Yom Kipper

Have you ever wondered what Yom Kipper was meant to celebrate? After seeing it for so many years on my calendar, I decided to check it out. Thought someone else may be interested also.

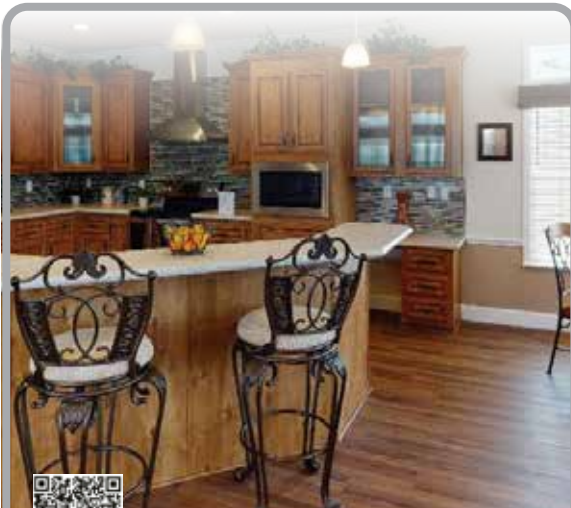
Yom Kippur literally means the "Day of Atonement". The holiday is just a few days after the Jewish new year. Although differences are noticeable within each branch of Judaism, the underlying principles involved in Yom Kippur are the same. Yom Kippur is a time for individuals to atone for their sins of the past year.

The "five rules" of Yom Kippur, also known as the five afflictions, are prohibitions against eating and drinking, wearing leather shoes, bathing or washing (except for cleansing dirt), anointing oneself with oils or lotions, and engaging in marital relations. These abstentions are meant to minimize physical distractions and allow focus on the spiritual purpose of the day: repentance, prayer, and reconciliation with God and fellow humans.

Here are the five afflictions in detail:

- Prohibition of Food and Drink: This is the most well-known custom, a complete fast from both food and water for the entire 25-hour period of Yom Kippur.
- Prohibition on Wearing Leather Shoes: Wearing shoes made of leather is avoided, as it is considered a luxury and a physical comfort.
- Prohibition on Bathing or Washing: Full bathing or washing is forbidden. However, washing for cleanliness or to remove dirt is generally permitted.
- Prohibition on Anointing: Anointing the body with oils, perfumes, or lotions is not permitted.
- Prohibition on Marital Relations: Intimate relations between spouses are forbidden on Yom Kippur.

These prohibitions help create a heightened spiritual atmosphere, allowing individuals to concentrate on inner purification and atonement.

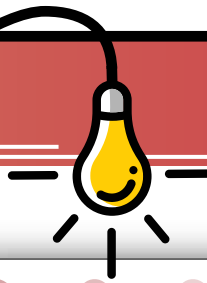

Halloween Snack Mix – (10 minutes) Quick and Easy

Ingredients:

- 2½ cups Cheez-its
- 2½ cups Bugles
- 2½ cups pretzels small or mini
- 1 cup peanuts salted or unsalted
- 3 tablespoons vegetable oil I use peanut oil
- 1 ounce dry Ranch Salad Dressing and Seasoning Mix
- 2 cups assorted Halloween candy

Instructions:

1. Combine the Cheez-its, Bugles, pretzels, and peanuts in a gallon-size plastic storage bag or large bowl.
2. Drizzle the vegetable oil over the mixture and shake the bag gently, or toss it if in a bowl, to coat the mixture evenly.
3. Add the dry Ranch dressing mix and shake again, or toss it if in a bowl, to coat the mixture evenly.
4. When you are ready to serve it, place the snack mix in a bowl, and add the candy.

Notes:

- You can replace my snack ingredients with your favorite snacks or dry cereal like Chex Mix, popcorn, Goldfish, mini Wheat Thins, oyster crackers, sesame sticks, etc.; you get the idea. You can even make it gluten-free by substituting gluten-free snacks.
- Instead of peanuts, feel free to substitute roasted pecans, almonds, pistachios, or a nut mix.
- As far as candy, shop the grocery store candy aisle to find your favorite candy. Candy corn is always a favorite, as are mellow creme or jelly pumpkins. Orange and black jelly beans, skittles, or M&Ms are also a great choice. I sometimes include edible can-dy eyeballs to give it a little personality. Or, you can leave the candy out altogether.
- You can also use this recipe to make a holiday or special occasion-specific snack mix, by swapping out holiday-specific candy.
- You can make it ahead and store your Monster Munch Halloween Snack Mix in a tightly sealed Ziploc plastic storage bag on your kitchen counter for up to a week. I think it keeps better if you wait to add the candy until right before you are ready to serve it, but I've stored it with and without the candy, and it still stays fresh for over a week.
- This recipe calls for a package of dry Ranch salad dressing mix. Do not use the liquid salad dressing.
- A one-ounce package of dry Ranch dressing equals about two tablespoons.

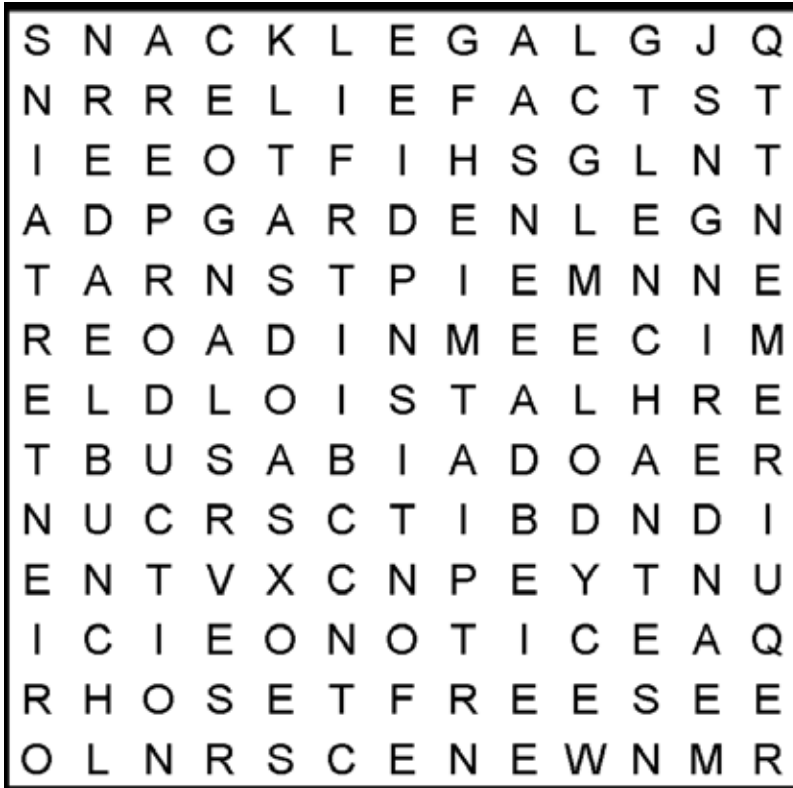

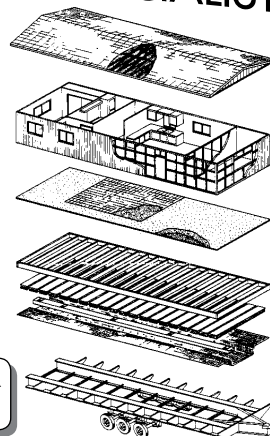
