ovid19 – go away!!! Here in Lincolnshire, we are happy to report that a large number of our residents have received the covid vaccine. We must thank the office for a quick response to an invitation from Four Seasons Mobile Home park to join their residents along with a few other parks as they hosted a vaccine clinic From the Editor in their clubhouse. Their clubhouse is actually still completely closed



but they opened it up for the health department to host as a vaccine site. We had sign-ups in our own clubhouse starting at coffee hour and going through the day. Over 100 of our residents were able to sign up. Four seasons did not have any idea what they got into. By the end of the day there were over 800 people signed up for about 500 doses. Harold & I volunteered to help out, because the health department forgot to tell them that after the sign ups they would need to call everyone on the list to tell them their appointment times. We called a lot of people who we did not know, often getting no answer or a response from people who said "thanks but I already got another appointment." In the end we were able to add more people to the list from Lincolnshire because of their cancellations.

### COOKING IN LINCOLNSHIRE

ince the pandemic we have not been able to enjoy Pot Luck Dinners, buffets, or any other shared meals here in Lincolnshire. We have our cookbook still for sale, and some new residents might be interested in purchasing one, but without our usual events, we thought it would be nice to share some of the recipes that are in our book, and maybe some that didn't make it at the time of the publication. So we are starting out with a recipe from one of our residents who will be leaving us soon to live with her daughter up north. From Judy Artish – a recipe from the 2019 Lincolnshire Cookbook.

#### FRUIT FILLED CREPES:

Crepes are easier to make than lots of people think. Here we are presenting fresh fruit & cream filled breakfast crepes. A great treat for a leisurely breakfast or brunch.

For the crepes

2 eggs - -  $\frac{3}{4}$  cup mild - -  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup water - - 1 cup flour - - 3 TBS. melted butter

optional - 1 tsp granulated sugar - - 1 tsp vanilla or other flavoring)

For the filling

3 cups of fresh seasonal berries -1 c. softened cream cheese -2 TBS granulated sugar Prepare the cream filling by combining the berries (if strawberries – cut to smaller pieces) cream cheese & sugar and set aside.

Mix ingredients for the crepes except the butter in a blender until smooth. Add the butter & pulse.

Cook the crepes by pouring batter in thin layer in a crepe pan or any flat bottom nonstick large skillet. Cook at medium high heat until firm, flip & cook reverse side until lightly browned. Spread the filling on each individual crepe in a thin layer & roll up. Garnish with whipped topping & additional berries if desired.



DID YOU KNOW? Rental parks without an active HOA never see this sort of information.

y this printing all homeowners would have usually received the yearly notice from the park owner concerning rent, compactor fee and the property tax pass-on charges. The property tax pass-on is allowed by Florida statutes for rental mobile home parks like Lincolnshire. This has been in existence for several years. Each homeowner is responsible for 1/464th of the difference in the property tax paid from the basis year of 2006 until the last year. Our park owner makes the charge to each homeowner once a year in July along with the rental increase. Last year this was deferred until November. Other park owners may blend it into the rental increase or have 12 month installments. The Board does not recommend putting the pass-on tax in our lot rent would oppose that. Property taxes are based on the value of the property (including the land) owned and is assessed by local or municipal governments. Resident owned parks also see increases and those charges are seen in increased maintenance fees. The Board is surprised by the number of new homeowners who have no knowledge of this pass-on tax until they receive the yearly notice. Your Board of Directors ensures that this pass-on is calculated

The Board will also exercise our right by Florida statute to schedule a meeting with the park owner or his representative concerning the rental increase notice, property tax pass-on and other issues deemed important to affected **Members**. This meeting must occur before the rental increase takes effect on July 1st.

The 2020 Annual Meeting took place on February 16th. Sadly attendance was less than expected and no quorum. The Board appreciates those who did come, receive a yearly report from the Board and asked questions.

If you are reading this and are not a Member please take the opportunity to join. Members are paying to keep LHOA in existence and ensure your voice can be heard and also have a vote. The Association strength is in its membership and let's always maintain that. The Board is also a remarkable resource for issues mobile homeowners may have. The Board are all certified as trained and attend other informative meetings.

