

I would like to thank everyone who sent in their proxies and ballots for the annual election for members of the Board of Directors. Reelected were Connie Holmes, Pat Reveria, and Bob Barr filling three of the four open positions. The fourth person elected this year was Tim Glasheen. As a side note “Not fully funding our reserves” was approved once again, which means we will have a lower monthly maintenance fee for the next 12 months (yea).

With the retirement of Gene Arend as a board member:

I would like to thank Gene on behalf of the Board of Directors and our community for at least 14 years of volunteer service as a board member and as President of the board. He has guided us through multiple repair and improvement projects. His experience as a project manager, in a former life, has been invaluable in keeping projects on track and providing a lot of sage advice throughout the years, whether he oversaw the board or was just another member performing assigned duties.

He was the first to make and set up a long-term budget analysis which has helped guide us to a sound financial position. Some of his jobs assigned or as a backup to other board members has been lawns, water line repairs, renovation of kitchen and bathrooms in the clubhouse, clubhouse event calendar, replacement to clubhouse circuit breaker boxes, new pool equipment and power, new power lines to the clubhouse after original lines failed, new doors and fob system for the clubhouse and much more.

Dogs in the NO PET section of Briar Creek #1?

Have you ever asked yourself why you live on the south side of Briar Creek (physical) and cannot have a dog for a pet? The original developers made it that way. In fact, in the beginning the entire community was NO PET!

In 2006 the *APPROVED AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDED AND RESTATED RESTRICTIONS OF BRIAR CREEK MOBILE HOME COMMUNITY 1 – A CONDOMINIUM* was changed by vote at the Annual Members Meeting. It read, in part,

17. Pets shall be permitted, but only on that portion of Briar Creek Mobile Home Community I designated by the Board of Directors as the area where pets can be kept. Effective immediately, the Park shall be divided into two (2) parts, the "pet section" and the "cat only" section. In the "pet section" Pets, as defined herein, pets shall be restricted to one (1) domesticated cat or one (1) domesticated dog of a breed that shall not exceed more than twenty-five (25) pounds when mature (such as poodle, terrier, pekinese). In the "cat only" section, no pets shall be permitted except one (1) domesticated cat which must be kept inside the residence at all times. No other pets of any kind, nor more than one (1) of the described pets at any time, shall be permitted in any residence...The lot owner will be required to maintain the pet at all times under a leash. Any pet causing, creating, or contributing to a nuisance or unreasonable disturbance or annoyance or noise shall be permanently removed from the Park upon ten (10) days written notice from the Board. The Board's decision that a pet constitutes a nuisance, or that it creates an unreasonable disturbance or annoyance or noise shall be conclusive. Lot owners wishing to have pets other than a dog or cat must have prior approval of the Board of Directors. Authorized areas for pet shall be established by rules adopted by the Board of Directors (copied)

The only waiver to this community guideline is the Federal law which allows for a SERVICE animal or an ESA (Emotional Support Animal) of which papers MUST be completed and approved before the animal is brought into the community.

This item was brought up at the November Directors Meeting and has been tabled until the January Directors Meeting. It takes a vote of the entire community to change the documents.



Headaches

I have had patients who have told me that they have suffered from headaches their entire life. Headaches have various patterns. Some headaches can be felt along the sides of the head in the temporal region. Another headache may appear toward the top of the head and the parietal region. Some headaches are experienced behind the eyes and toward the back of the head in the occipital region. Many folks have been diagnosed with migraine type headaches which can be associated with dizziness and nausea. Headaches that affect the mucous membranes are referred to as sinus headaches. Headaches may have a diagnostic orientation associated with toxins, spinal misalignment, chemical imbalances, and thought and emotional integrity. Some patients have described their head pain as a dull ache, as well as sharp and pounding. When people have headaches for years as a norm, they will usually categorize it as, oh I can live with this, or i can't function at all.

It is only when we learn to distinguish what we are feeling and how we are reacting to circumstances in our lives that we can discover an opportunity to become healthier. The more we feel stuck the more we continue to react the same way, and the more hopeless we can feel. Only when we change our paradigm and shift our consciousness can change and transformation occur.




