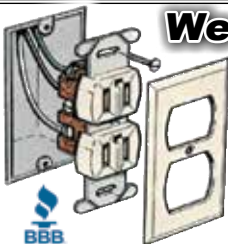

Park Rules

Remember it is the responsibility of all residents to inform their guests of all the rules.



- The Park speeding limit is 15 mph throughout the park for all bikes and vehicles.
- Any and all acts which endanger the life, health, safety, property or peaceful enjoyment of Colonial Village or its occupants will not be permitted and are violations of the Rules.
- Resident must conduct themselves in a manner that does not either unreasonably disturb their neighbors or constitute a breach of peace and are responsible for the actions of persons on the premises with their consent.
- Disorderly conduct, intoxication and profane language will not be tolerated in and around common areas.
- The use of firearms, including BB guns, bows and arrows, slingshots, etc. are prohibited.
- Fireworks are prohibited anywhere in the park.
- All residents and guests must wear shirts or cover-ups at all times except within their own unit area.
- Failure to comply with the provisions of the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation, Bylaws, and Master Form Occupancy Agreement is also a violation of these Rules and Regulations and is cumulative grounds for fines and termination of occupancy.
- No political signs, flags, streamers and/or banners permitted on the mobile home lot or the mobile home, appurtenances or other structures on the lot, including but not limited to carports, sheds, screen room, antennas and flag poles.
- Home For Sale signage should be **placed in the front window of the unit, or in the front flower/stone garden bed**, NOT in the yard or on the sidewalk.
- No smoking **and/or vaping** will be allowed in the common areas.
- The Noise Rule was modified in the Park's Rules and Regulations. The hours **from 11 P.M. to 8 A.M.** should be considered an especially quiet time. Please be considerate when entertaining.
- Shuffleboard – A resident must accompany all guests using shuffleboard court. Guests must wear shirts and shoes. Walking on or across the court is not permitted. Equipment taken from the shed must be returned after use.
- Renting or subletting of units is not permitted.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the Clubhouse except at Community approved social functions. No alcohol is permitted in the pool area or in other common areas of the Community.
- No overnight parking on the streets

Recipe of the Month

Lemon Cream Cheese Crescent Rolls



Ingredients: 1 can (8 oz) refrigerated crescent roll dough, 4 oz cream cheese, softened, 2 Tablespoon sugar, 1 teaspoon lemon zest, 1 Tablespoon Lemon juice, ½ teaspoon vanilla extract

Directions: Preheat your oven according to the crescent roll dough package instructions. In a bowl, mix together the softened cream cheese, sugar, lemon zest, lemon juice and vanilla extract until smooth and creamy. Unroll the crescent roll dough and separate it into triangles. Spoon a generous amount of the cream cheese mixture onto the wider end of each triangle. Roll the dough from the wide end to the point to form little crescent rolls. Place the rolls on a baking sheet and pop them in the oven. Bake according to package instructions, usually about 10-12 minutes, or until they're golden brown. Once you take them out, let them cool slightly. Serve warm. Enjoy every fluffy, creamy bite! Optional: sprinkle confectionary lightly over the tops while warm.

Six Foods that Never Expire

It's easy to lose track of items in the back of a dark pantry, which is why expiration dates can be so helpful in determining when to toss old foods. However, the "best by" dates we rely on aren't always a true picture of how long a food is shelf-stable. Food dating is mostly a voluntary process for grocery manufacturers, who often just estimate when their products will no longer be at their best quality. Luckily, there are some foods that are safe to keep using even if their expiration date has long passed. The six foods that never expire are **Honey, Vanilla Extract, Salt, Sugar, White Rice and Vinegar.**



Did you know you do not have to put opened bottles of mustard and ketchup in the refrigerator for safety. But refrigerating them preserves the flavor and quality for longer. Mustard is shelf-stable because its high acidity from ingredients like vinegar prevents the growth of harmful bacteria, mold, and mildew. While an opened bottle can be safely stored at room temperature, it may dry out, lose flavor, or separate over time, so most experts recommend refrigeration for the best taste and consistency, especially for Dijon or horseradish mustards.

