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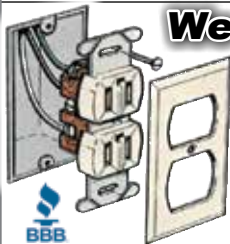

## 250th ANNIVERSARY of INDEPENDENCE CELEBRATED 2025 –2026



This year and next, the country is celebrating the 250th signing of the Declaration of Independence.

According to America250.org, many events are planned. Among those activities was the June 14 celebration of the founding of the U.S. Army in Washington, D.C. Events planned around the country will culminate in the national commemoration and celebration July 4, 2026.

One unifying project is a **Time Capsule**. This collaboration involving all 50 states, five territories, and the District of Columbia involves collecting items for a time capsule to be buried in Philadelphia on July 4, 2026.

The plan is for the capsule to be buried on the West Lawn of the Capitol and remained sealed until July 4, 2276, the nation's 500th birthday.

## BOARD of DIRECTORS

### BOARD OF DIRECTORS RESOLVES LAND LEASE AND APPROVES REVISED BUDGET FOR MAILING

The Board of Directors has successfully resolved the 15-year land lease renewal process with the Taylor Family, owners of the Palm Hill property.

The initial appraisal process began last fall with a preliminary valuation of approximately \$68 million for budgeting purposes. As required by the lease terms, three independent land appraisers were engaged, resulting in a June 2025 valuation of \$48 million. Following additional discussions with the Taylor Family, the final agreed-upon amount was reduced to \$45 million, effective July 1, 2025. The Taylor family graciously acknowledged their valued relationship with Palm Hill over the years.

In response to this outcome, the Finance Committee developed a revised budget. On June 12, the Board of Directors granted approval, for mail out to shareholders, a proposed budget that will reduce the monthly shareholder fee from \$677 to \$554 starting Aug. 1, 2025, a savings of \$123 per month per shareholder.

A detailed explanation of the revised budget has been distributed to all shareholders by postal mail and by email to those subscribed to Palm Hill's electronic notifications.

A final vote on the revised budget is scheduled for **July 17**, the approved budget remaining in effect through March 31, 2026. This revised budget incorporates the updated land lease terms effective July 1 and includes adjustments to other Palm Hill operating expenses for Fiscal Year 2025–2026.

As part of this budget, the Board has designated \$50 of each shareholder’s monthly fee to be allocated directly to the Reserve Fund, which supports ongoing maintenance of Palm Hill’s infrastructure. This contribution will add approximately \$54,800 per month or \$438,400 by fiscal year-end, to the Reserve Fund, which currently holds about \$900,000.

Finally, shareholders are reminded that the Finance Committee will begin preparing the next annual budget this fall. As in recent years, the process will remain fully transparent, with open committee meetings and regular communications to all shareholders as the Fiscal Year 2026–2027 budget is developed.

## **PALM HILL: A COMMUNITY AT A CROSSROADS**

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**F**rom my perspective, Palm Hill is at a pivotal moment, one that calls for thoughtful consideration of the future of our community’s amenities and services. This year’s Board and committee members are highly engaged and share a common goal: progress. With a younger demographic and a growing number of full-time residents, it’s clear our community’s needs and expectations are evolving.

This transition invites us to reflect on what we currently have and to consider what we truly need moving forward. Some residents have begun advocating for the consolidation—or even elimination—of certain amenities, especially where unnecessary duplication exists.

Historically, Palm Hill was developed as a set of “sister parks,” functioning largely as North and South entities. Today, we continue to operate within that framework, which includes:

- 2 laundry facilities (North/South)
- 2 shuffleboard courts (North/South)
- 2 pool rooms (North/South)
- 2 libraries (North/South)
- 2 recreational buildings (North/South)
- 2 pools and 1 hydrotherapy spa (North)
- 1 pool and 1 hydrotherapy spa (South)



In current discussions, cost savings and space optimization have emerged as key considerations. For example, both laundry facilities are significantly underused, primarily because most units now have their own in-unit laundry. In fact, the vendor supplying the machines has proposed downsizing to a single location, reflecting the clear decline in demand. Given that external laundromats are readily available nearby, maintaining two on-site facilities is no longer financially sensible.

This prompts a broader question: why maintain two underwhelming versions of anything when we could invest in one high-quality facility that better serves the entire community? While the pools may remain an exception due to their popularity and function, in many other cases, duplication may be holding us back.



The amended Palm Hill prospectus appears to provide only a general snapshot of amenities at the time of the developer's transfer to HOPH Inc. To the best of my understanding, this does not obligate us to maintain the exact same inventory of amenities forever.

