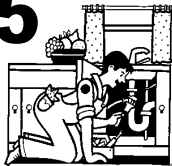

WATER SCHEDULING & RULES – PINELLAS COUNTY

- Addresses ending in even numbers (0, 2, 4, 6, 8): Tuesdays
- **Addresses ending in odd numbers (1, 3, 5, 7, 9): Thursdays – Lincolnshire based on address #1071.**
- Mixed or No Address (such as common areas, entry areas/office complexes, shopping centers and other “no address” locations): Thursdays
- **Watering hours are reduced to 12:01 a.m. to 4 a.m. OR 8 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.** Properties less than one acre in size may only use one of these windows. Properties one acre or larger can use both windows.

Restrictions under Phase III

In addition to continued one-day-per-week watering, the following restrictions will go into effect April 3, 2026:

- No HOA or other entity shall enforce deed restrictions or other community standards requiring an increase in water use, including replacement of plant material to meet aesthetic standards or pressure washing.
- Car washing at home (non-commercial) is only allowed on your lawn watering day and you must use a hose with a shutoff nozzle.
- Ornamental fountains are limited to four hours a day. The regular hours of operation can be selected by the owner but must be posted.
- **Restaurants are required to only serve water upon request.**



Please note Lincolnshire residents: per inquiry to Pinellas County 4/15/2026.

Pressure washing is permitted on your day of the week for watering, (Lincolnshire’s day is Thursdays) at any time of the day.

If you hire a pressure washing business from OUTSIDE of Lincolnshire the pressure washing can be done any day of the week.

Violations

To protect the remaining water supply, Pinellas County Utilities is required to issue a \$193 citation for any violation of these watering restrictions. This fine will double with each additional violation. **While we typically issue a warning for a first violation, warnings will not be allowed after April 17, 2026, due to the extreme drought conditions.**

COMPACTOR REMINDER



If you are new to Lincolnshire please read this article.

A friendly reminder for all our residents. Whenever you take trash to the compactor, please **remember to close the door** after depositing your garbage. **DO NOT PRESS THE RED BUTTON.** This compactor is pre-programmed to automatically start compaction after the door has been closed three (3) times. **It is very important that the compactor door is CLOSED after you deposit your garbage.**

Please do not bring large items furniture etc. that need to be placed in the Bulk dumpster that is brought into the community twice a month. Check the Voice calendar for dates each month and hold those large items at your home till the container is brought on site.

Help us keep our compactor working by following the rules above.

Please note: do not leave any bulk trash or regular garbage in the area that formerly housed the blue recycling bins. Any bulk trash items you may wish to discard need to be kept at your residence till the bulk trash container is brought on site 2x each month. See Voice calendar for scheduled dates.

All regular garbage should be placed in the compactor. Do not throw large items into the compactor.

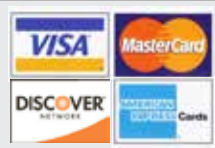

Scam message being sent claiming unpaid tickets and traffic violations. Message looks very realistic coming from the State of Florida including a QR code for you to scan and pay. **Florida Courts will never request money via a text message or a QR code.**

We advise citizens never to give personal information or account information over the phone and call law enforcement immediately to report suspicious activity.

Latest tech support and computer virus scams. Scammers pretend to be tech support from a well-known company. They either call, text or try to trick you into clicking in an email, text or pop-up window, claiming there's a problem with your computer like a virus or billing issue. To fix it, you inadvertently give them remote access to your computer and all your data. **Never click on virus alerts, even if they look like they come from your computer company or an anti-virus protection company.** If you think your computer was impacted, talk to a local reputable service provider

News and Updates for June 2026:

Tips on successful community along with our tenet association updates on living in Lincolnshire. LHOA protects your rights under Federal and State laws and reminds homeowners of our responsibilities too.

- Yes, SWFL Hurricane preparedness started this month. Start now and avoid the certainty of a rush for supplies later. Essentials: water to drink for a week, batteries!!!, power storage device to keep at least a smart phone charged for 10 days, all medicines for 2 weeks and food that does not require rehydration to eat.
- Of consideration for personal and property safety (our coach or neighbors) while preparing for a strong tropical storm, excessive wind gusts or a major Category 1 or higher is to: bundle potted plants (especially in plastic pots and tall light weight planter decorations) close together and against a wall, remove decorations on the coach siding whether in the carport or around the coach, strongly secure outside grill (charcoal or propane regardless of weight). Please remember that once items go airborne and with weight plus speed that item can injury and severely damage your coach and people.
- There are both regular and electronic device recycling availabilities in Largo. The Starkey site does not take electronic waste. However, merchants like Staples and Best Buy do take old and unused electronic waste including connections. Many give you credit on your account. Call them before you just toss it in the compactor. All small batteries should not be tossed in the trash. Collect them and then take them to a designated battery recycle site.

