

### **Q&A** about the coronavirus vaccine

edical professionals have begun vaccinating people against the COVID-19 virus, but many people have questions about its safety. The BBC addresses some of them:

- How are trials conducted? Scientists test vaccines on large numbers of people—40,000 for the Pfizer/BioNTech vaccine, for example. Half the volunteers receive the vaccine, and the rest get a placebo. Neither the volunteers nor the scientists administering the test know which group is getting which. Findings are checked and verified independently. Even at the high speed of development, scientists didn't skip any steps.
- What's in the vaccine? The Pfizer vaccine uses pieces of genetic code to create an immune response to the virus. The vaccine developed by Oxford AstraZeneca uses a harmless virus that has been altered to resemble the coronavirus. Vaccines in general frequently contain ingredients to stabilize them and make them more effective.
- Will the vaccine make you sick? Some people experience muscle aches or a higher temperature in response to the vaccine, but that's not from the virus itself. There is no evidence that the vaccine can make you sick or cause you to get the disease.
- Should you get the vaccine if you've had COVID? Yes, because natural immunity from recovery may not provide you with protection from future infections. However, you should wait until you've fully recovered to get the vaccine.


## Check for these warning signs of hearing loss

en are at greatest risk of noise-induced hearing loss (NIHL), according to a study of more than 5,000 people con- ducted by the University of California-Irvine Medical Center. The likely cause: greater recreational and occupational exposure to noise, along with higher rates of military service. But men and women suffer equally when their hearing deteriorates.

Pay attention to these symptoms of NIHL so you can seek treatment before too much damage is done:

- Sounds seem muffled to you.
- Ringing in the ears.
- Sensation of pressure in your ears.
- Others complain more frequently that your TV or music is too loud.
- People feel you're not paying attention to them.
- Background noise makes understanding speech difficult.
- You hear better with one ear than the other while speaking on the phone.
- You have frequent earaches or ear infections.

Because hearing loss happens gradually over time, many people don't realize they're experiencing it. See a doctor and get your hearing tested if you have any of the warning sings listed above.