Board meetings occur monthly, usually the 2nd Sunday of each month and posted in the "Voice" and laundry room. Members are always welcome at Board meetings and raise issues along with recommendations. LHOA follows FL Statute 723 concerning Member rights in all proceedings. Member meetings will resume next December 21st, town-hall style.





If your dog sleeps on their stomach - This position could mean that your pup isn't quite down for the count just yet. "That's their ready position where they can spring forward. Sometimes it's just comfortable—more belly contact with a cool floor, for example—and sometimes it's because your dog wants to be able to jump into action if necessary.



# **VETERAN'S CORNER**

Joe Potter is? The tourists at Disney World are too preoccupied with the majestic Cinderella Castle ahead and the marching band playing "Let It Go" to notice the words in the second-floor window above the candy store. "General Joe's Building Permits, licensed in Florida since '66," it says over the fake business on the Magic Kingdom's Main Street USA. "If you ask anybody that goes to Walt Disney World, who is Joe Potter? ... They won't know much about him, Without



him, there'd be no Disney World." Missing Walt Disney's "Joe" Potter was the force that turned a swampy Florida wetland into the Magic Kingdom. Potter was the architect of Disney World's government, the mastermind behind the hidden tunnel system at the park and the reason why Disney has no mosquito problem today, Lucas said. Potter died at age 83 in 1988 after remaining in Central Florida for the rest of his life post-Disney retirement. In his early 60s, the graying retired U.S. Army general led the construction project to get Disney's land ready to build a theme park. Bulldozers tore through trees, and crews tamed an alligator- and snake-infested swamp of Central Florida. This was an old Florida back then, more rugged, wild and so far away from the well-manicured Disney grounds known today. On a boat ride through the canal, Potter and his team brought a gun because snakes hung from the trees. To make Disney World, something had to be done about Bay Lake. The water was "a dark-brown color which would not be used for swimming because it would turn bleached blond hair brown and white swimming suits would be grey," Potter and his men pumped out 5 million cubic yards of the sand, added well water and cleaned the lake's bottom to turn into a pristine lake. Potter's team also built the 200-acre lagoon by the Polynesian Hotel. A good military man, Potter listened to his commander, Walt Disney who complained how hard it was to maintain the fantasy in Disneyland when garbage dumpsters or employee areas couldn't be completely hidden away. Potter's workaround: Build an underground tunnel system at Florida's Magic Kingdom.

To govern this new kingdom Potter established the plan for Reedy Creek Improvement

District. By 1967, the state officially approved Reedy Creek as its own government, so Disney could have control of building roads, zoning code, and build a power plant, even its own airport if Disney desired one. Potter served as the district's first leader. "We think today Disney is its own self-sufficient community, but that didn't happen overnight, and it certainly didn't happen by itself. Walt had to sign off on all of this, but Joe Potter was the man that he trusted. In the 1960s, Potter's was helping to build New York's World's Fair of 1964, putting him in direct contact with Walt Disney who debuted "It's A Small World," and the Abraham Lincoln animatronic from the future Hall of Presidents. In 1965, as the fair wound down, Walt Disney was quietly acquiring 28,000 acres for something big in Central Florida. He invited Potter to join him. Potter was on board. Disney World hadn't been officially announced yet, so his family kept his new job as a vice president for Walt Disney Productions a secret. "He told us that he had been offered a position by Walt, but he said we can't tell anybody."

Walt Disney's dream was not just to build Florida's version of the Magic Kingdom but also Epcot, a city of the future. Potter worked with him and the architect who designed Disneyland to develop a masterplan for Disney World. The general called Walt Disney a genius, but his boss's health was failing. Potter visited him in the hospital in the final days and remembered Walt Disney laying in his bed pointing up at the hospital ceiling tiles as a blank canvas to explain his vision for Epcot, said Potter's grandson.