❖ LHOA membership for 2026 remains at \$15 for both new members and renewals. Support as LHOA does look out for both Federal (Fair Housing Act) and Florida homeowner rights. LHOA has spent over \$8000 to protect 463 homeowners from both liability and state/federal lawsuits over its lifetime. All on Membership yearly dues. Veterans Corner



Greatest Ranger that ever-lived Dies at 106: An Army Ranger who fought through D-Day, the Battle of the Bulge, and the Battle of Inchon, escaped enemy captivity twice and was wounded two dozen times across two wars has died at 106. Thomas Edward "Tommy" Gwynn, known throughout his adopted hometown of Tullahoma, Tennessee, as "the greatest Ranger that ever was," died Monday, April 6, at the Life Care Center there, according to an obituary issued by Kilgore Funeral Home. He was two months from his 107th birthday and was the town's oldest resident. By the time he left the military, Gwynn had earned a battlefield commission, a dozen Purple Hearts and later earned a French military award for valor.

Gwynn was born June 2, 1919, in Moscow, a farming town in Fayette County east of Memphis. He enlisted in 1941 and, two years later, earned a spot with the U.S. Army Rangers, the light infantry force activated in 1942 under Maj. William O. Darby. Gwynn shipped to England with his unit in 1943 and waded ashore at Normandy on June 6, 1944. He marked the date as a second birthday every year afterward, telling the Moore County News he celebrated it because he survived. From the beachhead, Gwynn pushed east through the Allied breakout, fought through the snowy Ardennes during the Battle of the Bulge and reached the Elbe River on May 8, 1945, the day Germany surrendered. He came home that November.

In 1950, he was called back to service and shipped to Korea, where he took part in the Sept. 15 amphibious landing at Inchon, Gen. Douglas MacArthur's flanking strike against North Korean forces. On two separate occasions during the Korean campaign, enemy troops took him prisoner. Both times, he broke out and returned to American lines. Troops called him "Little Horse" for his speed and stamina under fire. He also earned a battlefield promotion to be a first lieutenant. **By the war's end, Gwynn had been wounded 24 times.**

His decorations included two Silver Stars, three Bronze Stars, 12 Purple Hearts, the Presidential Unit Citation with two bronze clusters, the Distinguished Service Cross, the Combat Infantryman Badge, and the Prisoner of War Medal. **The number of Purple Hearts alone places Gwynn among the most-decorated American combat veterans of his generation and in history.** France awarded him a Chevalier of the Legion of Honour, its highest order of merit, conferred in a Nov. 7, 2012, letter from then-President Francois Hollande for Gwynn's role in the 1944 liberation of France. A 2013 fire at his Tullahoma home destroyed many of the original medals. Replacements were issued in the years that followed.

After returning from Korea, Gwynn owned and operated Gwynn Appliance Repair in Tullahoma, served as a jail minister and remained a longtime member of First Baptist Church in town. He became a familiar figure around Tullahoma well into old age, handing out donuts, candy, and small bags of food to neighbors and strangers alike. Imagine being shot 24 times in the war and surviving 106! When asked about the secret to his longevity at his 106th birthday celebration, Gwynn said, "Always smile and have a good heart."

This month on why and how a daily focus on completing basic exercise (movement) can have a positive effect on how we feel and look to our friends, to ourselves, our family and even our medical care providers. Giving enough time before judging if there is a benefit is worth the effort.

After enrolling in VA walking and Tai Chi I now ride my bike less and walk several times a day instead. It has been one year since I started this. I simply started by walking down my block and around the next returning home doing it again. My pace is like a stroll. I added extra blocks when I was ready. Now that the temperature is getting warmer my longest walk in the morning and shorter walks later on. I either walk in our park or to the Largo Central Park and join a regular parade of people doing the same.

Why walk? Our bodies were designed close to a million years ago to do this each day. As a wee kid and a teen, I walked all over southwest Minneapolis, even in the winter. Whatever the reason and wherever I wanted to go. Freedom. For a kid, girl, or boy, it was an enormously big deal. If you did the same, then keep reading.

How to start walking again for health. Not someone else's health but our own. This is walking for our body and the spirit we all have within us. Each of us is so much more than a shopping list, trip to the doctor/dentist or the mall in our daily or weeks schedule. Fire up the spirit.

