


LINE DANCE PARTY



So, to all that worked hard to make this "Golden Anniversary" happen, I say Thank You from the bottom of my heart.



RUBEN CASSEROLE

Ingredients:

- 7 cups cubed pumpernickel bread (about 10 slices)
- 1/3 cup of butter, melted
- 1 lb. thinly sliced deli corned beef, coarsely chopped
- 1/2 cup Thousand Island dressing
- 1 can (14 oz) sauerkraut, thoroughly drained
- 1 teaspoon caraway seed
- 2 cups shredded Swiss cheese (8 oz)
- Additional Thousand Island dressing, if desired

Instructions:

- Heat oven to 400°F. Spray 13x9-inch (3-quart) glass baking dish with cooking spray. In large bowl, mix bread cubes and melted butter; toss to mix well.
- Place 4 cups of bread cubes in baking dish. Top with layers as follows: 2 cups of corned beef, 1/2 cup dressing, the sauerkraut, caraway seed, 1 cup of the cheese, remaining corned beef and remaining 3 cups bread cubes. Cover with foil; bake for 25 minutes.
- Remove foil; sprinkle with remaining 1 cup cheese. Bake for 5 to 10 minutes or until cheese is melted and casserole is heated through. Serve with additional dressing.

Tips:



- **Copy writing.** From advertising to in-depth web content, words are still important. Putting together readable, useful copy is an important skill, even in an age of multimedia.