In addition, the Master Form Exclusive Right of Possession (Section 5, parts a–f) outlines the corporation's service responsibilities and offers a framework within which thoughtful changes can be considered.

Regarding Florida Statute 719 and the question of “material alterations,” this matter is currently under internal review. Once we have a clearer understanding, we will engage legal counsel to guide us through any necessary bylaw amendments.

### **Evaluating Priorities and Next Steps**

Our committees are actively working to define parameters and develop cost estimates for future projects. A key area of concern is our aging subsurface infrastructure, particularly the pipes that manage wastewater and stormwater. From my perspective, and that of the volunteer shareholders who have been monitoring and maintaining these systems, this should be our top priority.

Parallel to these efforts and ongoing input from committees and shareholders, the Board is also considering engaging professional assistance to help develop a comprehensive strategic plan. The combination of critical infrastructure needs and the fact that much of our Park is now 50-years-old presents the ideal moment for us to come together for collaborative, forward-looking planning.

Our goal is to create a thoughtful, realistic plan that reflects both our present circumstances and future aspirations.

Above all, I believe it is vital that shareholders continue to have a voice in this process. Our volunteer committees play a key role in advising the Board, and we encourage robust participation as we move forward.

The steps we take must be transparent. The reasoning should be clear. And most importantly, the community should feel confident in the direction we choose.

## **BOARD MEETING SCHEDULE**

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**E**xpectation and general rule is that Board meetings will be at 1 p.m. on the last Wednesday of every month (**June 25, July 30**). Any changes will be announced via web blast and ZOOM.

A special **July 17** meeting is scheduled for final approval of the revised budget for 2025-2026.

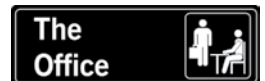

# Hurricane Season is June 1st to November 30th

## Make A Family Plan

**Step 1:** Put together a plan by discussing these 4 questions with your family, friends, or household to start your emergency plan.

How will I receive emergency alerts and warnings?  
What is my shelter plan?  
What is my evacuation route?  
What is my family/household communication plan?

**Step 2:** Consider specific needs in your household. As you prepare your plan tailor your plans and supplies to your specific daily living needs and

responsibilities. Discuss your needs and responsibilities and how people in the network can assist each other with communication, care of children, business, pets, or specific needs like the operation of durable medical equipment. Create your own personal network for specific areas where you need assistance.

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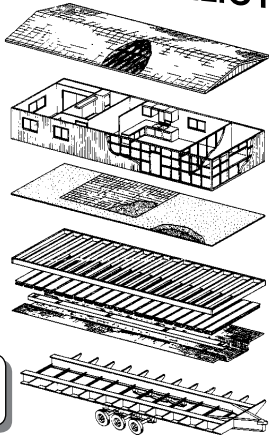
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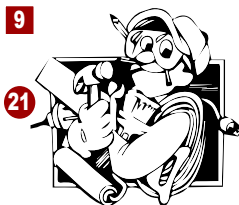
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## NEWS ABOUT/FROM VOLUNTEERS

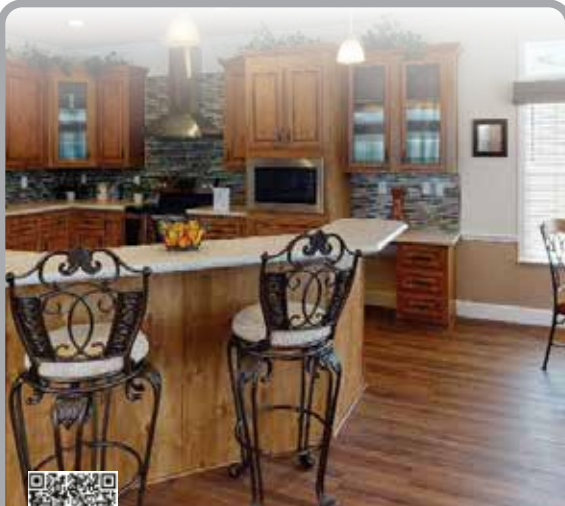

### ***CHANGES START JULY 1, 2025***

**N**ew registration forms for the 2025-2026 annual golf membership and golf cart stickers are available for purchase at the Office.

July 1 is when all new golf cart stickers and membership cards are required.

The color of the stickers for Golf Carts will change as of July 1.

Golf Carts must display current stickers. Two will be issued; one to be placed on each side of the cart, not on cart windows – per written instructions that come with the stickers.

