

into the compactor. You will need to wait till the bulk trash container is brought into the community each month. See Voice calendar for dates dumpster is scheduled each month.

Don't forget to break down your cardboard boxes before throwing them in the mixed recycle bins. If the recycling bins are full do not overfill them, the lids should be able to lay flat. Put your recycled items in the compactor instead. When the city comes to take the recycling bins all the "over" loaded trash ends up on our streets. **Please! Please! Think before you overload those containers.**

Please do not bring large items furniture etc. that need to be placed in the Bulk dumpster that is brought into the community twice a month. Check the Voice calendar for dates each month and hold those large items at your home till the container is brought on site.

BIOMEDICAL WASTE

The Editors:

Recent post on FYI Lincolnshire a reminder to many of our residents that have **needles or test strips that these items are a biomedical waste product.** There are needle collection programs in Pinellas County that can help you dispose of needles, syringes with needles, test strips and lancets that have been used by you or a family member in the treatment at home of an allergy, acute illness or chronic disease, such as diabetes.

Sharps Disposal Program safely collects needles, syringes and other potentially dangerous items and properly disposes of them to ensure the safety of Pinellas County residents and visitors.

What are Sharps? They are items having the potential to puncture or lacerate. **They can cause injuries to waste collectors and potentially spread illnesses such as hepatitis or HIV.**

How the Pinellas County program works: Be a careful user and protect others and our

environment. No cost to you.

- Visit one of the participating disposal sites listed below
- Ask for an approved sharps container and brief instructions on use.
- As needed, perform your injection, and then dispose of the syringes or lancets completely intact into the container.
- Once the container is filled, seal it properly and return it to one of the participating collection sites for proper disposal. Always hand the filled and properly sealed sharps container to authorized personnel. Never leave a sharps container unattended.

VETERAN'S CORNER

This month I would like to focus on an area that is a big problem in FL and the country. Are you aware that we have almost four thousand homeless Vets in Florida. Although that number may not seem significant When you are sleeping on the streets and subject to the harsh weather in Florida, we can have heat rain and even sometimes cold it can take a toll on anybody. Plus, many do not know where their next meal will come from. It is easy to say this is their choice, it is not that easy.

Homeless veterans are individuals who have served in the military and are currently experiencing homelessness. They are at a higher risk for homelessness due to various challenges, including mental illness, substance abuse, and disabilities. While considerable progress has been made in reducing veteran homelessness, the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) and various partner organizations continue to provide a range of services, including housing assistance, employment support, and healthcare through programs like HUD-VASH. Homeless veterans are disproportionately older, often have disabilities, serious mental illness, or substance abuse problems. Factors such as financial hardship, unemployment, depression, and addiction can increase a veteran's risk of homelessness.


As many of you may or may not know, I am the Veterans Chair for the Largo Elks, and I am on the City of LARGOs Veterans Committee. Because of this I get to see a lot more of the issues with homelessness than many of you do. I also have quarterly meetings with several groups at Bay Pines VA Center in ST Pete so that heightens my awareness of some of the issues that affect our Veterans. Recently Bay Pines had a Standdown for homeless Veterans. A standdown brings in homeless Veterans and provides them with free medical services, haircuts, legal advice and helps them hook up with agencies that can help them. There are also many organizations there giving them clothing, supplies etc.

My organization, the Largo Elks Veterans Committee, hosted and served breakfast at the standdown for 414 local homeless veterans so I hope this gives you an idea of homelessness just in our regional area. We also work with the VA HUD-VASH, this program combines rental assistance with case management and clinical services provided by the VA to help homeless veterans find and keep permanent housing. We have delivered 218 Welcome Home Kits in the last couple of years. We work with the Social Workers at the VA HUD-Vash to get homeless Veterans off the street and into an apartment. The Welcome Home Kits consist of dishes, pots and pans, silverware, small appliances, a bed etc. everything they would need to set up their apartments. So, we have helped get 218 Veterans off the street.

Bay Pines also runs a food pantry for homeless Veterans, and I normally am able to collect enough food every month to bring a box or two to the food pantry. The other issues that some of the Veterans have even after getting into an apartment because of some of their diminished mental capacities is that they sometimes have trouble with finances and get




