





Identity Theft

Warning signs of identity theft

- Bills for items you did not buy
- Debt collection calls for accounts you did not open
- Information on your credit report for accounts you did not open
- Denials of loan applications
- Mail stops coming to, or is missing from, your mailbox

How to report identity theft

To report identity theft, contact:

- The **Federal Trade Commission (FTC)** online at IdentityTheft.gov or call 1-877-438-4338
- The three **major credit reporting agencies**. Ask them to place fraud alerts and a credit freeze on your accounts.
- The **fraud department at your credit card issuers**, bank, and other places where you have accounts

How to protect yourself from identity theft

- **Do not answer phone calls**, texts, social media messages, or email from numbers or **people you do not know**.
- Do not share personal information like your bank account number, Social Security number, or date of birth.
- **Collect your mail every day** and place a hold on your mail when you will be on vacation or away from your home.
- Review credit card and bank account statements. Watch for and report unauthorized or suspicious transactions.
- **Understand how ATM skimming works** and how to protect yourself
- Learn when it is safe to use a public Wi-Fi network
- Store personal information, including your Social Security card, in a safe place. **Do not carry it in your wallet**.

Imposter Scam

The top types of imposter scams:

An imposter scammer may call, text, or email to convince you they are **someone in authority**. They may even use caller ID to make it look like they are calling from an official government or business' number. To commit identity theft, they try to get you to send money or a gift card or share personal information.

- **Government** imposter scams - Unless you contact them first, government agencies typically initiate communication with you by letter. Unexpected contact or demands through any other method may be a scam.
- **IRS** imposter scams - scammers pretend you owe the IRS money for taxes and may threaten legal action
- **Social Security** imposter scams - scammers claim there is a problem with your Social Security account or promise to increase your benefits
- **Charity** scams - scammers pretend to be from a real or fake charity and try to get you to contribute
- **Grandparent scams** - scammers pretend to be a grandchild or other relative who needs emergency financial help
- **Tech support** scams - scammers tell you your computer's security is at risk and try to remotely access your device and steal personal information or ask for payment
- Scammers may also pretend to be from your **bank or a company you do business with**. You might be told you owe money or there is a problem with your account.

Hurricane season

It's that time of year again! Living in Florida means that we all need to understand and get ready for hurricanes. *"Florida history is defined by hurricanes. They are to this state what tornadoes were to Dorothy's Kansas"*. You cannot stop a hurricane, but you can take steps to protect yourself, your family and your home from the dangers of these powerful storms. It's a good time to start preparing for those summer storms. Last year was a hard time for a lot of this county. Get your plans in place now. Make evacuation plans, where will you go, what should you bring with you, make a checklist of things you need to take. Keep your important papers all in one place so you can grab and go.

People with special needs should determine if they may need assistance. The following are key considerations:

- Do you use equipment that requires electricity? Make sure you have a backup power source, or plan to go to a location that does.
- Do you have family or friends who can help you make your plan, shelter in place or evacuate? Work with them now to make a plan and assemble the items in your kit. Be sure to include any medical devices, equipment or medications you will need.
- If you need assistance, register for the Special Needs Program. Pinellas County can help with your pet; transportation needs and sheltering.

Build an Emergency Kit

When getting your emergency kit together, think about each member of your family and what they would need for two weeks. Pinellas County Emergency Management offers a full list of recommended items. Basic items include:

- Important documents.
- Medication.
- Sanitation (wipes, antibacterial hand gel, soap, cloth).
- Water (at least one gallon of water per person per day).
- One-week supply of nonperishable food.
- Can opener.
- Batteries.



Check your insurance.

Homeowners and flood insurance can help you with emergency needs after a disaster. Most of the time, you will not be eligible to receive disaster assistance until the President of the United States declares an emergency—and even then, the assistance is usually in the form of loans that you must pay back. Having homeowners insurance and flood insurance means that coverage and assistance will be available regardless of disaster declarations. Discuss all of your insurance needs with your agent to confirm you are adequately protected.

The saga of the cataract surgery....

So, I had cataract surgery in June and lived to tell about it lol

I was supposed to have the surgery last year but my doctor decided to move to Tallahassee instead. I swear it was not my fault. They were supposed to reschedule when there was a new doctor available but hurricane season happened instead and then I was out of town for months. So it was being done this year for sure

I had my exam and the expensive measuring of the eye not covered by my Humana Gold Plus. The new dr told me my eyes were extremely healthy (go me) and we scheduled the surgeries again. You have to start the pre surgery drops 3 days before surgery. I was ready!! I had read all the paperwork and was prepared to log it all. But wait.... 4 days before the first surgery we had to cancel and reschedule because the doctor was out sick. On no.... not again!! They called back and moved my first surgery to the date of my second surgery and rescheduled by second surgery for a week later. I really wanted the standard two weeks between eyes but was scared to change it at this point... as you can understand.

