

The White Table, is a symbolic solemn display in United States Military dining facilities and events honoring Prisoners of War, (POW) and those Missing in Action (MIA).

It features a small, white-clothed round table set for One, representing the Isolation, Purity, and Enduring Hope for the return of service members.

Key Elements and Symbolism:

Small Table: Represents the Service member's lonely battle.

White Cloth: Symbolizes the Purity of the Service member's intentions.

Round Shape: Shows everlasting concern for the Missing.

Empty Chair: Represents the Missing Service Member.

Single Rose: Signifies the Bloodshed and the Families keeping faith.

Yellow ribbon: Represents continued hope for Their return.

Slice of Lemon and Salt: Symbolizes the Bitter Fate and Tears of families.

Inverted Glass and Candle: Represents the Inability to share in a meal, and a light for Their return.

The tradition, often linked to the Vietnam War, serves as a poignant reminder of the sacrifices made by Armed Forces Members.

March Birthstones

The birthstones for March are aquamarine and bloodstone. Aquamarine is a blue to blue-green gemstone named for its sea-like color, while bloodstone is a deep green stone with red spots. Aquamarine is more widely known and associated with tranquility, while the traditional bloodstone is linked to health and strength.

Aquamarine

Appearance: This gem is a blue to blue-green member of the beryl family, named from the Latin words for "sea water". It is known for its clarity, with colors ranging from a very pale blue to a deeper sea-green

Symbolism: It is associated with tranquility, clarity, and hope, and its name reflects the color of the sea.

Lore: Legends say aquamarine was the treasure of mermaids and that it protects sailors at sea.

Uses: It is often faceted and used in jewelry for its beauty and durability, making it suitable for daily wear. It is also the modern wedding anniversary gem for the 18th year.

Bloodstone

Appearance: This is a dark green stone that is typically opaque and is known for its red spots of iron oxide, which look like drops of blood.

Symbolism: It is traditionally associated with health and strength.

Uses: It is usually cut into a cabochon (a smooth, rounded shape). It is also recognized as an alternate 14th wedding anniversary gem.



March Fun Facts & Recipes



March is named after Mars, the Roman god of war, because it was the first month in the ancient Roman calendar, marking the start of the military campaign season after winter, a time for both warfare and agricultural renewal. The name comes from the Latin Martius, meaning "of Mars," and was significant as the beginning of the year for the early Romans.

Roman Calendar:

In the original Roman calendar, March (Martius) was the first month, symbolizing new beginnings for military action and planting.

God of War:

Mars was a central Roman deity, considered the father of Rome's founders, Romulus and Remus, and was honored as a protector of agriculture and war.

Transition:

The name reflects the shift from winter's dormancy to warmer seasons, when armies would "march" out and farming would recommence.

The world's oldest recorded recipes date back to approximately 1730 BCE, found on Mesopotamian cuneiform tablets, with lamb stew, various pies, and stews being among the earliest documented. These Babylonian tablets describe complex, meat-based dishes designed for elite consumption. Another early, 4,000-year-old recipe is *mersu*, a dessert made of fruits and nuts.

Oldest Recorded Recipes

- **Mesopotamian Stew (c. 1730 BCE):** These tablets, found in modern-day Iraq, contain recipes for lamb stews that used ingredients like garlic, onions, and leeks, often focusing on intense, complex flavors.
- **Mersu (c. 2000 BCE):** Often cited as the oldest dessert, this Mesopotamian dish combined dates, pistachios, and sometimes cheese or nuts, typically formed into balls.
- **Nettle Pudding (c. 6000 BCE):** While not a "written" recipe, evidence suggests this is one of the oldest known preparations from Britain.
- **Ancient Egyptian Bread (c. 1500 BCE):** Hieroglyphs show specialized, early baking techniques.

These ancient recipes were not written for home cooks but rather as technical records, often focusing on ritualistic or high-status meals.



Where the magic is hiding



Use social media responsibly

Here are some tips for both parents and children to follow to help create an atmosphere of positive citizenry on social media channels:

Don’t hesitate to block contacts and remove posts from your feed if they are offensive.
- **Exercise caution.** You wouldn’t allow your children to walk around with a sandwich board displaying their legal name age, address, and other personal information, so don’t allow them to create detailed profiles that can be accessed by strangers the world over. Never divulge too much information about yourself, your current location, or future plans unless you want to fall victim to unscrupulous internet trolls.

Here are a few tips to keep in mind if you are inheriting a blended family situation:

- **Establish routines.** This can be an emotional and confusing time for all, and it might take some time to figure out how this new dynamic functions. It will be less chaotic if your household and schedules are organized and in sync.

- **Find common bonds.** Figure out activities that the entire family can enjoy. You’ll also need to find activities that encourage bonding between stepparents and stepchildren.

- **Don’t forget date night.** It’s easy to get lost in the identity of your roles in your new family, but shift the focus back to your marriage. Keep the romance alive by scheduling a meal away from home at a favorite restaurant or a night out on the town with your spouse.
