We can't do anything to cure the violation if we don't have the proper evidence. Please work with us. It is a constant source of frustration when we get bits and pieces of a violation, but not the full information so the violation can be taken care of.

Landscapers are on property Wednesdays and Thursdays. Since Wednesday is RECYCLE day, we ask that you put your recycling on your carport and not on the lawn.

HURRICANE SEASON STARTS EARLY THIS YEAR, MAY 15TH.

LEAVING US: Please ensure your property is secured and all items that may become airborne during a severe storm are safely stowed away to prevent damage to your unit or surrounding units. It is important to have someone in the park or the office to have a key to your unit in the event we need to gain access in an emergency or when necessary. The rainy season in Florida typically starts towards the end of May and lasts through October. During this time, heavy rains are likely. Now is a good time to check and clean out your gutters to prevent water runoff from backing up and flooding your roof or running off on the side of the mobile and possibly causing water damage to the interior.

WEEDS/CONDITION OF MOBILE: If you do not make arrangements with someone and the weeds become an issue, or the mobile needs to cleaned, etc., you will receive a letter asking you to correct the violation. If the work does not get done, the resident will be charged a service fee of \$25.00 per hour with a one (1) hour minimum for each time work needs to be done. It is only fair for the residents maintaining their homes & lawns on a year-round basis. Thanks for your cooperation.

FOBS & REMOTE TRANSMITTERS: Your fobs and remote transmitters will be turned off when you check out. If you tell us when you are going to return, we will program the system to activate your fobs/transmitters on that date. If you do not give us a return date, you will need to contact the office prior to your arrival to have your fobs/transmitters activated before you arrive.

PARKING ON THE STREET / SIDEWALKS: Do not park golf carts or cars on the sidewalk. Street parking is only allowed to accommodate carport or unit maintenance. Please do not park directly across from someone else's driveway, as it makes it extremely difficult for them to exit the driveway. Please use common sense and do not park near or on corners or close to intersections. We encourage parking on the same side of the street to avoid traffic having to "zig-zag" to get by, or be completely obstructed.

SPEEDING: Slow Down. The Speed limit in the park is 10 M.P.H. For the safety of all residents and guests in the park, be sure to stop at all stop signs. No one under the age of 16 is ever allowed to operate a golf cart.

PROPER ATTIRE: Please abide by the Park rules requiring men to wear t-shirts or button up shirts and ladies to have cover ups over bathing suits when you leave your property. Also, dry clothing, including shoes, are required when entering the club house.

Please do not, under any circumstances, feed stray animals. While you are trying to do a good thing, you are attracting UNWANTED CRITTERS TO THE PARK, and to your neighbor's properties. **DO NOT FEED STRAY ANIMALS:** Sec. 14-30. - Public Nuisance Feeding Animals: A citation or \$148 fine for a violation of this section may be issued based upon: (4) Placing food or garbage, allowing the placement of food or garbage, or offering food or garbage in such a manner that it attracts cats, dogs, raccoons, coyotes or other wildlife, thereby creating a public nuisance. Telephone number for Animal Control is 727-582-2600.

Safety Tips:

- Call the police immediately if you witness any suspicious activity at all! Be prepared to give as many details as possible. The Pinellas Park Police non-emergency phone number is 727-369-7864. Call 911 (in dire emergencies.)
- Keep outside lights during hours of darkness, every night.
- Lock your cars. Don't leave anything in your vehicle that you don't want to lose. Never hide a spare set of keys anywhere in your vehicle.
- Keep your outdoor shed locked at all times.
- Never open your door to someone you do not know, or solicitors.
- LOOK OUT FOR ONE ANOTHER.

Lift Station Monthly Reminder – Important

LUSH ONLY: Body waste and toilet paper. It is highly recommended that only one ply toilet paper be used to prevent clogging the toilet.

DON'T FLUSH: Tampons- Sanitary Pads – Diapers – Depends – Swiffer Cloths – Dust Cloths – Wet Wipes – Kleenex – Food, etc.

When we flush, the waste goes into a **holding tank** that has two pumps to expel the waste **<u>UP</u> and OUT** into the Pinellas Park sewage system. When any of the above gets flushed, it clogs the pump, overheats it, and burns out the motor.






