 $\mathbf{Y}$  ith our storm season coming up soon, here is some information that may be helpful - On Page 2 of this issue of the Breezes, please find a phone number listing for the following Utilities:

Duke Energy Outage - 1-800-228-8485

Spectrum Outage – 1-855-657-7328 (ask for customer service billing dept)

Water Outage – call Park Manager Office -727-786-6558

To have our community phone directory handy, cut the from page cover off of this issue and tape it inside a kitchen cabinet door, so you'll know where to find it at all times.

Also, please be advised that Southwind Park Manager will send out an email to let residents know when the water is off. If she does not have your email address, you will not be notified. Some residents don't check email daily or have no access to internet. The last time our water was off, I called several neighbors to let them know and they really appreciated it, and called more neighbors to let them know. It seems like we have water shut off far too often then we would like. I called Pinellas County Utilities to find out why this happens so frequently. There is a Palm Harbor Water Main Replacement Project going on this year, BUT it does not include Southwind. Here is what I found at http://www.pinellascounty.org/utilities/projects/old-palmharbor-alt19.htm:

Pinellas County Utilities is replacing approximately 15 blocks of residential water mains in the Old Palm Harbor area neighborhood from Alt US19 (Palm Harbor Boulevard) to Omaha Street and from Delaware Avenue to Nebraska Avenue. The purpose of the project is to improve the water quality, water circulation and public safety by replacing the existing old and deteriorating potable water mains with new high standard pipes and improved potable water network system/safety.

The existing potable water mains are composed of old deteriorating galvanized pipes and very thin substandard Schedule 20 PVC pipes. The new replacement mains shall be 2-inch and

8-inch high density polyethylene (HDPE) and Ductile Iron Pipe (DIP). The work also includes addition of Fire Hydrants for additional public safety and installation of new Au-tomated Meter Reader (AMR) for improve data record keeping.

When Southwind has a water main break, it is the management office's responsibility to notify residents, call a plumber to make repairs, and notify residents if a boil water advisory is in effect (according to Pinellas County Utilities).

There has been some discussion about water quality safety and Boil Water Advisory's. The HOA Board is looking into this issue, but it may help now to review this info below.

Here are common FAQ's from: http://www.pinellascounty.org/utilities/boilwater.html **1. What is the proper way to disinfect my water so that it is safe to drink?** 

- The preferred method of treatment is boiling. Boiling water kills harmful bacteria and parasites (freezing will not disinfect water). Bring water to a full rolling boil for at least 1 minute to kill most infectious organisms (germs). For areas without power, disinfect the tap water by adding 8 drops, about 1/8 teaspoon, of plain unscented household bleach per gallon of water and allow the water to stand for 30 minutes. If the water is cloudy, repeat the procedure. Use a container that has a cap or cover for disinfecting and storing water to be used for drinking. This will prevent contamination. If your well was flooded, boiling the water is the safest action, since disinfection does not kill certain parasites.
- 2. How should I wash my hands during a boil water advisory? Based on the current conditions of the affected public water supplies, vigorous hand washing with soap and your tap water is safe for basic personal hygiene. If you are washing your hands to prepare food, if at all possible, you should use boiled (then cooled) water, disinfected or bottled water with hand washing soap.
- 3. Is potentially contaminated water (where Cryptosporidium is not the significant contaminant) safe for washing dishes or clothes? Yes, if you rinse hand-washed dishes for a minute in a bleach solution (1 tablespoon bleach per gallon of water). Allow dishes to completely air dry. Most household dishwashers do not reach the proper temperature to sanitize dishes. It is safe to wash clothes in tap water.
- 4. Is potentially contaminated water safe for bathing and shaving? The water may be used for showering, baths, shaving and washing, so long as care is taken not to swallow or allow water in eyes or nose or mouth. Children and disabled individuals should have their bath supervised to ensure water is not ingested. The time spent bathing should be minimized. Though the risk of illness is minimal, individuals who have recent surgical wounds, are immune-suppressed, or have a chronic illness may want to consider using bottled or boiled water for cleansing until the advisory is lifted.
- 5. How should I wash fruit and vegetables and make ice? Fruits and vegetables should be washed with boiled (then cooled water) or bottled water or water sanitized with 8 drops (about 1/8 teaspoon) of unscented household bleach per gallon of water. Ice should be made with boiled water, bottled water or sanitized water.
- 6. What if I have already consumed potentially contaminated water? Even if someone has consumed potentially contaminated water from either a public water system or a private well before they were aware of the boil water advisory, the likelihood of becoming ill is low. Anyone experiencing symptoms such as diarrhea, nausea, vomiting, abdominal cramps, with or without fever, should seek medical attention.
