PARKING POLICY

Briar Creek 1 Parking Policy – Effective June 1 2026

There are 3 common parking areas: BC Mart, Laundry, and Shuffle Board (East) Side of the Clubhouse.

ALL OVERNIGHT PARKING (10 pm to 7 am) REQUIRES A PARKING PERMIT (at office or on website). DAYTIME PARKING REQUIRES A BC STICKER, A VISTORS CAR REQUIRES A PARKING PERMIT.

Parking Permits will be approved/issued by the Director in charge of Parking (see office wall for the director). Drop completed permits in the mail slot in the office for approval.

COMMON AREA PARKING LOCATIONS

NOTE: PARKING PERMITS ARE LIMITED TO A MAXIMUM OF 18 DAYS AT THE BC MART AND LAUNDRY BUILDING PER CALENDAR YEAR AND A MAXIMUM OF 28 DAYS AT THE EAST CLUBHOUSE LOT. There MUST be an approved Parking Permit on the inside windshield.

1. The BC Mart and Laundry lots have multiple spaces available marked as "GUEST". **Limited to a Maximum of three (3) days, six (6) times per calendar year (non-consecutive).**

Note: The Laundry has three (3) spots identified with lettering on the ground for those doing laundry only, no overnight parking allowed.

2. The East Clubhouse (Shuffle Board) lot is for clubhouse guests, owner's guests and owner temporary parking (**48 hours to fourteen (14) days**). ***Limited to a Maximum of two (2) times per calendar year (Non-Consecutive)***. For temporary parkers, PLEASE park away from the shuffle board courts.

Note: We NEED to know who the car belongs to in the event of an unexpected situation, so they may be notified, rather than towed.

PLEASE NOTE: PARKING IN THE COMMON AREAS IS A COURTESY AND REQUIRES A PARKING PERMIT APPROVED BY THE DIRECTOR IN CHARGE OF PARKING!

Our guidelines state that you should be able to park your vehicles in your driveway. If they do not fit you are not allowed to park it in the street or on the Common Areas and it is your responsibility to find a place to store it.

As a homeowner, if you opt to rent your home, you **CANNOT** leave your vehicle in one of these lots during the rental period.

No sleeping in parked vehicles overnight.

If a vehicle is parked in a common area with no Permit (it can be towed):

1. A yellow card will be left on the vehicle asking the owner to contact the Director in charge of Parking within 24 hours.
2. If this is not done a second note will be left, and a letter will be sent from Ameri-Tech.
3. If a third time is required a note will be left informing the owner that a Fine may be issued. \$100.00 per day or a maximum of \$1,000.00 may be charged.

BOARD COMMUNICATION

The Board of Directors sends out email communication on items of importance that you need to know. They send out an email informing residents when there is a water leak and the water will need to be turned off, an upcoming Board of Directors Meeting and notification when the minutes of the meeting are available for you to read. There are also other items such as the lawn mowing schedule that the Board sends out to keep you informed. I know many residents have signed up and are getting these emails but if you are not, send your email information to our contact at Ameri-Tech Property Management – Laura Franzese at lfranzese@ameritechmail.com and she will add your information.



It has been brought to our attention that there are many homeowners that do not have a computer, cell phone or email address. If you are one of these homeowners, the Board suggests that you contact one of your neighbors that does have a computer and receives these communications and ask them to inform you of any communication from the Board that may affect them.

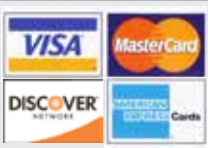

LAUNDRY BUILDING KEY

Access to the Laundry Building is by key only. At one time before we switched to Key FOBS the key for the Clubhouse also opened the Laundry Building. Once we converted to Key FOBS for the Clubhouse many people discarded their old keys to the Clubhouse. If you didn't keep your old key and you find you need a new key, I have the master key and can have one made for you at a charge of \$5.00 each.

FOBS

Al Hartin, Treasurer

It has been four years since the Association switched from keys to FOBs for the Clubhouse Doors and Pool Gates. This was done for increased security. In the past when a new owner purchased a home in Briar Creek, they were given a key and this could be readily copied and owners made keys for their children, or others so as a result there were probably thousand of keys for the Clubhouse and Pool floating around. Now that we have the FOBS owners are issued a FOB and there is a log of each time, they enter the Clubhouse or Pool. In addition, when owners sell or pass away the FOB can easily be turned off. Just a reminder having a FOB is for your security, you should never let anyone in the Pool or Clubhouse – if they are an owner they have a FOB.



A few reminders:

- If you are selling your home the FOB or FOBs issued to you should be either given to me or the buyer. Failure to do so will result in the new owner having to pay \$25.00 for a FOB. A prospective buyer fills out an application and that information is listed on it and also when Connie Holmes does the interview, she reminds the buyer that they need to get the FOB or FOBs from the seller. If you sell your home and give the FOB or FOBs to me, I will inform the new owner of this when they contact me for a FOB.
- If you happen to lose your FOB it will cost \$25.00 for a new one.

PRIVATE USE OF THE CLUBHOUSE

At the February 2026 Board Meeting the Board of Directors enacted a policy requiring any homeowner wishing to use the Clubhouse for a private event to purchase an Event Liability Policy. It is necessary to protect the assets of the Association and thus the requirement to purchase an Event Liability Policy to attain that goal.

This policy became effective May 1, 2026.

Dark Street, all of a sudden

Sometimes, we don't realize how much we appreciate some things, until they don't work!

Did you know that when a streetlight no longer illuminates its comforting light, it is easy to report it to Duke. Every pole has a number on a plate. Take notice of this number. Log on to Duke-Energy.com and look for Street and Area Light Reporting and follow the steps. The pole number and street address will be needed as well as contact information of the person reporting the light out. If you do not have internet access and are unable to recruit assistance from a neighbor or friend, call 800-521-2232 for help.