Champagne Corks Can Fly at 50 MPH.

It's impossible to pinpoint just how much that tension-bursting “pop!” adds to the enjoyment of a bottle of Champagne, but human ingenuity has found ways to measure the speed at which a cork shoots from its mooring. In 2008, a German scientist calculated that the average speed of a Champagne cork is just under 25 mph, though they also noted that 62 mph could be reached under the right conditions. Other sources, including the American Academy of Ophthalmology, have noted that champagne corks can easily go flying at around 50 mph.



This high-speed bedazzlement is the result of the way Champagne (and all sparkling wine) is created. Since that magical late 17th-century day when Dom Perignon discovered the recipe — and likely even before that — the beverage has been made by adding yeast and sugar to an existing base of wine. Sealed tight in a bottle, this mixture undergoes a second fermentation that produces its signature carbon dioxide bubbles. That second fermentation swells internal pressure to 90 pounds per square inch — approximately three times the level of an inflated car tire. Upon finally achieving release when the bottle's wire is unwrapped and its stopper nudged, the pent-up carbon dioxide not only ejects the cork at parkway-level speeds, but also generates supersonic shock waves that resemble those unleashed by rockets and jets.

Of course, such a violently ejected projectile needs to be handled carefully; while it's used to comic effect in movies, a poorly aimed cork can shatter glass and result in ghastly injuries like a split eyeball or a detached retina. Drinkers will want to follow safe-opening guidelines that include chilling the sparkling wine to reduce pressure, aiming away from the body, and gripping the cork while twisting the bottle.

Facts:

Champagne is not a grape. Champagne is made with three types of grapes: pinot, meunier, and chardonnay.

The word “Champagne” refers to the region where the bubbly is produced, about 90 miles east of Paris.

The opening in a wine cask is called a Bunghole.

The average Champagne alcohol by volume (ABV) percentage is 12.2%.

Pounds of grapes used in a 750 mL bottle of Champagne is 2.6.

Square miles of vineyards in Champagne France is 132.

Bottles of Champagne (750 mL) imported by U.S. in 2021 is 34.1 million. In 2024 U.S. imported 250 million (750mL) bottles. Notably, Italy was the largest supplier, providing 122.6 million liters, while France supplied 38.1 million liters.

The traditional Formula 1 celebratory Champagne spray began by accident in the 1960s.

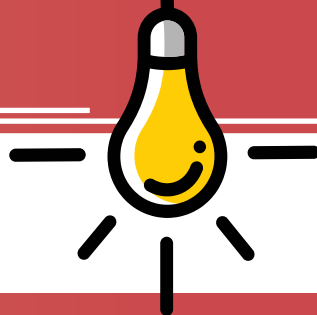
It's unclear when overflowing bottles of Champagne became a regular sight in the locker rooms of pro athletes celebrating a championship, but for motorsports at least, the tradition of the winner spraying the crowd with a bottle of bubbly has a clear origin. At the 1966 24 Hours of Le Mans race, Swiss Formula 1 driver Jo Siffert was handed a bottle that allegedly had been sitting out in the sun for too long, resulting in a surprise pop and unexpected shower for those in proximity. The following year, American driver Dan Gurney decided to up the ante by shaking his winning bottle of Champagne and directing the outburst onto the crowd by the podium. Although the spray may have landed a little too much on team boss Henry Ford II and his new bride, even the sport's bigwigs soon realized that there was no getting that particular mode of celebration back in the bottle.

