Hello everyone, we are still in Hurricane season. We have been pretty fortunate with not as many storms as predicted. And it hasn't been an overactive season yet, but don't let your guard down, we are in peak season and anything could happen! Be aware, prepared and know what you are going to do.

- Listen to your local radio and TV during foul weather for warnings and possible instructions. Go to www.pinellascounty.org/emergency or go to www.weather.gov for real time weather alerts.
- Be prepared to evacuate. **HAVE A PLAN!** Know how and what to secure if a hurricane threatens.
- Sign up for the **Alert Pinellas**, it's a free emergency notification service, online at www.pinellascounty.org/alertpinellas. This service provides multiple ways to notify you, such as landlines, mobile phones, email, and text messages, whenever an urgent situation such as flooding, arises in your location.
- There is also an application for your smartphone "Ready Pinellas."
- It doesn't hurt to check your homeowner's policy for coverage.
- If a tornado warning is issued you would be better off going to the clubhouse or pavilion bathrooms (be sure you have the codes written down) than staying in your mobile home, park model or RV.
- Please stay safe!

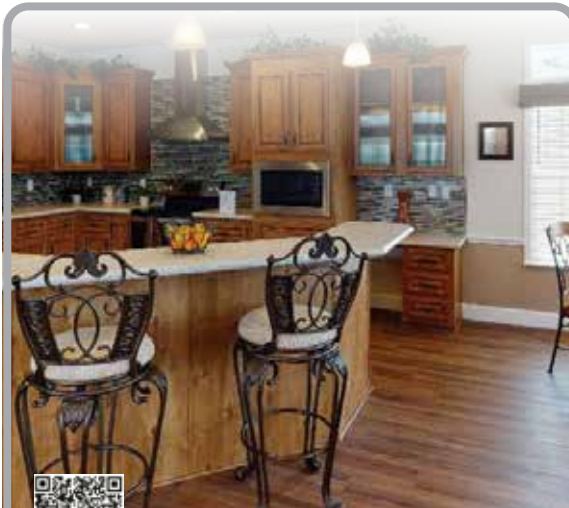

Your Options:

Pets must be on a leash no longer than six feet. Retractable leashes extend many feet, often blocking the whole road. This is also in the park rules.

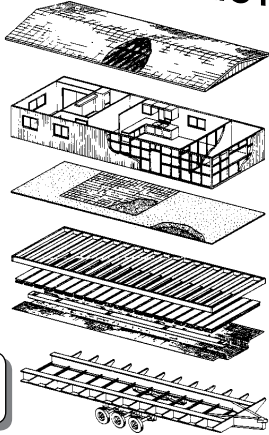

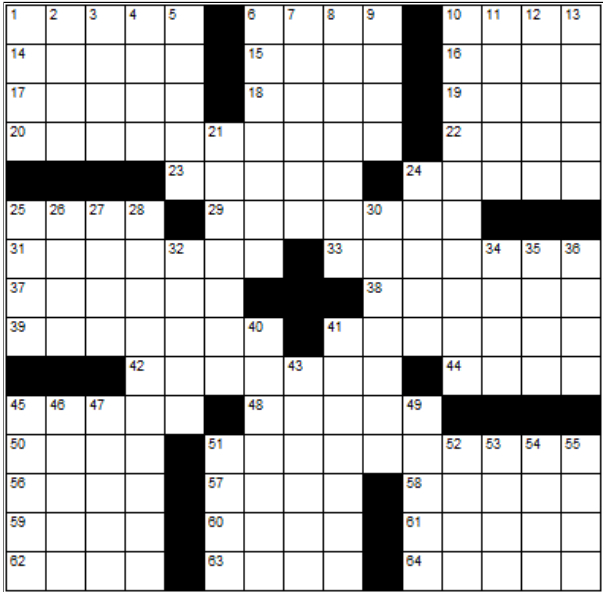

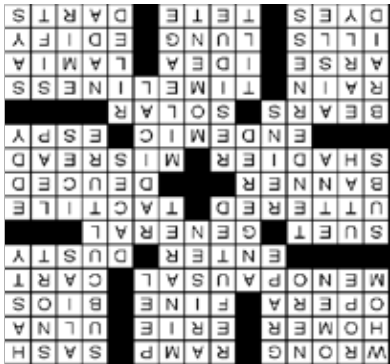
