PINELLAS COUNTY VACCINE INFORMATION

his was posted at: covid19.pinellascounty.org/vaccines/on March 11, 2021. Please review information currently posted as it may have been updated.

Key things to know about getting the vaccine:

Register on the CDR Health Patient Portal, PatientPortalFL.com, or by phone at (844) 770-8548.

Also sign up with a participating pharmacy — their appointments do not go through PatientPortalFL.com.

Monitor for news and notifications about availability.

Note: These Florida residents are now eligible to register for the vaccine at www. patientportalFL.com:

Anyone 65 and older, (with proof of age)

eligible health care workers (with ID),

50 and older sworn law enforcement, firefighters and K-12 school staff (with ID).

Medically vulnerable residents under 65 may also get the vaccine with a physician form at select pharmacies and federal vaccine sites (details below).

Teachers under the age of 50 may schedule their vaccine appointment at Publix, CVS, Walmart or Sam's Club, or may go to the Federal Vaccination Site at the Tampa Greyhound Track.

Vaccine supply is limited, and you must be a full-time or part-time resident to be vaccinated in Florida.






LUAU DANCE

Gateway MHP Rules and Regulations

Pets

- 1. Pet Registration: Every resident pet owner must register any pets with the Community Manager. Only two (2) generally accepted domestic pets which have been approved and registered by the Community Manager and that do not exceed 35 pounds are allowed in the Community. Pets brought into the Park by visitors may be kept overnight only and must be kept in the house. If guests expect to stay longer than one (1) night, out-of-Park arrangements will have to be made for pets.
- 2. Leashes: Pets must be kept inside the home or on a leash with the resident at all times. While the pet is outside, resident shall be responsible for any clean-up needed.
- 3. Collars: Pets must wear necessary registration from the appropriate governmental agency.
- 4. Pet Removal: Any pet not properly registered must be removed from the Community. If the Community Manager finds the conduct of a pet to be dangerous or bothersome to other residents, its registration will be terminated and the pet must be removed. The only exception to this Rule will be those made for animals that provide "seeing eye" or "hearing" assistance.
- 5. Pets are not permitted in the recreational facilities, the laundry area, or the front lake area. Resident's should exercise pets in the picnic area only.
- 6. Cancellation of Pet Privileges: Should pet management become a problem in the Community, the Community Manager reserves the right to refuse admission to all further new and/or replacement pets.

Pinellas County Pet Laws (In Part)

Is there a leash law in Pinellas County?

Yes, the law states, "No dog or cat shall run at large within the county. Any person who possesses, harbors, keeps, or has control or custody of any dog or cat which is running at large shall be in violation, regardless of the knowledge, intent or culpability of the owner."


From Pinellas County Code Chapter 14

*At-large means any dog or cat on the owner's premises which is not within the unobstructed sight and in the control of the owner, or any dog or cat not confined by sufficient means to assure that it is maintained on the property of the owner; or any dog or cat off the owner's premises




which is not controlled by an adequate leash or tether, or otherwise under the owner's physical control, as defined in this section.

*Physical control means the immediate, continuous physical control of a dog or cat at all times, such as by means of a leash, cord, or chain of such strength to restrain the dog or cat; or "physical control" shall also include visual signals or oral commands by the owner of a dog which has been trained to consistently and effectively respond to such signals or commands, if such dog is at all times within the unobstructed sight of the dog's owner.



animals or persons, or substantially interferes with the rights of citizens, other than their owners, to the enjoyment of life or property. The term "public nuisance animal" shall mean and include, but is not limited to, any animal that:




*Sec. 14-61. - Rabies vaccinations and licensing.

- (a) Every person possessing, harboring, keeping, or having control or custody of a dog or cat over the age of four months within the county shall secure a county license from a veterinarian or from the department of animal services and, as a part of such license, shall show proof of a current rabies vaccination which shall have been administered by, or under the supervision of, a veterinarian. Evidence of circulating rabies virus antibodies shall not be used as a substitute for obtaining a license, current vaccination in managing rabies exposure or the need for a booster vaccination.
 - (b)Licenses, either certificate or tag, shall not be transferable from one dog or cat to another.
- (c)Licenses under this article expire in accordance with the following schedule:(1)If a one-year license is issued for a one-year rabies vaccination or a three-year license is issued for a three-year rabies vaccination, licenses expires when the rabies vaccination expire.(2)If a one-year license is issued for a three-ear rabies vaccination, the license expires one year from the date of issuance. The expiration date of licenses for year three shall expire on the date the rabies vaccination expire.(3)All licenses shall be renewed on or before the date of expiration.
- (d)Those persons who relocate their dogs or cats, which are over the age of four months, to the county shall secure a license within 30 days of relocation.

*Sec. 14-63. - Dogs or cats at-large.

(a)No dog or cat shall run at-large within the county, as defined under this article. Any person who possesses, harbors, keeps, or has control or custody of any dog or cat which is running at-large shall be in violation of this article, regardless of the knowledge, intent or culpability of the owner.






