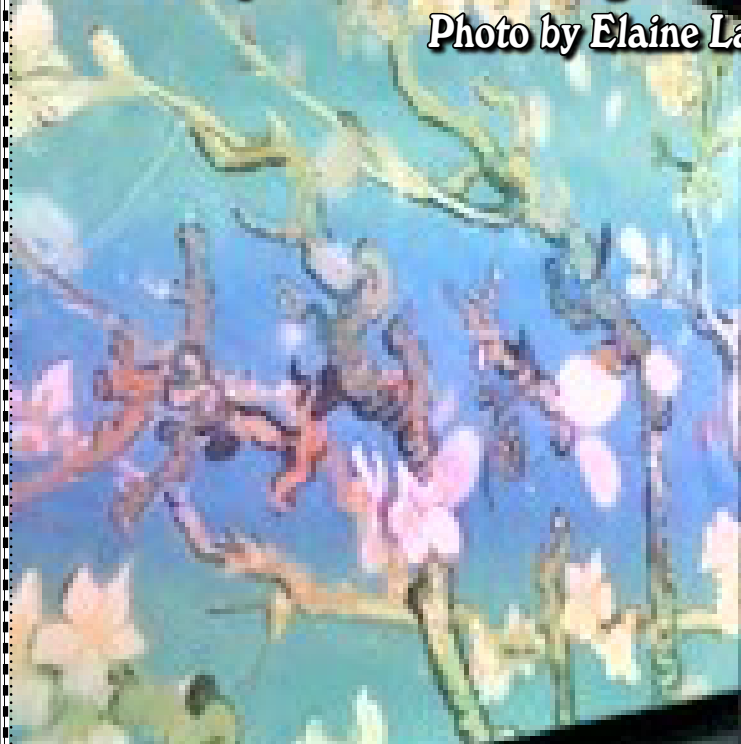

## EDITOR'S CORNER:

**A**s of the February LINK's deadline, the date of the election and annual meeting are January 29, 2021.

*Megan DiBello, Palm Hill's Assistant Community Manager, CMCA, provided logistics about this year's election and annual meeting below.*

This is a brief overview of how the election will proceed this year, due to the fact that the meeting will be conducted via webinar.

If you have not otherwise returned your ballot in accordance with the instructions provided earlier, there is a locked "Drop Box" in front of the South Clubhouse where shareholders may drop off ballots for the three Board of Directors positions, as well as the proxy forms. The proxy forms are important because they will determine a quorum for the annual meeting, which will begin at 1:30 p.m.

The Election Committee will count the ballots in the South Clubhouse, and results will be announced at the annual meeting.

In the interest of safety, in-person attendance at the South Clubhouse will be limited to the Election Committee and representatives from Resource Management, Palm Hill's management company.

There will be a camera, possibly more than one, which will allow shareholders joining the meeting on ZOOM to view the Election Committee while they count the votes. The ZOOM recording of the annual meeting will be posted on the Palm Hill website: palmhillcountryclub.net.

If you haven't yet turned in your ballot and proxy, please do so as soon as possible. If you have any questions, please contact the Office at 727-581-8729.

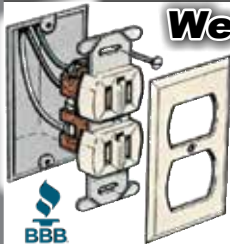

**HOW TO ATTEND AND PARTICIPATE:** Shareholders who are listed in the online member email directory on the website will receive an invitation with instructions on how to attend the board meetings via an email from the Webmaster.

Board members are registered for the meeting as Webinar Panelists and shareholders are attendees. A copy of the Notice and Webinar Invitation will also be posted on the HOPH information page on the Home Page of the website.

**FOR SHAREHOLDERS/AUDIENCE:** If a shareholder desires to speak to an agenda item he or she is required – (because of the technical aspects of hosting and managing the meeting) – to submit the speaking request via email to [managerpalmhill@tampabay.rr.com](mailto:managerpalmhill@tampabay.rr.com). The speaking request should state the specific aspect of the agenda you wish to address and it should be submitted prior to 12 p.m. on the day of the meeting. Prior to discussion of the agenda item each listed speaker will be given an opportunity to speak for three minutes.

When entering the ZOOM meeting, you will be asked for your name. Use first and last name because it enables the ZOOM host to quickly find you and unmute you so you will be heard.

**MEETING NOTICES:** To comply with Florida Statutes and increase transparency of Park management and governance, the Palm Hill webmaster is broadcasting by email notices of all board and committee meetings, as well as postings of minutes. Shareholders can thus follow park business and management in a timely manner, either by attending meetings (currently through remote technology per instructions that will be distributed via the email blasts) or through the minutes on the website. Information is also posted on the TV Channel 732. (Ch. 732 is not in the Spectrum cable guide on TV. You must key 732 into the remote-control device to get to the channel.)