Hurricane Season Begins

June 1st through November 30th can sometimes keep us on our toes. Somethings to keep in mind includes preparations ahead of time. Know where to go if an evacuation is ordered. Make sure everything outside is brought inside or firmly secured so it doesn't become a flying object. Flashlights, batteries and perhaps battery-operated fans. Keep cell phone fully charged. Avoid burning candles. If you evacuate and power goes out, a tip on how to determine if freezer food is still safe is to freeze a small, closed container of water. On top of the ice, place a coin. When you check the situation, look at the coin. If it is still on top of the container, food is safe. If the coin has sunk to the bottom of the container, everything thawed. Probably not safe to eat.



Have all important documents with you. Have a small inventory of non-perishable foods. Bottled water. Pet food if you have fur children. Cash. Full tank of gas. If you choose to stay in place, be aware that emergency response will not be able to respond until the hurricane passes. Roads may be blocked from fallen trees or debris. Below is brief description of the local info to consider. More interesting information about the Tocobaga Tribe can be found on numerous sites, including Wikipedia.

Tocobaga Blessing for Safety Harbor

The Tocobaga tribe, known for their burial mounds in Safety Harbor, is believed to have blessed the area, providing a protective shield against hurricanes. While there is no scientific evidence to support this claim, it remains a cherished part of the local culture and community spirits.

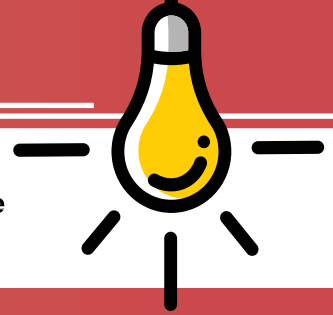

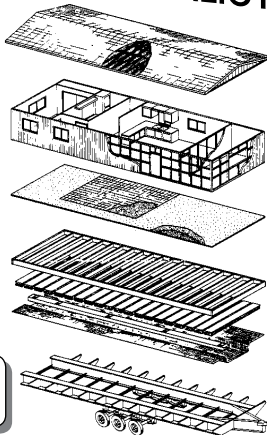

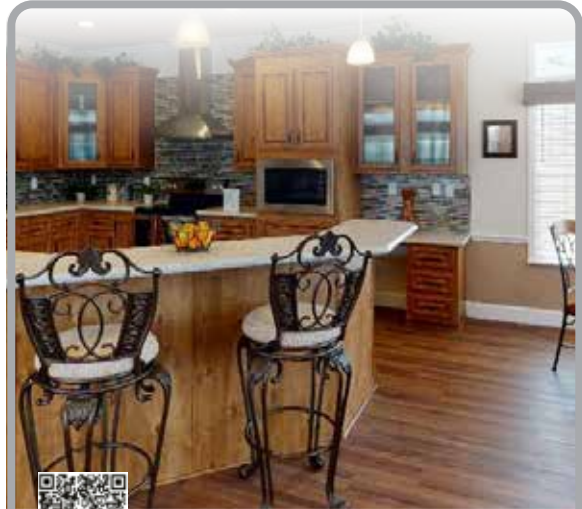

Saying Yes To Life

When we greet life with a yes, we can enter into new possibilities that can lead us to deeper abundance, new experiences that can change our lives, and empower our wellbeing. A simple yes when someone shares something that might assist us with whatever challenge we are facing can change our life. As simple as a yes might seem, we often respond to life with excuses, reasonable explanations, all of which sabotage what we may truly desire.

Often I meet people who share with me about their health problems, yet are resistant to hear about alternatives that may help them improve. Instead of seeing the opportunity as a yes, we immediately respond with rational reasons to stay on the same path hoping for a different outcome. I understand this phenomenon for I have been there. Either too lazy to change something or simply resisting change. We are creatures of collected habits, and change does not often come easy. I use to educate my patients on the importance of daily healthy strategies. And in my own discoveries of evolving I realized the importance of small steps. So whether it was a routine of exercise every day, or eating healthy each day, simple actions that could be achieved. Eventually after discovering what did not work for developing healthy lifestyles, I gave my patients 3- 5 minute exercise routines for stretching and strengthening to be done each day. If someone already had a routine where they went to an exercise class 3 times a week, that was great. But the secret was to develop an everyday mindset. Everyday we use our bodies and many hours are spent sitting or sleeping.

I use to laugh when I had folks say to me, well I heard you have to exercise at least an hour every day for it to be beneficial. My simple answer was, how is that working for you, in other words are you doing that. The answer was always No. Beginning something new is truly a mind game. It is easy if you are setting high goals to sabotage the process. You will hear the voice in your head say, I didn't have time today, something unexpected occurred, my car broke down, the answers of the saboteur are endless. But if the exercise only takes 5 minutes it becomes harder to deceive ourselves. Even then you will hear the voice say, I was so busy today, I will double up tomorrow. Say yes to baby steps and after a month or two you will find you want to exercise more for you are feeling value. More energy, more flexibility, feeling mentally more alert and clear headed. The same principals apply for nutrition. Diets fail because we eventually fall back to old habits and could not sustain the extremes of the new eating profile. Begin introducing more healthy foods, and slowly eliminating the unhealthy

foods and drinks. Saying yes to change can be very exciting. And truly the more we open up to change, the better we feel about ourselves.

As we journey into the next 25 years, ask yourself, what are the activities I want to be able to do and enjoy. More people are living to 100 years old these days. Some very lucky with great branches off their genetic tree, others by also being lucky to have a mindset that says Yes to change and a clear vision of the creative and fun activities to enjoy.