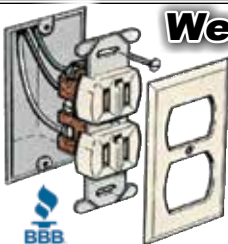

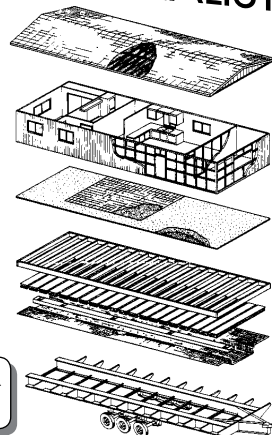

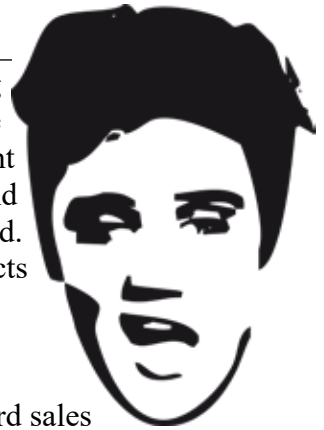

Rock Out to These 6 Facts About Elvis Presley

Few entertainers have achieved greater acclaim than the King of Rock 'n' Roll, Elvis Aaron Presley. From his humble beginnings in Tupelo, Mississippi, to his lavish later years spent at Graceland, Elvis lived a fascinating life, and his performances and songs remain almost as beloved today as when they were first recorded. In honor of the King's birthday on January 8, we've compiled six facts about one of the most renowned musicians of the 20th century.



Elvis Never Performed Outside of North America

Despite being a global sensation — an estimated 40% of his record sales occurred internationally — Elvis never performed outside of North America. In fact, the only time he ever held a show not on U.S. soil was during a series of three Canadian concerts, in Ottawa, Toronto, and Vancouver, all in 1957.

His tendency to stick stateside had little to do with his rumored fear of flying, however, as he still traveled by plane to perform in Hawaii in 1973. The most widely accepted (if still unconfirmed) reason for the lack of foreign gigs has to do with his manager, Colonel Tom Parker. Parker was born in the Netherlands, and reportedly feared that his status as an undocumented immigrant would make returning to the United States impossible. That may have been why he only booked Elvis on North American concerts.

Elvis Was a Natural Blond and Used Shoe Polish as Hair Dye

You'd be hard-pressed to find evidence of Elvis' natural blond hairstyle, as only one known photo exists, hanging on the wall of Graceland. From a young age, Elvis dyed his hair jet black with shoe polish — which was cheaper than hair dye — in an effort to make his blue eyes stand out. Elvis also began applying eyeliner to further accentuate his eyes around 1960, a trick he learned from actor Tony Curtis. As Elvis rose to fame, he continued to dye his hair to maintain his image, though he eventually shifted from shoe polish to a patented hair dye combination of Miss Clairol 51D and Black Velvet/Mink Brown by Paramount. Elvis later enlisted the services of Larry Geller, a beloved stylist in West Hollywood who also worked with stars such as Marlon Brando and Steve McQueen.

Elvis Didn't Write Any of the Songs He Performed

Despite recording over 600 songs throughout his career, Elvis' skills were lacking on the songwriting front. In a 1957 interview with *Dig* magazine, he explained, "I never wrote a song in my life... I've never even had an idea for a song." In fact, Elvis never learned how to read or write music. That didn't stop him from being credited as co-writer on many tracks, as his label demanded that certain songwriters give up 50% of authorship for any songs that Elvis recorded.

This isn't to say Elvis went about the recording process lazily — quite the opposite. In the recording studio, he sometimes did 40 takes of a single track until it was perfect.

Elvis Earned Several Black Belts in Karate

Elvis began training in the shotokan style of karate in 1958 under a man named Juergen Seydel while he was stationed in Germany as a member of the U.S. Army. Upon returning to the United States in 1960, Elvis earned his first black belt in the style of chito-ryu from Hank Slemansky. Elvis later studied in a Memphis dojo under Kang Rhee, where he received a seventh degree black belt in 1973 and an eighth in 1974. Rhee wrote a book about his experiences training Elvis, noting that he “was the only person I ever saw wear boots into the dojo,” and that the musician “insisted on using real firearms” during training instead of wooden ones. Elvis was so passionate about karate that he later co-founded the Tennessee Karate Institute in 1974. Some have questioned whether his black belts had more to do with his celebrity status than his skills, but his love for martial arts was undeniable.

