From the Board of Directors

As I drove away from Blue Jay for the last time until October, the deck footings were curing and awaiting the framers to set the base for the Trex. Three new palm trees had been planted, with 2 additional ones awaiting deck completion. The downspouts from the roof had been relocated. A water main and several valves had been moved. All of this had to be done before the deck can be finished. Hopefully, when I write next month's edition, we will have a completed deck.



Blue Jay has been a busy place since I last wrote. SWFWMD has imposed Phase III water restrictions upon us, with reduced watering hours and days. Warnings have been eliminated, and \$193 fines are being given for even a 1st offense. I won't attempt to minimize the effect of this action. Our wells have the capacity to water up to 22 homes at the same time. With the change, they must water 34 homes at the same time. Obviously, water pressure will be affected. Phase III will be in effect until July 1st, and at that point the decision will be made to 1. continue Phase III for an additional 3 months, 2. go back to Phase II, or go to Phase IV, which would end all watering, and require that we shut down all wells. You should be aware that Pinellas County has already been in to check adherence, so make sure you are in compliance, or pay the substantial price. On top of that, we had a check valve fail on well # 2, which resulted in a \$3500 bill to replace the valve and pump (collateral damage) with replacements. We do not believe that this was caused by the Phase III restrictions.

We have contracted to have all of the clubhouse chairs cleaned, sanitized, and coated with protection in May. Hopefully, that will erase 9 years of spills and provide us all with a more pleasant sitting experience for events. The clubhouse floor will be stripped and sealed in June. This will require the clubhouse to be closed for close to a week to remove everything, do the job, await the clubhouse to air out from the dangerous chemicals they will use, and finally put everything back in order. Please plan accordingly.

Each of you that stay in Blue Jay during hurricane season should have an emergency plan that includes: 1. where you will stay if there is an evacuation; 2. supplies for 2-5 days; 3. medications; 4. important papers to take; 5. medical and pet accommodations. A reminder, the clubhouse cannot be used as an emergency shelter. Keep this in mind as the hurricane season approaches. There is a link on the Pinellas County website with additional information.

With the summer heat upon us, it is important that as we go to the pool to get a little relief from the heat, we comply with the rules that allow us to keep our pool open. These rules are in your Blue Book, and you should take a few minutes to review them before your guests arrive. Of the rules that are there, the one that will cost us all the most money in the long run is the wearing of tanning lotions and oils, which are prohibited from being used inside the pool. These substances will destroy our pool filters and require a very costly replacement. We ask that you please remind your guests.

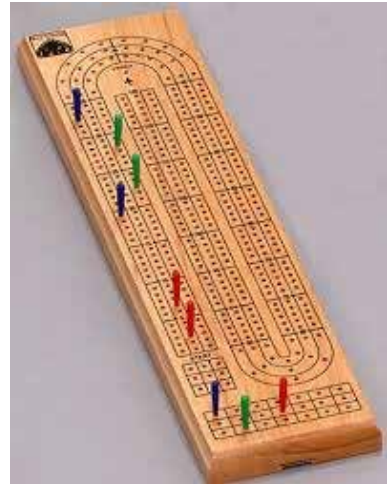

Things to Remember



1. Eastbound cars entering Blue Jay Estates from Curlew Road **ALWAYS** have the right-of-way.
2. Parking & Driving in Blue Jay Estates
 - a. **ONLY** park on one side of the street based on which side other cars are parked on. This allows room for FIRE & EMS trucks to get through.
 - b. **DO NOT** park on sidewalks.
 - c. No parking at the corners.
 - d. Must obtain permission, in advance, to park in someone else's driveway.
 - e. Cars parked at clubhouse overnight must be moved by 8:00 am.
 - f. Speed limit is 15 mph.
 - g. This applies to residents, visitors and workers.
3. **No dumping** of any kind in the RV lot.
4. Run off created by cleaning your house, car etc. will end up in our ponds. Consider this when selecting your chemical/cleaning products.
5. **Any** modifications or new additions to the exterior of your home or lot must be reviewed by the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) and approved by the Board of Directors before any work begins.

