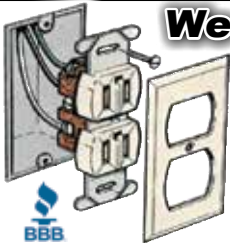

WATER SCHEDULING & RULES – PINELLAS COUNTY

- Addresses ending in even numbers (0, 2, 4, 6, 8): Tuesdays
 - **Addresses ending in odd numbers (1, 3, 5, 7, 9): Thursdays – Lincolnshire based on address #1071.**
 - Mixed or No Address (such as common areas, entry areas/office complexes, shopping centers and other “no address” locations): Thursdays
 - Watering hours are reduced to **12:01 a.m. to 4 a.m. OR 8 p.m. to 11:59 p.m.** Properties less than one acre in size may only use one of these windows. Properties one acre or larger can use both windows.

Restrictions under Phase III

In addition to continued one-day-per-week watering, the following restrictions will go into effect April 3, 2026:

- No HOA or other entity shall enforce deed restrictions or other community standards requiring an increase in water use, including replacement of plant material to meet aesthetic standards or pressure washing.
- Car washing at home (non-commercial) is only allowed on your lawn watering day and you must use a hose with a shutoff nozzle.
- Ornamental fountains are limited to four hours a day. The regular hours of operation can be selected by the owner but must be posted.
- **Restaurants are required to only serve water upon request.**
Please note Lincolnshire residents: per inquiry to Pinellas County 4/15/2026.
Pressure washing is permitted on your day of the week for watering. (Lincolnshire’s day is Thursdays) at any time of the day.

If you hire a pressure washing business from OUTSIDE of Lincolnshire the pressure washing can be done any day of the week.

Violations

To protect the remaining water supply, Pinellas County Utilities is required to issue a \$193 citation for any violation of these watering restrictions. This fine will double with each additional violation. **While we typically issue a warning for a first violation, warnings will not be allowed after April 17, 2026, due to the extreme drought conditions.**

COMPACTOR REMINDER

If you are new to Lincolnshire please read this article.

A friendly reminder for all our residents. Whenever you take trash to the compactor, please remember to close the door after depositing your garbage. **DO NOT PRESS THE RED BUTTON.** This compactor is pre-programmed to automatically start compaction after the door has been closed three (3) times. **It is very important that the compactor door is CLOSED after you deposit your garbage.** Do not throw large items into the compactor. You will need to wait till the bulk trash container is brought into the community each month. See Voice calendar for dates dumpster is scheduled each month.

Don't forget to break down your cardboard boxes before throwing them in the mixed recycle bins. If the recycling bins are full do not overfill them, the lids should be able to lay flat. Put your recycled items in the compactor instead. When the city comes to take the recycling bins all the "over" loaded trash ends up on our streets. **Please! Please! Think before you overload those containers.**

Please do not bring large items furniture etc. that need to be placed in the Bulk dumpster that is brought into the community twice a month. Check the Voice calendar for dates each month and hold those large items at your home till the container is brought on site.

Help us keep our compactor working by following the rules above.

Please note: do not leave any bulk trash or regular garbage in the area that formerly housed the blue recycling bins. Any bulk trash items you may wish to discard need to be kept at your residence till the bulk trash container is brought on site 2x each month. See Voice calendar for scheduled dates.

All regular garbage should be placed in the compactor. Do not throw large items into the compactor.

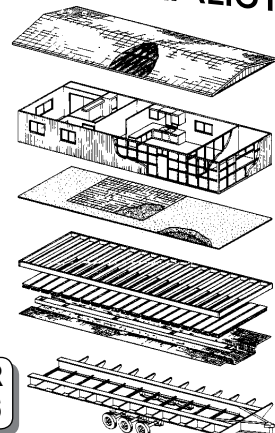

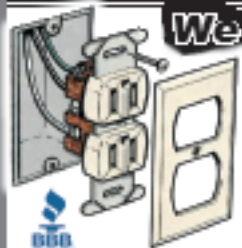

VETERANS CORNER

Most Vietnam veterans have fascinating stories about their time in the war, whether they are tinged with trauma, courage, hope, and sadness. But for Marine Corps veteran Frank E. Cius Jr., his story is one of captivity and torture, spending over six years stripped of his freedom as a prisoner of war (POW).

Cius spoke of his time in Vietnam during an event to honor National Vietnam War Veterans Day in Buffalo, New York, this year, according to WIVB.com. Cius, who grew up in Buffalo, enlisted in the Marine Corps in the late 1960s and was assigned to the 1st Marine Aircraft Wing.

The young soldier knew his life would change when he received orders for Vietnam but had no idea what was truly in store for him. “Most of the guys in my squadron who came over with me were from our local area,” Cius told a group of veterans at Buffalo Naval Park.

Like so many other POWs, Cius’s will to survive kept him going, even though it was the darkest days. Cius will always recall June 3, 1967. That is the day the helicopter mission he was on did not proceed as planned. “On the return mission in, we lost three choppers,” Cius said. “Now the mission turns into a rescue.” Flying over Laos, his unit’s CH46A helicopter was hit by a barrage of bullets from enemy forces. “We took the heaviest fire I have ever encountered in my entire life,” Cius, serving as a door gunner, recalled. The chopper spun out of control, hover-rotated in the sky, before crashing down in a place Cius and his crew wanted no part of. “We crashed into the jungle, I thought,” Cius said. “It was the village of the VC.”

The Viet Cong. A group of guerrilla fighters that aided the North Vietnamese Army and other communist forces in South Vietnam. After the aircraft hit the ground, all hell broke loose. “They were not expecting a helicopter to land in the middle of their village, and what happened was everyone was shooting, and getting hit, and hurt,” Cius said. “I caught one too.” Wounded from the firefight and injured by the crash, Cius somehow avoided capture for a day and a half before his luck ran out.

VC troops captured him on June 5, 1967, sending him to the notorious “Hanoi Hilton” in North Vietnam. Cius’s tiny cell and the four walls that enclosed it would be his home for the next 2,100 days before being released on March 5, 1973, during Operation Homecoming.

“It’s nice to share what I’ve been through with other people,” Cius told reporters after his speech. Medically retiring from the Marine Corps as a staff sergeant in 1978, Cius received both the Prisoner of War and Bronze Star medals for his acts of valor.

News and Updates for May 2026:

Tips on successful community along with our tenet association updates on living in Lincolnshire. LHOA protects your rights under Federal and State laws and also reminds homeowners of our responsibilities too.

- There are both regular and electronic device recycling availabilities in Largo. The Starkey site does not take electronic waste. However, merchants like Staples and Best Buy do take old and unused electronic waste including connections. Many give you credit on your account. Call them before you just toss it in the compactor.
- This is a repeated item for several months as recycling compliance has not changed for several years. The LHOA Board has found no change in recycling behavior. It is not just a very few residents who place nonrecycling in the four bins. The volume speaks for itself. Despite repeated actions to ensure the recycle bins are used properly **all 4 become contaminated** before each pickup. Unsanitary, unhealthy for residents living close by and for many residents with chronic health issues, plus a biohazard for all. Park management has no responsibility for what resident's place in those bins. Only we do. We simply have not. Soon, if not by this writing, the recycle bins have been removed or very soon. We expect a result of a more frequent compactor and roll off pick-ups. Largo does have active recycling centers close by.
- ❖ LHOA membership for 2026 remains at \$15 for both new members and renewals. Support as LHOA does look out for both Federal and State homeowner rights. LHOA has spent over \$8000 to protect 463 homeowners from both liability and state/federal lawsuits.
- ❖ The next LHOA monthly Board meeting is Wednesday May 13th right after the Wednesday Resident's Club coffee. Members and homeowners are always welcome to attend. The Board wants to hear your concerns.
- ❖ The LHOA Board is responsive to emails (Gmail address is above). Officer and Directors are listed on the inside cover of the monthly Voice. There are 2 Director vacancies. Please read our mission statement and code of conduct on the LHOA bulletin board in the laundry/postal building. LHOA pays for your online/in person state training.