***Golf carts are only permitted on the Golf Course and cart path while playing golf.***

Please remember to sign-in and pay inside the Pro Shop when open, otherwise, please continue to sign in on the Pro Shop patio indicating time/address/ and annual membership number or 10-pack number. Cash payments via envelopes provided can be placed through slot. See fees below.

\$17 including tax for 9 holes

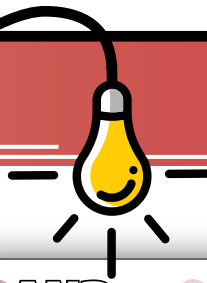
\$22 including tax for 18 holes

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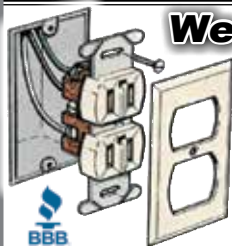

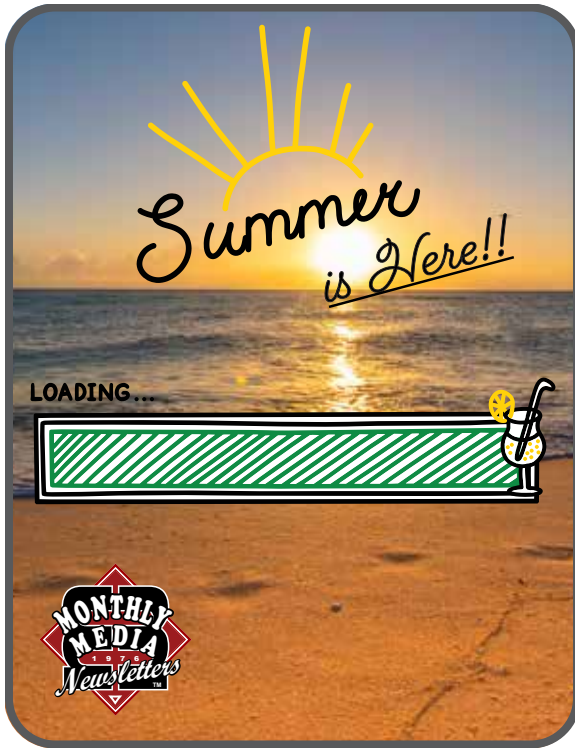

### Reminder of the Water Schedule for Palm Hill

Please remember we have a watering schedule that includes only Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

This schedule can be found on the Palm Hill web site located under HOPH information – Palm Hill Maintenance Services – K-Water Schedule for Palm Hill 2024).

Notes – each residence may irrigate with water only once per week (check schedule) and irrigation water is not available on Sundays.

Please read and follow this schedule and make sure your irrigation system is not spraying or wasting water on the streets.

Drinking water (city) should never be used for ANY exterior purposes in other words, washing vehicles, power washing home driveways and sidewalks.

**Rule IX - D.** Golf carts and licensed mopeds shall not be operated by anyone under sixteen (16) years of age. This means NO CHILDREN under the age of 16 are permitted to drive golf carts in Palm

Hill, not even with an adult in the passenger seat. Be a good parent/grandparent and just say “NO” and mean it! Remember people are speeding and not stopping at stop signs and you are putting your family at risk.

**Latest Rules and Regulations, as of May 28, 2025:** When you moved to Palm Hill you agreed to abide and comply with the rules. If you’ve never had an orientation, please contact the office to schedule one. If you have misplaced or have an older copy of the rules, please stop by the office, they will make you a copy.

**SANITATION FIELD**

**PALM HILL RULES AND REGULATIONS, SECTION 6 – Q:**

Use of Sanitation Area: The sanitation area is available for the purpose of material handling of recyclables, non-recyclables, vegetation, and construction materials.

The use of the construction bin shall be used strictly for the purposes of construction material and household items such as furniture. Renovation debris, such as kitchen cupboards, shall be broken down as to minimize the volume required of the construction bin. Electronics, tires, paints, oil, metals including aluminum, and hazardous materials are not permitted. Items that can be recycled should be separated and placed by the appropriate refuse or recycle bin. Recycled items are not to be taken/removed by a resident or individual. No dumping of construction material or refuse directly on the ground is permitted under any circumstance(s).

Should the construction bin be filled, the office shall be notified, and appropriate arrangements made for disposal.

Should such abuse of the sanitation area occur, the cost of such cleanup will be borne by the resident and may include suspension of access and associated fining. Sanitation facilities are restricted to Palm Hill homes only. All others, including commercial use by contractors, individuals outside the corporation, will be considered unauthorized and trespassing.