Elvis Appears on the Most Popular Commemorative U.S. Stamp of All Time

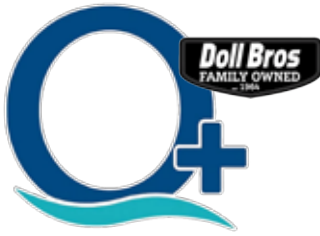
First issued by the United States Postal Service on January 8, 1993, a stamp featuring Elvis Presley went on to become the most popular commemorative stamp of all time. In 1992, two prospective designs were presented — one of a young Elvis from the 1950s and another of an older Elvis from his 1973 performance in Hawaii — with the former eventually selected by a whopping 75% of 1.2 million mail-in votes. Some 500 million copies of the stamp — three times the usual run — were printed by the USPS. Elvis would be honored with yet another commemorative stamp in 2015, making him the only musical artist with two USPS stamps featuring their likeness.

Elvis Purchased FDR's Old Presidential Yacht

During his presidency, Franklin Delano Roosevelt recommissioned a 165-foot former Coast Guard cutter known as the USS Potomac as his official presidential yacht. Dubbed the “floating White House,” the yacht went largely unused after FDR passed away in 1945, though it was later purchased by Elvis Presley in 1964 for \$55,000. Elvis didn't purchase the yacht for personal use, however; instead, he donated it to St. Jude Children's Hospital in 1964 so that they could resell it to raise money.

The yacht isn't the only presidential connection that Elvis shares. Genealogists also discovered that Elvis is actually a sixth cousin once removed of President Jimmy Carter.

Hippos Can't Swim or Float

The word “hippopotamus” means “river horse” in Greek, which makes sense given the amount of time — about 16 hours a day — these massive creatures spend in the water. But as it turns out, hippos can’t actually swim or even float. Their dense bones and heavy bodies cause them to sink, and their short legs and broad structure aren’t built for moving through water as easily as other aquatic mammals.

What they can do, thanks to that density, is stand sturdily on a waterbed’s floor and walk or bounce along the ground. With their eyes and nostrils located high on their heads, they can still see and breathe while almost completely submerged. Although they prefer the shallower parts of lakes, rivers, and swamps — typically around 6 feet deep — they’ve been observed in waters as deep as 40 feet, which they can propel themselves above by leaping like porpoises off the bottom. Even when they sleep, they can hold their breath for only about five minutes before an automatic reflex ensures they rise to the surface for air so they can rest without drowning.

The water isn’t just a playground for these creatures — it’s vital to their survival. Staying submerged helps keep their sensitive skin cool and hydrated under the hot African sun. It isn’t until dusk that they emerge and spend the next eight hours or so on land, grazing on grasses, before returning to their aquatic refuge when the sun reappears.

Hippos Can Outrun Humans.

The second-largest land animals after elephants, by some counts, with males weighing up to 9,920 pounds, hippopotamuses are notoriously aggressive and dangerous to humans. Luckily, humans can easily outrun these lumbering creatures on land, right? Well, no. When galloping, hippos can reach speeds of 19 miles per hour, whereas the average running speed of a human male is around 8 miles per hour. So if you ever come across a hippo in the wild, a minimum safe distance may be much farther away than you might think.

Facts:

A hippo can open its jaw 180 degrees.

The hippo’s closest living relative is the whale.

The longest human breath held under water is 29 minutes.

Hippos eat an average of 88 pounds of food a day.

The Kid Who Sang “I Want A Hippopotamus for Christmas” Actually Got One

In 1953, 10-year-old Oklahoma child Gayla Peevey recorded the quirky holiday tune “I Want a Hippopotamus for Christmas.” After the song became a hit, an Oklahoma City zoo and a local newspaper launched a statewide funding drive, encouraging people to chip in so they could give Peevey the very thing she sang about.