- Whistle to signal for help
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation Non-sparking wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- Can opener (if kit contains canned food)
- Local maps

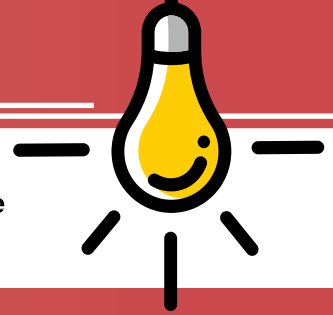

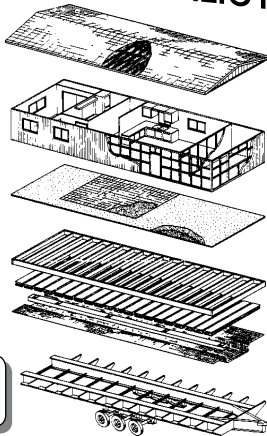

Flying in the face of disaster

In the 1980s and early '90s, Continental Airlines was a disaster. The organization had gone bankrupt twice and was on its way to a third (and final) catastrophe. It had gone through 10 presidents in 10 years, and employees mistrusted management.

Then in 1994 Gordon Bethune stepped in. Instead of running around willy-nilly trying to stamp out the various raging fires, Bethune took a step back to return to the basics. He identified Continental's key goals so that employees' efforts would be concentrated on them rather than diffused by the disaster of the moment. One of his areas of focus was creating a corporate culture. Without the commitment of the employees, the other goals would be impossible.

Drawing on the organization's history of excellence in service, he rallied the workforce. Bethune discovered that the employees weren't bad—they just worked in a dysfunctional organization. So they were quick to get behind his new leadership.

Senior management was a different story. Bethune knew he had to make wholesale changes, and that meant getting rid of the bureaucracy. In a couple of months, Bethune and his top executives replaced 50 of the company's 61 officers with 20 top-notch people.

The changes were dramatic. In one year's time, Continental went from being ranked the worst in customer satisfaction among major airlines to first.

The birth of 'excellence'

Tom Peters didn't exactly give birth to excellence, but he did establish the idea that companies can achieve excellence under the inspiration of a management guru—like himself.

It all began in the spring of 1978. John Larson of McKinsey's San Francisco office was set to give a presentation to a client. But his computer crashed and took with it his notes. He turned to another consultant, Tom Peters, to throw together a presentation that would satisfy the client.

Peters had just returned from traveling the world to compile research on best practices in business. Up until then, his research had been collecting dust after he had presented it to the McKinsey powers that be. With an opportunity to present his findings again, Peters gathered his data. In search of a sexy title to give his presentation, Peters came up with "Excellence." It was a hit.

Eventually, Peters edited the material into a manuscript. Continuing with the idea of excellence, he titled the book *The Secrets of Excellence*. But the title didn't fly with the McKinsey folks, who feared that clients would think the company was selling the secrets of client operations. In 1982, Peters and co-author Robert Waterman renamed it the more politically astute *In Search of Excellence*. And thus was excellence born.

Mix these ingredients for cultural creativity

Do you want to nurture a culture of creativity in your organization? Try to build in these essential ingredients:

- **Curiosity.** Ask people questions that challenge the conventional wisdom. Encourage them to stretch boundaries and take chances on new opportunities.
- **Emotion.** People who love what they do are better at generating new ideas about their work. Hire and support people who show a real enthusiasm for your organization and its mission.
- **Tolerance.** People won't suggest ideas if they're afraid of being punished for failure. Encourage risk taking by showing forgiveness when things don't work out, as long as people are giving their best efforts.
- **Direction.** A clear sense of what you want to achieve will help people focus their ideas. Have a concrete mission statement that tells everyone what you're trying to do, why it's important, and how it will benefit everyone.



What do the instructions say? Creativity expert

Yoram Solomon often conducts workshops that teach people to approach problems with an open mind. In one exercise (recounted on the Inc. magazine website), he asks participants to build a structure out of a sheet of paper. Some cut the paper into smaller pieces, although his instructions don't specifically say they can.

Once everyone is finished, Solomon asks, "Did the instructions allow you to cut the paper?" Most believe they've done something wrong. But one person usually pipes up with, "You didn't say we couldn't, either."

"To be creative," Solomon points out, "don't assume restrictions that don't really exist."

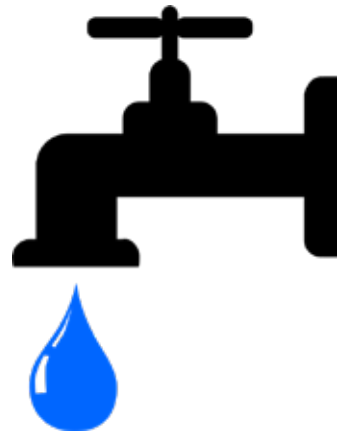
