
## TRIVIA NIGHT

## THE CURIOSITY CORNER

hattanooga, Tennessee was a strategic railroad center for the south's vital railroad system used for supplies and communication. The Union wanted to isolate and weaken Chattanooga before trying to capture the city. A civilian scout and Union spy named James Andrews stepped forward to pitch a plan to Generals Buell and Mitchel that would help isolate Chattanooga. The railroad lines out of Chattanooga connected many large cities in the northern Confederate states and other strategic cities such as Atlanta, Augusta, Charleston, and Savannah. Damaging or destroying as much of the Western & Atlantic railroad line between Marietta, Georgia and Chattanooga would seriously hamper Confederate troop and supply movements. Both generals embraced the plan and set into motion what would later become known as

"The Great Locomotive Chase."

Twenty-two soldiers, volunteers from an Ohio brigade, and two civilians purchased railroad tickets, and in small groups meandered to Marietta, Georgia, where they would become aware of the plans for this daring raid. Then at around 5 AM on April 12, 1862 they boarded a train as passengers to Chattanooga. Two individuals for unknown reasons failed to board the train. Shortly after departing Marietta the train stopped so passengers and crew could have breakfast. When the crew and passengers were out of sight the raiders quickly separated the engine (named "General"), the coal tender and three boxcars from the rest of the train without raising suspicion. Andrews and three other men climbed aboard the engine and the remainder boarded the three boxcars. Moments later the legitimate crew looked up from their breakfast to the jolting sight of the "General" leaving Big Shanty station without them.

The courage of Andrews and his men was matched by the determination of the "General's" rightful engineer, Jeff Cain. He and two of his crew, in a determined effort to recover the train, ran after the train on foot for two miles to Moon's Station. There they commandeered a handpropelled cart to continue the chase. The Great Locomotive Chase had begun!

The first twenty miles seemed to go according to plan. The saboteurs were confident in the belief that the hard part was behind them, that the rest of the mission should be easy until they returned to the safety of the Union forces in Tennessee. They proceeded with caution, keeping the speed of the locomotive to a normal speed to avoid suspicion. They even had a cover story

to explain their haste through rail stations. Periodically along the route they proceeded to cut telegraph lines, burn bridges, drop timbers across the tracks and destroy parts of the rail line. While passing the Etowah River they made a costly mistake by ignoring an old locomotive on a sidetrack.

Once Cain and his two crewmembers arrived, they quickly commandeered the old locomotive to continue the chase. At Kingston, the raiders were delayed by train traffic. Confident in the belief that no one was aware of their presence, they patiently but nervously waited on a siding, unaware that Cain was pursuing them and closing the distance with each passing minute. Finally, after more than an hour, Andrews' Raiders were able to continue their journey north, just as Cain arrived at the other end of the railyard. The two groups were now just ten minutes apart.

At Kingston, Cain and his crew traded the aging locomotive for better one. However, outside of Kingston, they encountered track that had been torn out and had to abandon it. Refusing to give up, Murphy and Fuller ran 3 miles on foot to Adairsville where they encountered a southbound train. Convincing the engineers of the urgency of the situation, they released the cars from the engine and continued the pursuit running in reverse.

While attempting to damage track north of Calhoon, the Raiders became aware that they were being pursued. They jumped back onto the "General" and pushed the throttle to maximum. Now both locomotives were racing northwards at full steam, the pursuing engine racing backwards, slowly closing the gap. Through the towns of Resaca and Dalton they raced. The Raiders dropped timbers behind them and even cut loose two boxcars in an effort to slow the pursuing locomotive, all attempts failed.

In a last desperate attempt to slow the pursuers, the raiders set fire to the coal tender and remaining box car hoping to burn the covered bridge over the Oostanaula River. Crowding onto the "General" they continued northward and looked back in astonishment as the bridge refused to ignite. One by one they began to jump from the train as they realized the safety of the Union forces was out of reach. Approximately 5 miles from Tennessee, the "General" ran out of steam and the remaining Raiders ran to avoid capture.

In about a week Andrews and all the Raiders, including the two who had failed to board the train, were captured. In Atlanta, James Andrews and seven others were tried for being unlawful combatants and convicted as spies. Andrews was hanged on the 7th of June and the other seven hanged eleven days later. The remaining 14 soldiers were placed in prison camps. The 14 prisoners thinking they had nothing to lose engineered an escape four months later in which eight reached safety. Six were captured and brutally punished.

On March 25, 1863, these six, now ragged, weaken soldiers stood before Secretary of War Edwin Stanton. They had just been released from a P.O.W. camp in a prisoner exchange. The condition of these once brave men moved him, and their story amazing. He decided that these six men for their acts of valor would receive the first Medals of Honor to be awarded in our country's history. The youngest of the six, Jacob Parrott, would receive the first medal. The six recipients by rank:

Ross, Marion A., Sergeant Major, 2d Ohio Infantry, Born in Christiansburg, Ohio Pittenger, William, Sergeant, Company G, 2d Ohio Infantry, Born in Knoxville, Ohio Bensinger, William, Private, Company G, 21st Ohio Infantry, Born in Wayne County, Ohio Buffum,

Eventually all but two members of the raid, Wilson and Shadrack, would receive the Medal of Honor. Despite years of effort by their descendants, military personnel, members of Congress and other influential people these two individuals, for reasons unknown, have not received the medal. Wilson and Shadrack were laid to rest in the Chattanooga National Cemetery, alongside the other six Raiders who were executed in Atlanta.

"National Medal of Honor Day" is now celebrated on March 25th and Chattanooga recognized as the birthplace of the Medal of Honor. All three services now have their own designed Medal of Honor. This medal is not pinned on but worn around the neck of recognized individuals. They become part of a very select group, approx. 3,400 to date, who have demonstrated uncommon valor, at the risk of their lives, above and beyond the call of duty. While most of these medals are given posthumously, a living recipient receives special privileges and compensation as an expression of gratitude for their valor by a grateful nation. These people, as well as all those who have served in an armed conflict, deserve respect from those who can only speculate about their own behavior in similar circumstances.


