

MOTHERS DAY

Mother's Day, a holiday in honor of mothers that is celebrated in countries throughout the world. In its modern form the holiday originated in the United States, where it is observed on the second Sunday in May. Many other countries also celebrate the holiday on this date, while some mark the observance at other times of the year. During the middle ages, the custom developed of allowing those who



had moved away to visit their home parishes and their mothers on Laetare Sunday, the fourth Sunday of Lent. This became Mothering Sunday in Britain, where it continued into modern times, although it has largely been replaced by Mother's Day.

Anna Jarvis of Philadelphia, who has had organized woman's groups to promote friendship



and health, originated Mother's Day on May 12, 1907, she held a memorial service at her late mother's church in Grafton West Virginia. Within five years virtually every state was observing the day, and in 1914 U.S. Pres. Woodrow Wilson made it a national holiday. Although Jarvis had promoted the wearing of a white carnation as a tribute to one's mother, the custom developed of wearing a red or pink carnation to represent a living mother or a with

carnation for a mother who was deceased. Over time the day was expanded to include others, such as grandmother's and aunts, who played mothering roles. What had originally been primarily a day of honor became associated with the sending of cards and the giving of gifts. HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY

he Largo Police Department has become the first agency in Florida to use a new communication technology to provide real-time updates on call response times, report status and victim services. SPIDR Tech's cutting-edge technology will provide the Largo Police Department the abil-



ity to provide residents who call into the Largo Communications Center with fully automated follow-up text and e-mail messages. When the Largo Communications Center is contacted, a predetermined message will be sent acknowledging the call for service and advise residents of any delayed response times. In addition, when reports are assigned to a detective, crime victims will be updated on their cases. Victims will be kept apprised of important facts, such as offense-specific information, report numbers and available victim services. Residents will have the opportunity to submit feedback as well. After the initial response has concluded, callers will receive a short, optional, mobile survey that asks questions about overall satisfaction and the professionalism of the Department team member they had contact with. Survey responses will help the department measure customer satisfaction and determine how to better serve the community.

RECIPES

24 chicken wings or drumsticks, ½ cup melted butter, ¼ cup hot pepper sauce, 3 tablespoons vinegar, 1 package Hidden valley ranch salad dressing mix.

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Dip chicken in mixture of melted butter, pepper sauce and vinegar. Put on baking pan and sprinkle with package of dressing mix. Bake for one hour or until brown. Sprinkle with paprika.



FIVE-SPICE APPLE CRISP


