Women Working Wonders (WWW)

I have been asked what is “Women Working Wonders” (WWW). It is a group of volunteer ladies that live here in Fairway Village. Our main goal is to try and make things easier for our 90+ year old residents and shut ins.



We meet every 1st Monday of the month at 11 a.m. in the clubhouse. We welcome seasonal or full-time volunteers. We have volunteers who remain active year-round. We assign year-round residents to those volunteers who are full-time, as well. We serve our 90+ residents year-round.

We ask our volunteers to visit or call their clients twice a month for an “Eyes on” gathering. This is done at the volunteer’s convenience. Our residents love food and sweets. It is a great idea to drop off leftovers and desserts. (Just saying 😊)

We deliver donuts to our residents every third Saturday of every month. Information and deadlines for orders are provided.

When offered, we deliver Thanksgiving meals. Three light meals are delivered in January, February and March.

We provide you with a welcome packet for new residents. This includes some small gifts and information for the new residents. A special magnet name tag will be given with the volunteer's name and telephone number on it to place on the refrigerator. We also provide WWW badges.

If you are not available to deliver food or donuts at any given time, a volunteer will pick up that request for you. Just contact the Chairperson, Kristy Williams.

When you become a WWW volunteer, you will have a mentor assigned to you to go to your first client's interview. You will be given a special gift bag with information for that person. You will always have someone to call in case you need any kind of help or information.

We also provide and deliver "remembrances" (small gifts) for Christmas, Valentines Day and Easter. This will be the volunteer's responsibility to deliver these.

We have several men who help us with WWW. Recently, smoke alarms were checked and serviced for the 90+ residents who are here year-round. In the fall when we welcome back our snowbirds, we will check their smoke alarms as well.

We have helped with pre-registration forms for Pinellas County for hurricane evacuations - especially the Seniors with special needs. Contact Kristy Williams, Chairperson at 727-218-8121.

We are working with the Office of the Aging in trying to obtain Meals on Wheels, cleaning and transportation for our residents. These are all FREE services. Contact Kathy Sturdee at 727-421-7063.

We will also be helping with the 90th Birthday Party for our residents who will turn 90 this year. Please contact Jamie Sgarrini at 678-938-8924 if you know of anyone turning 90 in 2027 so we can include them in this special occasion.

CREDIT CARD DEBT ON THE RISE

Financial counselors usually advise consumers to pay off their credit cards every month, but more Americans are carrying credit card debt from month to month since the most recent recession, according to the National Foundation for Credit Counseling.

A survey of more than 1,600 U.S. adults conducted in March found that 39 percent carry debt from month to month, up from 35 percent in 2016. Sixteen percent are carrying more than \$2,500 monthly, compared with 14 percent last year.

Other results from the survey: Younger adults were more likely than older adults to be denied a credit card (11 percent vs. 6 percent). They were also more likely to make a late credit card payment (11 percent vs. 5 percent), miss a payment (12 percent vs. 4 percent) or pay less than the minimum amount required (13 percent vs. 3 percent).

ONLINE SHOPPING: THE LATEST STATS

Shopping online is big business these days. A survey of more than 1,000 U.S. consumers by e-commerce platform provider Big commerce found that 96 percent of Americans shop online, accounting for 36 percent of their purchases.

The survey found that 80 percent of consumers make online purchases at least once a month, and 30 percent buy something at least once a week. Forty-eight percent reported spending more than they had originally intended.

Millennials do half their shopping online. Sixty-seven percent of them, along with 56 percent of Generation Xers, would rather shop via the internet, a preference shared by 41 percent of Baby Boomers but only 28 percent of senior citizens.

DISENGAGED MILLENNIALS HUNTING FOR NEW JOBS

An overwhelming majority of millennials aren't terribly interested in their existing jobs, according to new research from Gallup. The research found that 71 percent of employees born between 1980 and 1996 are either not engaged or actively disengaged at work.

Disengaged employees are usually short-timers. Nearly half of them—47 percent—say they plan to switch jobs during the next 12 months, as long as the overall employment picture brightens.

Millennials will represent about half the workforce in just three years; the cohort behind them, Generation Z, will probably exhibit many of the same preferences.



GIVING UP ON LOSING WEIGHT?

The obesity trend in the United States continues, with the number of adults who are either overweight or obese expanding from 53 percent to 66 percent over a 26-year period from 1998 to 2014. Apparently many of us have given up trying to fight it. According to the Journal of the American Medical Association (JAMA), the number of people actively trying to lose weight in the past year dropped from 56 percent to 48 percent over the same period.



Researchers theorize that the decline is due to changing perceptions about acceptable body weight.

ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE IS COMING

Artificial intelligence sounds scary in science fiction stories and movies, but it's becoming a big factor in business success, according to a report from Tata Consultancy Services. Its survey of 834 executives across 13 global industry sectors found that 84 percent of organizations see AI as essential, and 50 percent believe it will transform their businesses.

AI doesn't appear to be cheap, though. Seven percent of business survey said they invested more than \$250 million on AI in 2016.

LOOK TO THE PAST AND THE FUTURE TO SPUR CREATIVITY TODAY

“What could have been” and “what might be” are good considerations for creative discussions. Taking the opportunity to pursue these topics can lead to new insights and ideas. Try the following scenarios and see what emerges:

- **“What could have been.”** Choose one of your most important successes or failures—at work, it might be a retention program that surpassed expectations or a customer who got away—and investigate why it turned out that way. Your goal isn’t to assign blame or credit—presumably, that’s already been done—but to look for what might have been done differently. Was a particular benefit or perk an unexpected hit? Did you overlook one of the customer’s key concerns? Then ask how you can apply what you’ve discovered.
- **“What might be.”** The future is always a good topic for imagination. For example, ask your employees to imagine yourself at your most enthusiastic and productive. What would your job look like in terms of facilities, training, daily tasks, and so on? Consider how you can apply what you’ve discovered.



THREE CONDITIONS FOR INSPIRATION

Sometimes we need to find the right environment to be creative. When you’re trying to come up with a brilliant (or just workable) idea, set up these conditions:

- **Boundaries.** Set clear parameters—time, budget, materials, and/or other resources. When you know you have only limited resources to work with, you’ll be more open to combining existing ideas in new ways.
- **Pressure.** Set a realistic but firm deadline. Knowing you have to accomplish your task by a fixed date will focus your thinking.
- **Discomfort.** Don’t do only what’s easy and familiar. Challenge yourself to step outside of your comfort zone. You’ll learn more by stretching yourself and taking new and different paths.
