And somehow turned life's hardest lessons into something soft to teach.

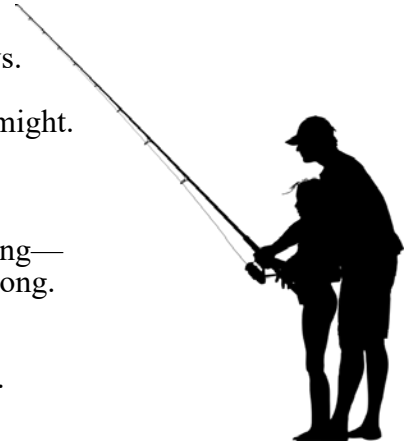
Always in the background, never asking for the praise,

SUMMER PASTA

Ingredients

- 8 oz (226 g) linguine pasta or preferred noodle pasta, uncooked
- ¼ cup (60 ml) extra virgin olive oil
- 1 cup (110 g) finely chopped onion sweet, yellow, or white onion, I like sweet (about ½ large onion)
- 6 large cloves garlic thinly sliced
- 24 oz (680 g) cherry tomatoes about 6 cups
- ½ teaspoon granulated sugar
- ½ teaspoon table salt plus additional for cooking pasta and to taste/as needed
- ¼ teaspoon ground black pepper
- ¼ heaping teaspoon dried thyme
- ¼ teaspoon crushed red pepper
- 1 oz (28 g) fresh basil leaves shredded or cut into ribbons (about 1/3 cup)
- ⅓ cup freshly grated or shredded parmesan cheese plus more for topping



Instructions

- Cook pasta in well-salted water according to package instructions. Before draining, reserve 1/2 cup of pasta water and set aside.
- 8 oz (226 g) linguine pasta
- Meanwhile, in a large skillet, heat oil over medium heat until shimmering.
- ¼ cup (60 ml) extra virgin olive oil
- Add onion and cook, stirring occasionally, until softened, then add garlic and cook about 30-60 seconds longer, until fragrant.
- 1 cup (110 g) finely chopped onion, 6 large cloves garlic
- Add tomatoes, sugar, salt, pepper, thyme, and red pepper and cook, stirring frequently until tomatoes soften and burst. Once tomatoes are soft enough you can use a wooden spoon or spatula to squish them as you stir.
- 24 oz (680 g) cherry tomatoes, ½ teaspoon granulated sugar, ½ teaspoon table salt, ¼ teaspoon ground black pepper, ¼ heaping teaspoon dried thyme, ¼ teaspoon crushed red pepper
- Add basil and stir.
- 1 oz (28 g) fresh basil leaves
- Add warm cooked, drained linguine and stir well. Add splashes of pasta water as needed to make a thin sauce, you basically want to ensure the pasta is not dry and the noodles are coated with a thin layer of the sauce. I typically need to add about ¼ cup of the pasta water.
- Remove from heat, add parmesan and stir well. Taste-test and add additional salt or pepper as needed, then serve warm topped with additional parmesan as desired with a side salad or side of crusty bread.
- ⅓ cup freshly grated or shredded parmesan cheese

Penelope, the 9-year-old granddaughter of Jody Gramley, has faced more in a matter of weeks than most do in a lifetime. Through every hospital stay, every test, and every unknown, Penelope has shown a level of strength far beyond her years. No matter what is scheduled for the day or how she is feeling, she continues to greet each morning with a smile. Her positivity, even in the hardest moments, has been a source of inspiration to her family, her care team, and everyone following her journey. She fights through each day with quiet determination, showing resilience that words can hardly capture.



Even as she approached her surgery on April 29th—a life-changing step toward giving her the best chance at a long, healthy, and mobile future—Penelope faced it with courage and grace. Now home from the hospital, she is recovering remarkably well, continuing to show that same brave spirit as she heals and prepares for the next phase of treatment. While the road ahead still includes weeks of recovery and many more rounds of chemotherapy, her strength continues to shine through each step forward.

But Penelope's journey is not one she walks alone. Surrounding her is a circle of unwavering love—family, friends, and an entire community determined to lift her up. At Honeymoon Park, where her grandmother Jody is a cherished member, residents rallied together in an outpouring of compassion and generosity.

Led by Denise Allen, the community organized a heartfelt initiative to support Penelope and her family during this incredibly challenging time. Recognizing the emotional and financial strain that accompanies such a diagnosis, neighbors came together to contribute what they

could—cards filled with encouragement, prayers, and financial donations to ease the burden.

The response was nothing short of extraordinary. In just a short time, the community raised over \$3,700 to help fund Penelope's first prosthetic leg—an essential step in her journey toward recovery and mobility. Penelope's story is one of unimaginable challenge, but also one of hope, strength, and the incredible power of community. 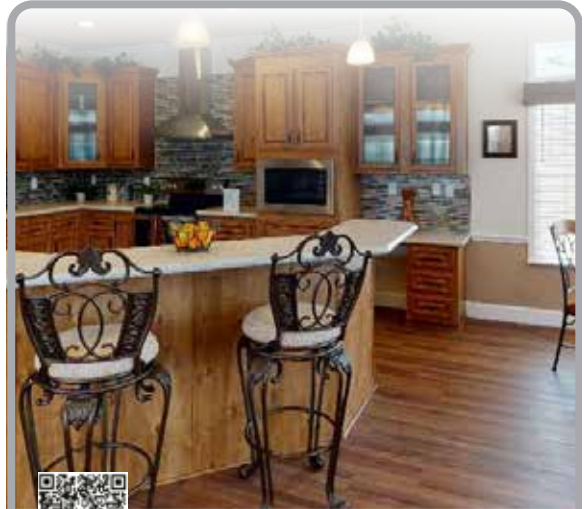

Try ginger for its health benefits

Looking to get over a cold a little more quickly, or ease muscle soreness? A little ginger may help. Check out this list of ginger’s healthy benefits from the Huffington Post website:



- **The common cold.** Some research suggests that ginger helps your body sweat out a cold, as well as producing a germ-fighting agent called dermicidin, which can protect you from bacteria and fungi.

- **Muscle aches.** One study by the American Pain Society found that taking two grams of ginger for 11 days can significantly reduce aches and muscle soreness caused by exercise. That’s because ginger contains anti-inflammatory compounds known as gingerols, which prevent the transmission of pain from inflammation. Try adding a few slices of ginger every time you drink a glass of water.

- **Indigestion.** Ginger can help speed up the digestive process, allowing you to empty your stomach faster. It also helps eliminate excess gas from the intestinal tract.

Watch out for ‘masked’ hypertension

Being diagnosed with high blood pressure may be scary, but thinking your blood pressure is normal when it’s not? Scarier still.

The Live Science website reports that almost one in eight Americans who believe their blood pressure is just fine may really have a masked form of hypertension that doesn’t show up when they visit their doctors. Instead their blood pressure is elevated during their daily activities, so they may be at increased risk of heart disease without realizing it. To diagnose masked hypertension, researchers suggest wearing 12-hour blood pressure monitors that take readings through the day.

The flip side of this phenomenon is so-called “white-coat hypertension,” in which patients’ blood pressure increases at the doctor’s office (possibly from nervousness?) but is normal the rest of the time. Unlike masked hypertension, these people don’t appear to be at a higher risk of heart disease.
