

Heading North - here are a couple of reminders:

Make sure your summer address is registered with Ameri-Tech.

Sign up with Ameri-Tech, if you have not already done so. Keep yourself updated on board meetings and minutes. When your proxy comes, via email or snail mail, in early October, please return it as soon as you can.

If you can, sign in and follow us on the Zoom link when we are having a board meeting.

Leaving your Home:

- 1. Turn off your water at the outside shut-off valve!!!**
2. Empty your refrigerator – turn it off – leave the door(s) propped open.
3. Put a cup of bleach in each toilet then cover with plastic wrap.
4. Keep the air conditioning on to prevent mold. Set the thermostat to mid-80's or if you have a humidistat set it to 60% or what was recommended by the installer.
5. Have a great Spring/Summer/Fall, keep in touch, and above all do not forget to come back.



## BOARD COMMUNICATION

The Board of Directors sends out email communication on items of importance that you need to know. They send out an email informing residents when there is a water leak and the water will need to be turned off, an upcoming Board of Directors Meeting and notification when the minutes of the meeting are available for you to read. There are also other items such as the lawn mowing schedule that the Board sends out to keep you informed. It has been brought to our attention that there are many homeowners that do not have a computer, cell phone or email address. If you are one of these homeowners, the Board suggests that you contact one of your neighbors that does have a computer and receives these communications and ask them to inform you of any communication from the Board that may affect them.

## FINING POLICY

The Board of Directors at their February 2026 meeting voted to adopt a Fining Policy. It is the Board's responsibility to ensure that the Association Rules and Regulations are followed. Our intent is not to fine owners but rather to have compliance with the Rules and Regulations. To that point listed below is a synopsis of the Fining Policy to be used by the Board of Directors. The entire Policy can be found on [mybriarcreek.com](http://mybriarcreek.com).

- Non-Compliance Issues are as follows:
  - ◊ Pets in the No Pet Section
  - ◊ Failure to complete an Architectural Form for work done outside a residence
  - ◊ Parking Violations
  - ◊ Cluttered Carports

Not complying with Governing Documents

- An Owner notifies the Board of a violation of Association Rules and Regulations. The notification must be in writing on a Complaint/Concern Form located in the mail slots outside the Director's Office.
- A Board member verifies that the reported violation does in fact constitute a violation of Association Rules and Regulations.
- Management sends out the following notices:
  - ◊ 1st Violation Letter – notifies Owner of a violation and gives them 10 days from the date of the letter to either contact a Board member with a question/concern or correct the violation.

- ◇ If Owner has not responded within 10 days a 2nd Notice of Violation Letter will be sent giving the owner 7 days to respond or correct the violation.
- ◇ If Owner has not responded within 7 days, then a Violation/Fine Letter will be sent informing the Owner of the Date, Time and Location of the Fining Review Committee.
- ◇ The Fining Review Committee which is comprised of Owners and not any Board Member will make the decision if the fine is warranted or not. If it agrees with the Board, Owner will be notified that they will be fined \$100.00 per day or a maximum of \$1,000.00 until violation is corrected.

The Board realizes that all of us upon moving to Briar Creek were provided with a copy of the Rules and Regulations but as time goes by it is possible that an owner unintentionally did something that violated a Rule. In most instances sending a 1<sup>st</sup> Notice Letter will remind the Owner of the Rule and they can correct the situation.

**Y**ou may hear political campaign promises that include cutting or eliminating property tax and think that is a good idea. What you won't hear is the real result of cutting property taxes.

If you read in "City Scape" the article submitted by Safety Harbor City Manager, Josh Stefanic, you may recall some of the facts and details. Just a brief reminder here and now.

First, understand that property tax is based on the assessed value of the property. If you are a full-time Florida resident property owner, you may qualify for the Homestead Exemption which will reduce the amount of tax you are required to pay.

# Ping Pong

**T**able tennis (Ping Pong ) is a great game to play. Aside from being a lively, competitive sport, it is also playable at whatever ability level you find yourself. But did you know that it has some major health benefits as well? 1. It dramatically improves your reflexes. Thanks to the fast-paced nature of the game, your reflexes (both gross and fine motor skills) will improve as a result of consistent play. Reflexes are not only important in your daily life, but they help you avoid big and small accidents as you navigate through this world.
2. It improves eye hand coordination. A rally of table tennis will stimulate and improve your mental alertness and concentration. It also helps your mind and body develop mental acuity. Hand eye coordination is not only important because it helps with many different exercises as the eye sends signals to the brain which then sends signals to your arms and hands, they can also make everyday tasks such as writing and cooking easier as well.
3. It's low impact. Unlike running and lifting weights and other common forms of exercise, table tennis is low impact and easier on your joints. It's perfect if you are wary of back problems, have a history of spraining your ankles or falling. While you are moving constantly, you aren't making large movements.
4. It keeps you flexible. It may not seem like it , but table tennis requires quite a bit of flexibility. From stretching across the table from one end to another, to simply leaning down to pick up the ball, you are going to stretch out your muscles. It gives you a good cardiovascular workout.
5. It keeps your brain sharp. Table tennis is known as the one of the world's best brain sports because it is highly aerobic, uses both upper and lower body, requires good hand eye coordination and reflection. 
