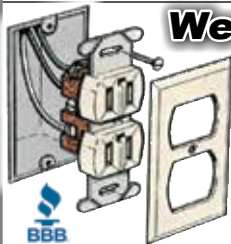

From the Board of Directors

Hello All,

I am writing this while simultaneously preparing for our final budget meeting, which by the time you read this newsletter will already have happened. As our Treasurer and Property Manager are still scrambling to get final numbers and sharpening their spreadsheets, I am keeping my fingers crossed. While it would be a dream to not expect some increase, we are hoping to keep the increase at a minimal level. The Board budget meeting will be held on Tuesday, October 21st, at 7pm in the Blue Jay Clubhouse. You may want to mark that date on your calendar so that you can attend and hear all of the details. The 2026 budget will be moved at this meeting.

At the time of this writing, there have been no hurricanes that have come into the Gulf. That being said, the season does not end until November 30th, so we still have plenty of time to see another one come by. The water in the Gulf is very warm, and warm water breeds hurricanes.

Also, the peak of the season is September 10th, so hopefully by the time you are reading this, we can at least start to feel a little more secure. The Board is currently working with Resource Property Management to find either a person or a company to take care of our maintenance needs.

Suzanne and I will see you all soon. We are flying in on Friday, October 10th. We are looking forward to seeing all of you very soon.

RV Lot Users

If you are using the RV lot to store or park a vehicle of any kind you are responsible for your assigned spot. This includes weeding and picking up trash as needed. The weeds have gotten too high in some areas. Please check your assigned space and pull or cut weeds and clean it up as needed.

Accidentally Calling 9-1-1

Have you ever accidentally called 9-1-1? If you have, you are not alone. Based on a study in 2023, would you believe that it was determined that Pinellas County 9-1-1 dispatchers receive nearly 500 accidental 9-1-1 calls per day. So, what should you do if you accidentally call 9-1-1?

First of all, do not just hang up and try to act like nothing happened, because it already has. Do not be embarrassed or afraid to speak to them. Remain on the line, and when the dispatcher answers, advise them it was an accidental call. Tell them you are okay. They may ask how it happened. If so, simply explain to them how it happened. If you do hang up, perhaps you did not realize you called, a dispatcher will attempt to call the number the 9-1-1 call came from. If you receive such a call, answer it and again, simply explain the situation. This prevents them from having to unnecessarily dispatch law enforcement to your location.

iPhone Tip: There is an Emergency SOS feature on an iPhone that will automatically call 9-1-1 if you repeatedly press and release the side button on the phone. The exact details of the feature vary depending on the iPhone model and settings. The setting can be modified by going to Settings>Emergency SOS.
