RECIPE OF THE MONTH



OVEN BAKED RICE KRISPIE TREATS

Ingredients

6 Tbs butter 16 oz Jumbo marshmallows
1 1/2 tsp vanilla 8 cups Rice Krispie cereal (divided)
Optional: chocolate chips, M&M mini candies, or holiday appropriate sprinkles

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees.
2. Spray 9 X 13 baking dish with non-stick spray.
3. Add butter and vanilla to the bottom.
4. Pour in the marshmallows, distributing evenly over the bottom of the pan.
5. Add 6 cups of cereal over the top of the marshmallows, spreading evenly.
6. Bake for 20 minutes.
7. Remove from the oven and, using a spatula, mix to combine all ingredients.
8. Add the remaining cereal (and any optional ingredients); mix and pat down well.
9. Cool for a few hours. Cut and serve.



FROM THE OFFICE

We had 5 great years, she adapted quickly to dealing with senior citizens, what the rules were, what I would say, etc. but most importantly, how to deal with “stupid”. It takes a certain personality to do her job, and I will miss her immensely. Best wishes to her in the next chapter of her life.

That being said, I have not hired anyone to replace her yet. I am looking for that unique person who has some big shoes to fill. In the meantime, Yvette will be helping out for the first week of the month, and as needed. If you want a one-on-one meeting with me, you will need to make an appointment. I will make myself available from 9:30 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. to 2:30 p.m. by appointment only. I already work from home everyday; some days I come into the office as early as 8:30 a.m. to do certain things that I need the files for.....my pet peeve is people who knock on the door just because they noticed my car there! I am not going to answer the door, the office hours (with some exceptions, such as food days) have been the same for 14 years, so don’t think just because I am there that I want to be disturbed! My employment agreement with Mr. Larson does not include ANY days in the office as long as someone is there during most of the posted hours, I get money in the bank, oversee Roy, and have a handle on the things that I can control in the park (lawn service is not one of them)! more time with my family”, and they know they come first. For those of you who have seen my paycheck, you know that I don’t work for the money (hahahahaha).

Complaint forms are usually on the office door; someone recently asked what I do with them. First, I determine the validity of the complaint. . . .is it really an office issue or a neighbor problem? Is it regarding something that has been discussed in the “News and Views” or the Resident’s Monthly Update Meeting, which you don’t bother to attend? I am not in the habit of repeating myself. Is it based on facts or gossip? The importance of these forms is if I need to evict someone based on rule violations, then they become supporting documents. If I feel you have a genuine concern, I will usually reach out to discuss it. Not signing the form makes it invalid. . . .if you won’t sign it, I am not going to take the time to pursue it.

Now that the weather is cooling off, and the rain is slowing down, I will be doing more carport and yard inspections. Bottom line, if you have medical reasons why you cannot maintain your lot, it is up to you to hire someone to do it for you in a timely manner. This includes having your mobile power washed once a year, per park rules. You are responsible for every tree, shrub, flower bed, etc. in your yard except the palm tree, if there is still one there, out by the sidewalk. It doesn’t matter if you planted it or not, you certainly knew it was there when you purchased the mobile and signed the lease.

Just a reminder that all paint colors must be approved by the office, and any fences, sheds, etc. must first be approved by the office; if I advise you that it needs to be permitted and you choose not to get one, you will be in violation of park rules. Several people ignored me when I told them they needed to get a permit to put carports backup; now they are dealing with the city and could be told to remove them and start over again! Carports are required per the prospectus; I am aware that some people still do not have one; several mobiles were sold between the hurricane and now, so I am giving the new owners a little leeway on getting their carport installed. They all signed a letter upon closing that they knew they had to install a carport.

Yes, the Canadians are returning. Some have decided to sell for personal, financial or health reasons; the Canadian medical insurance can get quite expensive, the Canadian dollar is weak, as they get older maintaining 2 homes becomes hard, etc. There was a group of French Canadians in the RV section that decided Embassy wasn’t for them, so they won’t be returning. As I submit this article, I am getting ready to go up north for 10 days; it's my last hurrah until April (for those who are keeping track of when I am gone)!

RENT INCREASE

As you know, the rent is subject to change once a year, and all residents must be sent a notice post-marked no later than October 1st of the current year. The increase is based on multiple factors, all of which are spelled out in your prospectus, which everyone is given when they purchase a mobile home in the park. For those who have lived here a long time, everyone was mailed an updated prospectus on May 1, 2019.

Here are some of the increases used to arrive at this year's increase:

The increase in the Consumer Price Index, which was 3 % ($\$740 \times .03 = \22.20)

The percentage of increase in social security payments for the preceding year, 3.2% ($\$740 \times .032 = \23.68)

The current one (1) year interest notes for one (1) year certificates of deposit in excess of \$100,000 was 4.30 % ($\$740 \times .043 = \31.82)

The amount of interest charged on fixed rate thirty-year mortgages by recognized financial institutions making loans in Pinellas County was 6.61% ($\$740 \times 6.61 = \48.91)

Just these 4 items add up to \$126.61; this does not take into consideration the following increases:

City of Largo, on August 5th, 2025, increased solid waste, stormwater, and wastewater a total of 30% a month, effective October 1, 2025. This is the second year in a row.

There was a four-year water rate increase plan for FY24 through FY27; the monthly base charge increases \$1.25 for each residence, plus \$.025 per gallon of usage for FY25. At the same time, sewer rates were increased \$0.82 per residence and \$0.30 per gallon.

The garbage rate was increased, the pool cleaning was increased, the lift station service rates were increased, etc. Insurance and taxes increased. The cost of Hurricane Milton cleanup was over \$300,000 between tree cutting and damage to electrical poles and boxes.

The Rent Committee offered several days and times for residents to meet and discuss rent increases. **The common misconception is that residents think they should be receiving something "more" for each rent increase.** As the above figures show, the increase is to partially cover the increased cost of doing business, not a larger profit. There is an annual comparison chart put out each year for Pinellas County, which shows comparable rents; you can review a copy in my office. Embassy has been in the bottom 20% for many years.

I will be happy to discuss any concerns with you; I suggest you make an appointment during office hours so I can set aside time to talk to you. I will also take questions at the October Monthly Residents Update Meeting on October 15th, at 9:30 a.m. in the Clubhouse.