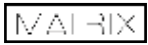

## ON THE COVER: COOL DESTINATIONS:

*Immerse yourself in light and sound at The Dali Museum. Cover photo by Elaine Lantz*

**M**y travel companions and I recently enjoyed an excursion to the Dali Museum in Saint Petersburg. Along with the incomparable Dali art on display, was the ‘Van Gogh Alive Experience’. I have been to the Museum previously, pre COVID 19, when the Dali venue was shared with the delightfully quirky Magritte exhibition.

This current event, running through mid-April at the Dali Museum, does not contain any actual canvas paintings by Van Gogh. Instead, it features wall-to-wall, floor-to-ceiling, high-definition projections, constantly flowing throughout the large maze-like room. The over 3,000 Van Gogh art re-creations are enhanced by the surround sound of classical music scores chosen to reflect the uniquely changing moods of the art and the timeline of the artist’s life. This total immersion creates a spiritual experience reflective of the artist’s genius, maturation, and emotional struggles. I felt I had been transported to a beautifully tranquil space, and that euphoria stayed with me long after I left the museum.

COVID 19 restrictions are in place and are well enforced; masks properly worn, temperature checks, sanitation stations, and reservations are required for timed entries. Reservation times are spaced so none of the areas crowded and six-foot distancing is easily maintained.

The Museum also boasts a lunch counter and spacious garden area with table seating overlooking a marina. The Dali permanent collection is also included in the reasonable (\$23.00 for seniors) admission price.

This temporary ‘escape from the corona haze’ was truly a pleasurable and safe day trip.

## FUN FLORIDA FACTS: Only in our state

---

The Florida Reef is **the only living coral barrier reef in the continental United States**. It is also the third largest coral barrier reef system in the world, after the Great Barrier Reef and the Belize Barrier Reef.

Florida is the only state in the continental United States with extensive shallow coral reef formations near its coasts. Coral reefs create specialized habitats that provide shelter, food, and breeding sites for numerous plants and animals. This includes ones important to fishing like spiny lobster, snapper, and grouper. The Florida Reef is a major attraction for divers, snorkelers and marine scientists.

Florida's Coral Reef stretches approximately 360 linear miles from Dry Tortugas National Park west of the Florida Keys around the Keys and southern Florida and up to the St. Lucie Inlet in Martin County on the East coast.

Roughly two-thirds of Florida's Coral Reef lies within Biscayne National Park and the Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary, a marine protected area that surrounds the Florida Keys island chain. The reefs stretching north of Biscayne National Park and the marine

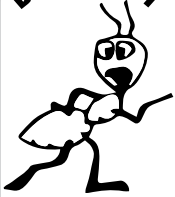

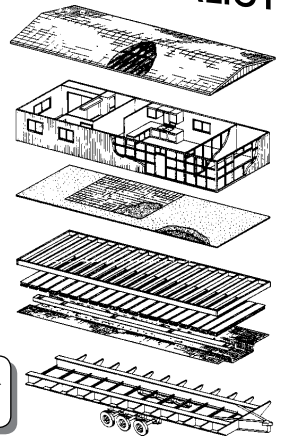

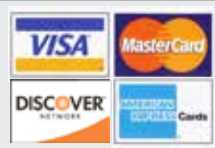

sanctuary are managed by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection's Coral Reef Conservation Program with insight from the Southeast Florida Coral Reef Initiative, which is one of several programs administered by the Coral Reef Conservation Program.

Florida's coral reefs came into existence approximately 10,000 years ago when sea levels rose following the last Ice Age. Reef growth is relatively slow; individual colonies grow only one-half inch to seven inches a year, depending on the species. Coral reefs are in a constant state of flux, where new polyps (the living tissue) grow on the outer surface, while their skeleton erodes to help make the white sand for our beaches. During long periods of favorable conditions, the reefs may reach awe-inspiring heights and diversity.