I started the presurgery drops 3 days ahead of time with fingers crossed. The surgery center called with my time – noon!!! And you cannot eat or drink anything for 8 hours prior to that time. What!! I am a breakfast lover. How do I survive? I set the alarm for 3.45 am and had a healthy snack and a long drink of water and went back to sleep. My girlfriend picked up a very hungry and thirsty me at 11.15 and off we went to the surgery center in New Port Richey.

I paid the copayment for the surgery and filled out the form. There is always a form. My girlfriend had to fill out a form also with her information so they can call when I am close to being done.... Like I am a cake in the oven. Lol. If you don't have a driver, you cannot have the surgery and you must remember to bring your dark glasses to wear on the way home and no jewelry or watches allowed. I sat there watching people coming back from surgery in the obligatory wheel chair and sunglasses and being taken out to their respective rides home and people coming in to have surgery.

Finally I was called back. They had said to dress warmly and wear a v neck top and it was really cold in there. So glad I listened and brought a sweater. They took my vitals and put all kinds of drops in my eyes and then it was.. wait. They moved me to a different room.. and asked if I wanted a warm blanket.. yes please ... and wait And finally I was up and going again this time into the surgical suite where there were a bunch of people just waiting for little old me.

I was told to lay down on the table with my head in the holder at the end of the table. Scoot up. Good. Arms by your side. They strapped me in!! not tightly though just enough that I would not be able to easily reach out. They gave me anesthesia and sent me into a twilight sleep.

I have no idea of time passing – I was aware of movements involving my eye – vague images of things approaching but that was it .. I felt nothing at all. I came awake as they were telling me it was time to get up. I did slowly and carefully and they lead me to the recovery room where I sat in a chair with a warm blanket and they offered me snacks of various kinds and a drink. I chose cheese and crackers as it seemed the most filling and a bottle of water. And then I was told my ride was here and into the wheelchair I got for my ride to the car. I felt a little fuzzy but fine other than that and home I went.

Once home you stay quiet and don't do much for the next week or so. No rubbing the eye and wearing a shield over the eye for the next few days when you are sleeping. You tape the shield over your eye which involves skin and you have to untape and retape if you are putting drops in over night. It's fun .. sure... lol. And you get to do this for at least 3 days. I am a side sleeper so I actually did it for the first week. Fortunately the tape they give you just makes your skin sore for a while after you remove it. Phew. No road rash. lol

You have 3 sets of drops you have to put in your eye daily for the next two weeks. One is twice a day, the next 3 times a day and the third one is four times a day. Yes, math is required lol So I set up my schedule: twice: 8am, 8pm; 3 times: 8am 4pm 11pm; 4 times: 6am, noon, 6pm and 11pm. If doing two drops at the same time you must leave at least 5 minutes between the drops. I set alarms on my phone to make sure I did not miss anything and if 2 drops at the same time, I used the snooze so I wouldn't forget. They gave me a tracking sheet to use but I made my own according to times and type of drop as it was easier for me. You follow this for 2 weeks, then it is just one of the drops twice a day for the next week and then once a day for the final week.

As you can imagine, alarms going off throughout the day and never a full night's sleep. I used 11pm for the final drops of the day because that gave me a chance to sleep 7 hours between drops. You can't sleep on the side on the surgery eye for at least 3 days.

The second eye was much like the first except that I reacted to the anesthesia and got nauseous on the way home. And panic. Don't throw up in the car.. don't throw up in the car... and... thank goodness ... we pulled into the driveway and I got the door open before was stopped and threw up on the drive way and me rather instead of my girlfriend's car, even if it was mostly water. The dr said that happens to some people after the second surgery.

You see the dr day after surgery and then a few weeks later as a follow up. As of this writing I have not had the follow up. It was supposed to be last Monday but the dr got sick. And then it was supposed to be today but she is in the hospital. No it is not my fault. I am not making the drs sick, I swear it!! Hopefully, Friday will be a good date

One of the weird things after surgery is your brain trying to coordinate the eyes. You remove one of the lenses from your glasses so that you have one eye that can see distance clearly and a second eye looking through the glasses and not seeing too clearly. My brain was not fully up to the task and I found that my coordination was off and my balance was a little off.

After the second eye, I had two eyes now seeing distance clearly but my brain cannot get used to the fact that I need reading glasses to read but not for distance. I have worn glasses since I was 10. My brain is still sure that I need them to see far but not near. It is totally confused but doing better as time goes on. A brand new way of living. Colors are amazingly bright and beautiful and I can see signs so very clearly. I will need to wear glasses still as I have astigmatism and I am okay with that, you could say I am used to wearing glasses lol. I could have paid thousands per lens to fix that but it was not worth it to me and my budget said no anyway.

Do I recommend cataract surgery? Hell yes!!! What an amazing difference in my vision. All the drops are an inconvenience but worth it. I am now a super star at getting drops in my eyes first time... but...yes... I still miss on occasion as the drops roll down my cheeks. No one is perfect, it seems, least of all me.




