s I write this article for February, it is only January 8th. The year 2021 has started with a flurry.

We gathered information from the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulations, and Attorneys to assure we are following all requirements.

### **SENIORS VS. CRIME:**

- Extended warranty on vehicle
- Building contractor asks to be paid in full up front
- Grandma (Grandpa) scam Don't volunteer grandson name- says they're in jail, send money
- Phone call virus in computer
- Reader's Digest sweepstakes scam
- Courthouse scam you failed to appear for Jury Duty
- Door to door solicitor Florida Statute requires all door to door solicitors to have a permit.

This park has strict no trespassing/no solicting rules. If it is during regular business hours, and someone knocks on your door, please contact the office at (727) 577-0287 so we can take care of escorting solicitor off of the property. If you have not made an appointment before hand, no one should be knocking on your door.

### **Friendly Reminders:**

Please check in with us at the office when you return to the park so we can adjust your Water Billing. Also, remember to clean up your lot and weed planters. If your home needs to be pressure washed and/or painted, please address this matter shortly upon your return to the Park.

Whenever you, your guests, or contractors need to park out on the street, please follow Community Rules; No parking on the sidewalks. Please do not park near or on corners or close to intersections. We would encourage parking on the same side of the street to avoid traffic having to "zig-zag" to get by, or be completely obstructed. Please remember, do not park in any neighbor's driveway without written permission of the neighbor. Written permission must be on file in the office.

SUBLETTING UNITS: It is the responsibility of the Unit Owners to notify Sunset Palms Office of their intent to lease their Unit. In order to approve the rental, Subtenants must complete the background process. The subtenant must sign in at the Office upon arrival and sign out at the time of expiration of the lease and the departure from the park. The terms of the lease is a minimum period of three (3) months and a maximum of six (6) months.

SLOW DOWN – SLOW DOWN – SLOW DOWN – SLOW DOWN- SLOW DOWN: The speed limit in Sunset Palms is ten (10) M.P.H. for all vehicles. Please also remember for Bicycles, and Golf Carts to turn your lights on early morning and evenings.

EXTERIOR HOME CHANGES: Prior to any work; all exterior changes to your home must be approved on a Request for Approval form, available at the Office. Many projects need a building permit and applications can't be finalized until the permit is obtained. You may call the City at 727-369-5647, or check online at: http://www.pinellas-park.com, for projects requiring a permit.

CAR REGISTRATION: Resident's vehicles must be registered at the Park Office and display a decal indicating the vehicle is approved to be in the community. Please come to the Office to pick up your sticker if you have not already done so.

GOLF CART RESTRICTIONS: Remember that only licensed drivers are allowed to drive golf carts, and you must be at least 16 years of age. Make sure they are not parked on the sidewalks or grass. Golf carts must use lights at night and obey the 10 MPH speed limit.

### Safety Tips:

- Call the police immediately if you witness any suspicious activity at all! Be prepared to give as many details as possible. The Pinellas Park Police non-emergency phone number is 727-369-7864. Call 911 (in dire emergencies.)
- Keep outside lights during hours of darkness, every night.
- Lock your cars. Don't leave anything in your vehicle that you don't want to lose. Never hide a spare set of keys anywhere in your vehicle.
- Keep your outdoor shed locked at all times.
- LOOK OUT FOR ONE ANOTHER.

**LUSH ONLY:** Body waste and toilet paper. It is highly recommended that only one ply toilet paper be used to prevent clogging the toilet.

**DON'T FLUSH:** Tampons- Sanitary Pads – Diapers – Depends – Swiffer Cloths – Dust Cloths – Wet Wipes – Kleenex – Food, etc.

When we flush, the waste goes into a **holding tank** that has two pumps to expel the waste **<u>UP</u> and OUT** into the Pinellas Park sewage system. When any of the above gets flushed, it clogs the pump, overheats it, and burns out the motor.






