

#### **Helping Hands: Dealing with Anxiety**

e often say we'd like to get rid of our anxiety, but anxiety can be useful. It can anticipate a threat and have our bodies respond to protect us. Unlike stress which is triggered by something external, anxiety is worry that doesn't go away even when the stress is gone. It can overtake your thoughts and cause you to obsess over things



that may never happen. But anxiety can motivate you to meet a deadline or react to traffic or cause you to improve your health.

When anxiety begins to interfere with your life, you may have an anxiety disorder. One of the most common disorders is called generalized anxiety disorder (GAD). It affects about 6.8 million American adults. Other disorders include phobias (fear of flying, or fear of heights, for example) or social anxiety fear of being judged negatively in social situations.

Sometimes anxiety can result in physical symptoms. Because of the bustle in our lives, we sometimes don't recognize that anxiety is affecting us until it shows up physically. Common anxiety symptoms include hand sweating, dizziness, fast heartbeat, migraines, neck or shoulder pain or even insomnia.

Anxiety affects about 23% of women annually compared to 14% of men. Women often have more caregiving roles for aging parents or children.

Finding support varies around the country, but apps such as LiveHealth Online and Doctor on Demand can be helpful. Only 37% of Americans with anxiety disorder seek treatment, although the disorders are real medical conditions and not just "in your head." One of the most effective therapies is called Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) which teaches new ways of processing feelings and how to frame events more productively.

With a COVID-19 virus vaccine becoming available, many of us will be far less anxious in the New Year!

#### 2020 Year In Review

espite a worldwide pandemic, there was a lot of buying and selling of homes at Americana Cove in 2020. A total of 306 people visited the sales office to view homes for sale and 45 homes were sold. September was the best month for home sales with seven closings that month. Of the 306 people, 99 were walkins, meaning that they stopped by the community during posted



business hours without an appointment. When this occurs, the Realtor® on duty greets the visitor.

Once the pandemic hit in March, Barefoot Realty met visitors in the parking lot, and everyone wore masks to ensure the safety of residents, potential buyers and Realtors®.

Each year, the best-selling months change. In 2019 a total of 41 homes were sold with January and April being the best months with 6 closings each. In 2018, March was the best month for sales with nine home closings. Forty homes were sold that year.