**SPEED LIMIT:** Speed Limit is 15 miles per hour.

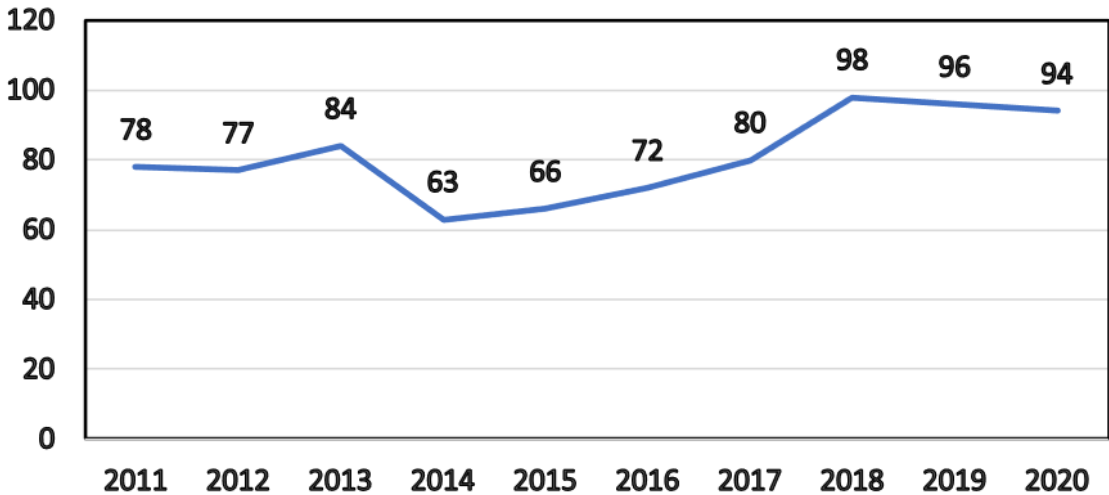

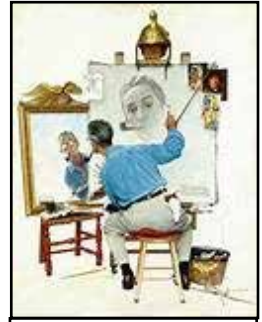
## BORN IN FEBRUARY? You have good company



*Dr. Elizabeth Blackwell - Feb. 3*

**Feb. 3, 1821**, The first female physician in the U.S., Elizabeth Blackwell, was born in Bristol, England. Her family moved to the U.S. and in 1849, she established a hospital in New York City run by an all-female staff. She was active training women to be nurses in the Civil War.

**Feb. 3, 1894**, American artist and illustrator Norman Rockwell was born.

**Feb. 4, 1746**, Thaddeus Kosciuszko, born in Poland. He served in the American Revolution, building the

first fortifications at West Point, then returned to Poland and fought against a Russian invasion.

**Feb. 6, 1895**, “Babe” Ruth born. Ruth held or shared 60 Major League baseball records, including pitching 29 consecutive scoreless innings and hitting 714 home runs.

**Feb. 6, 1911**, Ronald Reagan, 40th U.S. President

**Feb. 12, 1809**, Abraham Lincoln’s Birthday; 16th President of the U.S., Lincoln led the nation through the Civil War, freed the slaves, composed the Gettysburg Address and established Thanksgiving.

**Feb. 15, 1820**, Susan B. Anthony birthday. Pioneer in women’s rights and suffrage, Ms. Anthony was arrested in 1872 after voting illegally in the presidential election. She was commemorated in 1979 with the Susan B. Anthony dollar coin, thus became the first woman to have her image on a U.S. coin.

**Feb. 22, 1732**, Birthday of George Washington, leader of the Continental Army during the American Revolution, Founding Father of the Country and its first President.

**Feb. 23**, African American educator and leader W.E.B. Du Bois (1868-1963) was born in Great Barrington, Massachusetts.

**Feb. 24**

- Admiral Chester Nimitz (1885-1966) was born in Fredericksburg, Texas. He commanded Allied naval, land and air forces in the South Pacific during World War II, and signed the Japanese surrender document on September 2, 1945.
- American frontiersman Buffalo Bill Cody (1846-1917) was born in Scott County, Indiana. He claimed to have killed more than 4,000 buffalo within 17 months. He became world famous through his Wild West show which traveled throughout the U.S and Europe for 30 years.



*Paul Revere’s Ride - Feb. 27*

**Feb. 27**, American poet Henry Wadsworth Longfellow (1807-1882) was born in Portland, Maine. Best known for *Paul Revere’s Ride*, *The Song of Hiawatha* and *the Wreck of the Hesperus*. According to Wikipedia, Longfellow was the most popular poet of his day. Many of his works helped shape the American character and its legacy, particularly with the poem *Paul Revere’s Ride* (Paul Revere’s Ride by Henry Wadsworth Longfellow - Poems | poets.org). He was such an admired figure in the United States during his life that his 70th birthday in 1877 took on the air of a national holiday, with parades, speeches, and the reading of his poetry.

The North laundry will be accessible between 8:30 a.m. to 8 p.m. daily.

Access is by key fob. Sign-in sheets will be used and residents are required to sanitize

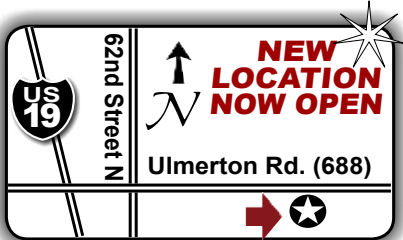

## **CORONAVIRUS UPDATES/RESOURCES:**

**A**t the LINK’s deadline on January 10, Governor Ron DeSantis announced that in addition to those in long-term care facilities and health care workers, those 65 and older are eligible for vaccines, as the vaccine supplies are available, and as new shipments become available.

The Florida Department of Health will also supplement CVS and Walgreen efforts in long-term care facilities.

As of the LINK February deadline, some hospitals in the Tampa Bay area were dispensing vaccines, as was the Veterans Administration at Bay Pines – to patients who meet specific conditions/requirements, in addition to age requirements.

As of the February LINK deadline, Pinellas County announced it would provide vaccines to people 65 and older, but reservations are necessary. At deadline, all appointments had been filled, but the County is planning for new sites as more shipments arrive.

- Email the document as an attachment to your own email so you always have accessible in your cell-phone.
- (Hurricane plans would include quick access to critical documents/information that you may need for any extended relocation.)
