### **April in History**

pril 2, 1513 - Spanish explorer Ponce De Leon sighted Florida and claimed it for the Spanish Crown after landing at the site of present day St. Augustine, now the oldest city in the continental U.S.

**April 3, 1860** - In the American West, the Pony Express service began as the first rider departed St. Joseph, Missouri. For \$5 an ounce, letters were delivered 2,000 miles to California within ten days. The famed Pony Express riders each rode from 75 to 100 miles before handing the letters off to the next rider. A total of 190 way stations were located about 15 miles apart. The service lasted less than two years, ending upon the completion of the overland telegraph.

**April 11, 1970** - Apollo 13 was launched from Cape Kennedy at 2:13 p.m. Fifty-six hours into the flight an oxygen tank exploded in the service module. Astronaut John L. Swigert saw a warning light that accompanied the bang and said, "Houston, we've had a problem here." Swigert, James A. Lovell and Fred W. Haise then transferred into the lunar module, using it as a "lifeboat" and began a perilous return trip to Earth, splashing down safely on April 17th.

**April 15, 1912** - In the icy waters off Newfoundland, the luxury liner Titanic with 2,224 persons on board sank at 2:27 a.m. after striking an iceberg just before midnight. Over 1,500 persons drowned while 700 were rescued by the liner Carpathia which arrived about two hours after Titanic went down.

**April 21, 1918** - During World War I, the Red Baron (Manfred von Richtofen) was shot down and killed during the Battle of the Somme. He was credited with 80 kills in less than two years, flying a red Fokker

triplane. British pilots recovered his body and buried him with full military honours. The Royal Air Force credited 24 year old Canadian, Captain A. Roy Brown of Carlton Place, Ontario with the victory...his 10th.

**April 30, 1789** - George Washington became the first U.S. President as he was administered the oath of office on the balcony of Federal Hall at the corner of Wall and Broad Streets in New York City.



#### **OUR HISTORY**

ISSION STATEMENT

What is FMO?

The Federation of Manufactured Home Owners of Florida, Inc., (FMO) is a statewide, consumer advocacy association dedicated to protecting the rights and interests and enriching the lifestyles of manufactured home owners.

Formed in 1962, the FMO has a current membership of approximately 15,000 manufactured home owners. FMO operates with more than 1,000 volunteer officers from around the state who serve members by answering questions, assisting with problems, organizing district meetings and workshops, and linking them to the Board of Directors and the administrative staff at the Largo business office.

In 1962, the St. Petersburg City Council planned to enact an ordinance mandating that mobile home owners install tie-downs, a very expensive proposition then. Peggy Johnstone, upset by the impending mandate, contacted fellow mobile home owners and, on March 26th, 77 communities came together to defeat the ordinance.

The FMO was founded that day with a clear vision in place:

#### Protect the interests of manufactured/mobile home owners in Florida.

#### WHO WE HELP

Because there are all types of manufactured home owners – those that own their home and land, those that rent land, those that live in family communities, just to mention a few – the FMO has diversified to assist homeowners in whatever situations they may find themselves.



#### Vernon Kozemski

#### VERNON KOZEMSKI

#### THIS IS MY STORY AND I'M STICKIN TO IT!!!

Vernon currently lives on Riviera Drive. He and his wife Margaret moved into a unit on Riviera Drive in 2015 and enjoyed all the activities that came with ownership in the community.

They always thought that they would move to Florida permanently, especially after their son's family moved to Tampa in 2003.



He and Margaret were grade-school friends. He would hang around at Margaret's house that included a large garden and a barn where they had kept horses. That was the beginning of their common love for riding, and enjoying rodeo activities.

They were married in Arkansas in 1948. Vernon was trained as a carpenter, and Margaret worked in an office. During those years they spent weekends bull riding (Vernon) and trick riding (Margaret) for various Rodeos around Missouri. In 1951 Vernon entered the Marine Corps, and they moved to Oceanside, California near Camp Pendleton Marine Base. They called a sixteen foot trailer home near the water. He was given duty on the base during the Korean conflict, and that is where their son Walter was born in 1953.

Upon release from duty, they returned to St. Louis to family and friends, picking up where they had left off. After so many years in the construction field as a journeyman carpenter, Vernon started his own company, that became Apollo Pools.