His inspiration the build the Magic Kingdom's underground tunnels drew from the locks and dams in the Panama Canal. Potter also knew all about battling pesky mosquitos. "One of his things that he learned from the Panama Canal where people were dying of malaria was if you let water just sit there, you're going to have a problem," Lucas said. "He insisted to Walt, whatever we do, wherever there's water, we got to make sure it's either running off, moving or it's just not sitting there or you're going to have a lot of mosquitoes." Potter made sure that water was always in motion and engineered the buildings' roofs at the Magic Kingdom so water never piled up. His anti-mosquito efforts were natural, too, as he had a say in planting the right flowers that wouldn't collect water and using a garlic spray, undetectable to humans, to repel the bugs. What seemed impossible, building a kingdom in the swamp, was becoming a reality.

**Remembering the General.** Potter wasn't interested in taking any credit for what he did at Disney World. "He clearly could have been a guy who was all about himself, but he was the exact opposite," Potter's mindset: Just get the job done, a can-do attitude that drew Walt to recruit from the military.

Disney has slipped in tributes to Potter over the years. Perhaps the grandest, Disney rechristened one of its three ferries the "Gen. Joe Potter" in 1997. That same year, the Walt Disney Co. inducted Potter posthumously into its Disney Legends hall of fame. And since the Magic Kingdom's opening day, there has always been a General Joe's Building Permits in the window on Main Street USA. Look up above the Main Street Confectionery, on the side facing the flagpole.

# A Nurse's Self Care Toolbox #33

ast month, March, I went over 4 vital steps in using food (sugar.) What we eat, how much we eat, when we eat (a big deal) and movement soon after we have eaten. This month's target is the damage high blood sugars create and testing blood sugar. Medications to mediate the effects of high blood sugar will be in the May edition.

Blood sugar is absolutely needed for life along with oxygen. Our body cells use both to make the energy needed to do their job. The sugar in the blood gets through the cell "door" by insulin, a hormone produced in the



pancreas, which drop kicks the sugar into the cell. A field goal and 3 points millions of times a day everywhere in our body. The blood vessels especially arteries (the smallest pass by each and every body cell) are sensitive to a blood sugar level that stays higher and longer in the blood than usual. Higher blood sugars remaining longer than normal are absolute irritants to the lining the blood vessel. Over time the lining becomes inflamed especially the very small vessels and often becomes "plugged". The blood supply slows and may just stop. That is not good whatsoever! The end result can and usually is damage to vital organs like the eyes, heart, kidneys, arteries in the lower legs, nerves and much more. The hard part to swallow is the damage may not be undetected until the damage has started. Another reason to see our physicians on a regular basis. Not just when we are sick. Did I say that? Yes I did.

Basically there are 2 types of diabetes. Type 1 is where the pancreas ceases to produce insulin or very, very little. Found mostly in young people though can occur when our pancreas becomes severely damaged. Why, teenagers didn't live to middle age before insulin and better monitoring. No cure yet but they take insulin in various ways either continuously by an insulin pump or injections up to 6 times a day. Life expectancy almost quadrupled, wow. Type 2 can be best described as pancreas fatigue or our body cells become insensitive over time. Almost always too much sugar at the wrong times without any upcoming need (movement.) Remember how we were designed, get up, eat, move, eat move and repeat until dusk. Eat a balanced meal!!! Prediabetes is simply a warning that our blood sugars remain elevated but just below graduating to diabetes. You don't want that diploma!

There are 2 basic blood tests for sugar. Yes, blood as that is where we find it. HgbA1c or just "A1c." started about 20 years ago. It measures on a scale of 5 to 16. It is the average "weight" if I can say that of the sugar in the blood over the last 90 days. 5.5 to 6 is normal and the higher the number the higher the average sugar load. Sort of knowing your average driving speed over 90 days. Normal, speeding or reckless. On the spot glucose monitoring with a home meter is exactly what it is, right now. Blood sugars on a monitor should be below 110 starting 2 hours after we have eaten or in the morning before we eat by 8:30 AM. Elevated right after we eat.



Our physicians will tell us when to test, usually fasting (before we put anything and I mean anything in our mouths and swallow) or 2 hours after we have eaten (tells them how we cope with the sugar absorbed from what we have eaten.) People who just test anytime to see what their blood sugar is are wasting a valuable test strip for sure. And will certainly remain confused and frustrated. Next month, medications and treatments. Chew well my friends.