Knowing what obstacles prevent you and me from walking regularly is the first step to being able to manage them. Look at the list of common barriers below and consider which ones interfere with your ability to meet your walking goals. Write them down so you can identify them and think about them. Writing things down does tell our brains what we care about.

1. Identify a barrier that prevents you from being more active.
2. Develop a few creative strategies to navigate the barrier (what will you try, when will you do it, and how will you put it into action?). Our brain is listening and reading our words when we write them down.
3. Analyze how well your plan works and revise it until you find a decent solution.
 - Let us look at an example:
 1. Identify a barrier: It is too hot during most of the day now to walk.
 2. Develop a few strategies to try to overcome that barrier: Maybe I can go to the mall and walk indoors after lunch. Or I can walk on the parks indoor treadmill and watch a TV show. For me, longer walks are before 9 am and after 6 pm in the park. I take 2 short walks during the day to get my mail and go for a walk to pool and back home. Oh, all free.

Finally, analyze how your plan worked: The plan worked out better than I expected. I realized that getting out of the house more frequently made me feel better and I was proud of myself for accomplishing my walking goals. I even stand taller than I could before.

Walking like healthy eating too makes a decent personal healthy business plan. Write one up for yourself.

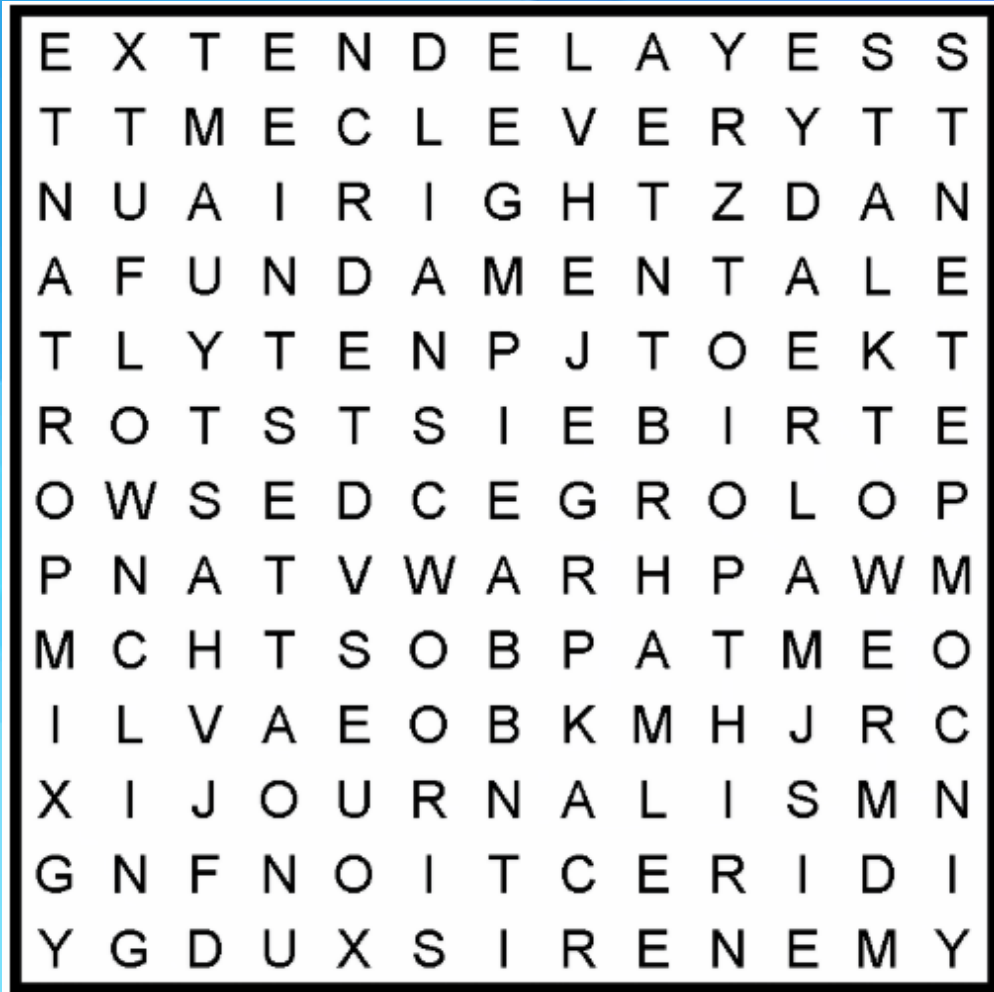
