

#### FROM THE MAIN OFFICE

I t's April and time for Mr. Cottontail to make his rounds. I just want him to help me with complaints. I can handle the letters and follow ups, but how about the reporting.

You see, I hear a lot of second-hand complaints and rumors, but don't actually get the eyewitness report. I understand that giving your name and telephone number seems like the person violating the Rules and Regulations would be able to get it. Teakwood Village Management does not give out complainant names so if they find out it generally is because they start asking around and you flinch giving it away that you reported. The reports must be made to the MAIN OFFICE on Commerce Drive. You can fill out a report form that you get from the Sales Office, but they cannot do anything with just a verbal complaint that you won't put your name to, so I respectfully request that you stop making the complaints, just get the form and they will bring it to the Main Office.

A few examples of violations that are talked about, but not properly reported:

- 1. My neighbor has 2 vehicles and when they use the one pulled closest to the shed they park the other on the street and leave it there. This is one of those parking violations, as there is NO on-street parking in Teakwood. Put this in writing with as much info as you can so that Teakwood can verify and get this corrected, yes even if we have to have a vehicle towed.
- 2. My neighbor has 2 dogs and just added another to their home. The pet section rules say no more than 2 pets per home. Put this in writing so we can take care of it.
- 3. My neighbor lets their pet do its business on my lawn and I have asked them not to. Put this in writing as we do not allow anyone to go into your yard without your permission.

There will be a number of things that are not a Rules and Regulations violation, but if you are

not, sure call or text the main office at 727-584-8684 or e-mail at tkwdllf@aol.com to find out if it is a violation. One last thought on things I have heard. If your neighbor uses language that you find offensive, just politely let them know you are offended and if they don't change walk away until you are no longer offended.

- \* Try it! Be in the "Know"!!







3 egg yolks (whites not used)


1/2 c key west lime juice


