FROM THE OFFICE

This month I would like to talk about what happens what someone dies in the Park, is evicted, or simply leaves the Park their mobile home. Time after time, residents feel free to go into these homes, sheds, carports, etc. and help themselves to what ever they want. **THIS IS STEALING!** Often times the last person leaving is a renter or roommate who has no right to "give" anything away.

What you probably don't understand is the financial aspects of these situations. Usually the Park is owed rent, sometimes in the thousands of dollars. If there is anything of value left in the mobile, it helps me to sell it quicker if it has appliances, beds, furniture, etc. If it is left a pig sty, often there are items maintenance can use, such as rakes, shovels, garden tools, etc. as well as brooms, mops, cleaning products that Patti can use for the Park. This saves Walter money and when he saves, you save by avoiding higher rent increases. If I am able to sell things of value, this money goes toward the lost revenue from that mobile home. Often, I just ask for a donation for the Library fund; a lot of times I just say, "if you can use it, take it".

Before you "help yourself", you need to check with the Office. I am to the point of calling the Police and treating this as theft. If it doesn't belong to you, don't take it!

As of right now, the Pool is still scheduled for July 5th although the demolition might start earlier. I have an appointment next week to pick out tiles so they will be in stock by the time they are needed.

This year's Hurricane Guides are a single piece of paper, English on one side, Spanish on the other. They are available in the office. Please take the time to read it over so you can be prepared if needed.

I have been sending out maintenance letters and will continue to do so, so keep your carports clean, have your mobile washed (once a year per Park rules), keep up on the weeds, and paint as needed. A clean and neat Park reflects on the people who live here.

By now you should know to keep your bikes, cars, doors, etc. locked at all times. Golf carts should be locked, and don't forget about the golf cart chargers. Don't be a "Crime of Opportunity"!

At the last Social Club Meeting it was decided to not do any planning for next season until Oct. 2021 when we will have a better idea of where things stand with Covid-19. The next Social Club Meeting will be Oct. 6th.

I will be out of town May 7th thru 17th, Joelle will be in the office and I can be reached at any time if needed.

STRAY CATS

The problem of stray cats was brought up at my last Manager's meeting. Some information was dropped off to me at the Office, so I am passing it on.

Pinellas County Animal Services (PCAS) has a Trap-Neuter-Vaccinate-Return (TNVR) program, which is the most effective and humane way to reduce the number of community cats and reported nuisance behaviors. In a TNVR program, cats are humanely trapped,



spayed or neutered, vaccinated against rabies, and returned to their community to live out their lives. Because they can no longer breed, the number of cats is reduced naturally over time. Nuisance behaviors are typically reduced immediately and eliminated completely only a month after surgery.

HOME DETERRENTS:.

SMELLS THAT REPEL CATS; To keep cats out of yard or gardens plant the Herb rue or sprinkle dried rue. Tie Irish Spring soap to a bush or tree branch. Citrus or lemon scents, garlic, ammonia, vinegar, coffee grinds, pipe tobacco, citronella, or eucalyptus all deter cars as well. Scents diminish over time, so re-applying is necessary.

NEUTRALIZE ODORS: Odor Ban, Nature's Miracle, Fission and Simple solutions are effective natural enzyme products that eliminate existing odors, such as urine. They are available at pet supply stores or online.

BLOCK OFF ACCESS: Cats seek out dry, warm shelters away from the elements. Block off access to places, such as under the mobile, in which you don't want cats. Make sure no cats are inside before doing so.

WATER: A motion-activated sprinkler, like Scarecrow has an infrared sensor that releases a three-second blast of water when a cat or other large animal approaches. You can find this and similar sprinkler-type repellents online.

SOUND: A motion activated, solar-powered, ultrasonic pest repeller emits a high-pitched sound that repels cats and other animals but can't be heard by humans. Amazon and other online retailers sell such sonic repellents.

DIGGING DETERRENTS: Push chopsticks into potted plants, use pinecones, lava rocks, concrete paver or stones as mulch to prevent cats from digging, Place larger river rocks throughout the gardens or use poultry fencing or landscaping wrap around plants.

BIRDS: If feeding birds, do not over feed. Seed spilled onto the ground brings birds out of the safety of the trees and into a cat's predatory range. Consider planting bushes and trees that naturally attract birds.

RECIPE OF THE MONTH

GOOEY BUTTER CAKE

CRUST:

- 1 PKG (18.25oz.) Plain yellow cake mix.
- 8 Tablespoons (1 stick) butter, melted.
- 1 Large Egg FILLING:
- 1 PKG (8 oz) cream cheese, room temperature
- 2 Large eggs
- 1 Teaspoon Pure Vanilla Extract
- 8 Tablespoons (1 Stick) butter, melted.
- 3 ³/₄ cups powdered sugar, sifted

Directions;

Place rack in center of oven and preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Set aside an ungreased 13 x 9-inch baking pan.

For the crust, Place cake mix, melted butter and egg in large mixing bowl. Blend with electric mixer on low speed for 2 minutes. Stop mixer and scrape down sides of the bowl with a rubber spatula. Batter should come together in a ball. With your fingertips, pat the batter evenly over the bottom of the pan, smoothing it out with your fingers till the top is smooth. Set pan aside.

For the filling, place cream cheese in same mixing bowl that was used to make the crust, and with the same beaters (no need to clean either) blend with an electric mixer on low speed till fluffy, 30 seconds. Stop the mixer and add the eggs, vanilla and melted butter and beat on medium speed for 1 minute. Stop the mixer and add the powdered sugar. Beat on medium speed till sugar is well incorporated, 1 minute more. Stop the mixer and scrape down the sides of the bowl with a rubber spatula. Pour the filling onto the crust and spread with the spatula so that the filling covers the entire surface and reaches the sides of the pan.

Place pan in oven.

Bake the cake until it is well browned, but the center still jiggles when you shake the pan, 45 to 47 minutes. Remove pan from the oven and place on a wire rack to cool, 30 minutes. Cut into squares and serve.

Store this cake, covered in aluminum foil, at room temperature for up to 4 days or in the refrigerator for up to one week, or freeze it, wrapped in foil, for up to 6 months. Thaw the cake overnight in the refrigerator before serving.


