit of 1 golf cart per lot.
2. There is no parking allowed on the street between the hours of 11 PM and 7 AM without a valid resident or temporary permit displayed.
3. If a guest unexpectedly is staying over after regular office hours, their vehicle may be parked overnight in one of 3 “visitor parking only” spots near the shuffleboard courts. **These spaces are for temporary guest parking only, not for overflow resident parking!**
4. No overnight parking is allowed in any of the other parking spaces in the clubhouse parking lots! Parking is for clubhouse and pool only!
5. **No parking on the sidewalk!** Park as close to the edge of the pavement as possible, but not on the sidewalk, facing in the same direction as the traffic flow.
6. **No parking in front yards!** Including if you have covered your front yard with gravel or pavers. This is not a parking space! Golf carts may park on approved pads in front of the home.
7. Boats, campers and RVs are not allowed to be parked on the street overnight. Temporary permit may be obtained for 1 night prior / after a trip for loading / unloading.
8. No utility trailers may be parked on the street overnight.

These are just a few highlights of the parking rules and regulations. Please refer to your copy of the Rules and Regulations for further information.

Temporary parking permits are available during regular office hours for guests if there is no room in your driveway for their vehicle, or for resident’s vehicles if you are having your driveway painted or refinished.

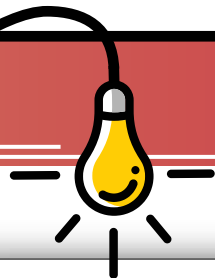

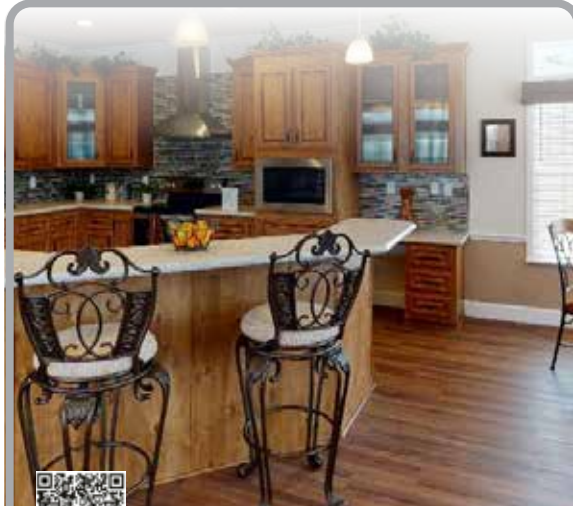

VETERAN'S CORNER

Greatest Ranger that ever-lived Dies at 106: An Army Ranger who fought through D-Day, the Battle of the Bulge and the Battle of Inchon, escaped enemy captivity twice and was wounded two dozen times across two wars has died at 106. Thomas Edward "Tommy" Gwynn, known throughout his adopted hometown of Tullahoma, Tennessee, as "the greatest Ranger that ever was," died Monday, April 6, at the Life Care Center there, according to an obituary issued by Kilgore Funeral Home. He was two months from his 107th birthday and was the town's oldest resident. By the time he left the military, Gwynn had earned a battlefield commission, a dozen Purple Hearts and later earned a French military award for valor.

Gwynn was born June 2, 1919, in Moscow, a farming town in Fayette County east of Memphis. He enlisted in 1941 and, two years later, earned a spot with the U.S. Army Rangers, the light

infantry force activated in 1942 under Maj. William O. Darby. Gwynn shipped to England with his unit in 1943 and waded ashore at Normandy on June 6, 1944. He marked the date as a second birthday every year afterward, telling the Moore County News he celebrated it because he survived. From the beachhead, Gwynn pushed east through the Allied breakout, fought through the snowy Ardennes during the Battle of the Bulge and reached the Elbe River on May 8, 1945, the day Germany surrendered. He came home that November.

In 1950, he was called back to service and shipped to Korea, where he took part in the Sept. 15 amphibious landing at Inchon, Gen. Douglas MacArthur's flanking strike against North Korean forces. On two separate occasions during the Korean campaign, enemy troops took him prisoner. Both times, he broke out and returned to American lines. Troops called him "Little Horse" for his speed and stamina under fire. He also earned a battlefield promotion to first lieutenant. **By the war's end, Gwynn had been wounded 24 times.**

His decorations included two Silver Stars, three Bronze Stars, 12 Purple Hearts, the Presidential Unit Citation with two bronze clusters, the Distinguished Service Cross, the Combat Infantryman Badge and the Prisoner of War Medal. **The number of Purple Hearts alone places Gwynn among the most-decorated American combat veterans of his generation and in history.** France awarded him a Chevalier of the Legion of Honour, its highest order of merit, conferred in a Nov. 7, 2012, letter from then-President Francois Hollande for Gwynn's role in the 1944 liberation of France. A 2013 fire at his Tullahoma home destroyed many of the original medals. Replacements were issued in the years that followed.

After returning from Korea, Gwynn owned and operated Gwynn Appliance Repair in Tullahoma, served as a jail minister and remained a longtime member of First Baptist Church in town. He became a familiar figure around Tullahoma well into old age, handing out donuts, candy and small bags of food to neighbors and strangers alike. Imagine being shot 24 times in the war and surviving to 106! When asked about the secret to his longevity at his 106th birthday celebration, Gwynn said, "Always smile and have a good heart."

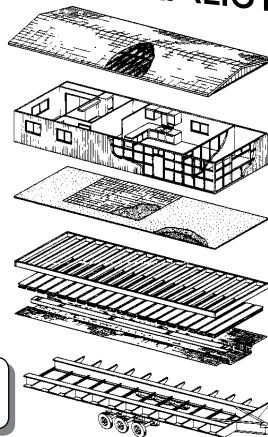

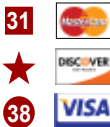

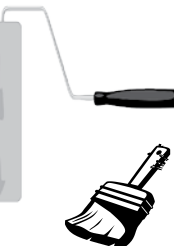
