Message from the HOA President

Tt has been brought to my attention that some of our resident owners have refused the packet that contains the revised by-laws.

There are four items that every household should have and they stay with the house in case you move. They include the park rules, phone directory, the prospectus, and the HOA by-laws.

Some of you have refused the packet with the by-laws, and my question is why? I think, some of you think, you have to belong to the HOA. Let me put you in on a secret. There is no secret, EVERYONE belongs to the HOA.

Some people pay their association dues (\$25) and some do not. Dues paying members can do more than non-dues paying members. Examples are:

- 1) Dues-paying members can run in the election of the Board of directors.
- 2) Dues paying members can vote, and can speak at HOA meetings (non dues paying members may only attend meetings but are not recognized to speak at these meetings).

All resident owners (dues paying and non-dues paying members) can attend the functions that the HOA puts on: dinners, coffee, programs, etc.

By refusing to accept the packet, you are missing out on some important information. The enclosed by-laws may answer some questions that you may have about your own Southwind Community.

I repeat, ALL resident owners are members of the HOA.
