pays the balance of the bill, up to \$75, after Medicare and insurance. Membership period is stated on your card. There are no grace days.



THANK YOU

I recently had the privilege of visiting one of Bay Ranch Legends: Jerry Olson.

These of you who don't know Jerry, let me give you a little background. Jerry is 93 years young. He's married to his beautiful bride of 20 years Carol. The Thank You I want to give him is for his service. Jerry was one of the lone survivors of his Infantry in the Battle of Pork Chop Hill. This took place in Korea in 1953.

Here is part of his story:

Jerry was drafted. But he was never trained for combat! He was never even on a rifle range. He thought he was training to be a signal man who climbed poles. His first week consisted of how to stay down in the mud, to avoid being seen or shot. His 2nd week. He was taught to use a bayonet and kill someone with it. His 3rd week was then for his signal training. It was during this time they asked for 12 volunteers, nobody did, so they picked 12 men out and sent them to a signal core. One group was for a 9-month course, the other for a 7-week course. 18 days later they were thrown in together. 8 were called off and were being sent to Okinawa and the other were being shipped off to Korea. Then plans changed and they were all shipped to Korea. They went in on low tide, mud was knee deep and about 8 feet of water. Once on land they were sent by train to Seoul, Korea, There Jerry was issued a weapon, (Sadly I can't read my notes for what it was). Jerry had never shot any weapon of any kind before, so fortunately an officer took him aside and taught him how to shoot.

Next, they thought they were going to go out and support the battle at Ole Baldy, on the way a mortar shell went off, Jerry jumped out of the jeep and stayed in the culvert all day long. At this point Jerry was reported missing.. He finally was reunited with his group.

Then on April 16, 1953, at approximately 5:30-6:30 it was like all **** broke loose. There was Chinese everywhere and they were under attack from them. Jerry was hit with shrapnel, but fortunately his flight jacket was lined and saved him from serious injury. However, when it all ended and he could check out his body, it was black and blue from his shoulder to waist.



Jerry finally was forced to kill, and it tore him up as a Christian he felt he had just committed murder,

Jerry survived 4 days on Pork Chop Hill by avoiding capture, killing when he must, just to survive. He used dead men's ammo and rations just to survive. Killing when he had to. He had to survive to get home to his wife, with a baby on the way. When he was found, he didn't even realize he had a cut on his hand from a battle with a bayonet. Bayonet man lost, Jerry won.

In those 4 days 415 men were lost. As the only survivor Jerry was taken to the Officer and they let him take a shower in Officers' quarters which had warm water and provided him with new clothes as his were all blood.

It took 9 days to get back to his outfit.

Jerry now suffers from PTSD and for 50 years has slept with a rifle under his bed.

He was told by doctors that after what he went through he was 100% disabled. Jerry didn't think so.


When he finally got back home, he joined the fire Department for a while.

I'm sure there is allot more I missed, as my notes are a mess because I was so taken in by his story.

On behalf of myself and all the other Residents here: Thank You Jerry and all of our other Veterans living here. We most likely wouldn't be here if you all were not defending us.

Manager's Moment

All Bay Ranch rent amounts have increased by \$75, starting with your January rent. Please make sure you submit the correct amount, write the amount correctly, and the "words" on the legal line are correct. In addition, all checks must be written in blue or black ink, or they will be returned to you. Your rent is considered late if the office does not receive a valid form of payment by the close of business on the 5th of the month (unless you have made other arrangements with the Office). A reminder that late fees are \$50 after the 5th of the month, NOT prorated by how many days you are late. Additionally, the bank returned check fee is \$30 and an administrative fee of \$12.50 is charged for handling. Simply put, if you pay late or issue an improper check, it will cost you an additional \$65. I am happy to work with anyone who has a legitimate reason for being late; "legitimate" does not include "I am going on vacation and need to have the extra money in case I need it"! Or "I had to pay my son's rent, so he didn't get evicted." And yes, I hear this all the time. Also, if you have a 3rd person approved to live in your mobile, the monthly fee has increased to an additional \$50 per person. Within the last 2 months, every resident should have received a letter about any repairs that

were needed to bring their yard and mobile home up to Park standards; some people received letters thanking them for keeping their mobile and lot in good condition (We called them “Happy Letters”). Kat has been the one checking the mobiles and lots, then sending out the letters. She then forwards me any pictures she may have taken to substantiate items that needed attention. She will be doing follow-ups to see if the needed repairs have been made. Rules 21 and 39 give Park Management the right to be on your lot for this purpose.

Here is a large problem we have encountered.... residents seem to think these are “suggestions” and that the time frame for repairs does not apply to them. WRONG! You can come see me or send an email and explain why you may need more time, and it will be at my discretion whether or not you are given additional time. Things not acceptable are we need to put money inside first; we may do it in the spring; we are ok with the way things are; I’m too old to do the work (then you hire someone); it’s been this way forever (times change, Bay Ranch was starting to look like a trailer park instead of a mobile home community); etc. Park Rule 18. TRASH/GARBAGE, items B, C, and D, give guidance on putting garbage out to the road. I cannot stress enough about garbage being put out on a Saturday, or other wrong time. No one wants to look at your trash, and it leaves a bad impression on guests and prospective new tenants who drive through the park. Understanding that a lot of residents have no golfcart, truck or other way to get the large amount of brush, limbs, etc. to the dumpsters after they received cleanup letters the letters. If you put garbage out early, or don’t properly prepare your limbs, etc. Your garbage will not be picked up AT ALL. It will be your problem getting it to the dumpsters.

Even though park rules allow for eviction of residents who continually break the rules (and don’t follow up on the repairs indicated in the letters), it is not our intent. I would rather work with you to find a solution.....there are still a few residents who are physically able (and young enough) to do some of the required work at a reasonable price. There are businesses that advertise power washing for just under \$100 in the News and Views. Park rules require mobile homes to be washed annually, but if at any time mold or mildew becomes visible, you are required to wash it again. Weather affects mold and mildew, and the record setting high temperatures and humidity that we had this summer caused many residents to wash their mobiles several times. Mold is a living organism that grows and spreads when it has the right conditions, such as damp, warm and humid environments. If you see signs of mold starting, you should remove it immediately, so it doesn’t become a bigger issue. Washing of mobile homes is not subject to Pinellas County water restrictions.

We are still under water restrictions, (2 days a week, Thursday and Sunday) but NOT permitted between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Also, park rules allow car washing only twice a week (a week is defined as Sunday through Saturday).

I apologize for the length of this article regarding mobile home lot and home maintenance, but, like most of you, I do not want to live in a “trailer park” and I expect all residents to take some pride in their home and yard.

Some background on Mardi Gras



FLORIDA CODE:




