





Be contrary to plumb new ideas

Following the crowd is usually a safe bet, but it doesn't usually lend itself to creative thinking. If you want to be creative, sometimes you have to go against the grain. Never divulge too much information about yourself, your current location, or future plans unless you want to fall victim to unscrupulous internet trolls.


One big, happy family
