LOCAL CORONA VIRUS AT A GLANCE

year ago at this time the number of confirmed Covid cases in our 33716 Zip Code was still in single digits. The cases now number 1652, that works out to fewer than 5 per day, hardly what can be called a raging epidemic. Our zip code is roughly rectangular bordered by Brighton Bay Blvd to the East; 28th St, which is just beyond I-275 to the west; Ulmerton Road to the north and Gandy Blvd on the south. There are about 435 residents here at Gateway and when we take the time to consider our sister park at Pinewood and the myriad of apartments and condominiums to our east, west and north it would appear we have been quite safe and secure throughout the spread of the illness.

As a 55+ park, Gateway is a 'vulnerable' community and from the beginning of the alarms as to the dangers presented by the virus I noticed that virtually all of us took steps necessary to protect ourselves and friends and neighbors from transmission of any cold or flu, let alone Covid-19. To my knowledge there have been fewer than ½ dozen reported Covid-19 infections here at Gateway and no deaths attributed to the virus.

I wish to extend my thanks to Gateway Homeowners Association President, Debi Johnson, who undertook arranging for the vaccination of over 100 residents on March 23rd. Thanks also to Past President Barb Fuelling and Gateway Activities Organization Steering Committee for their thoughtful considerations in making adjustments to normally scheduled activities in order to provide for the health and safety of the residents.


LADIES DAY




