What is a Special Meeting?

pecial meetings are unscheduled meetings called from time to time by the board for a specific purpose. Special meetings usually address issues that need immediate attention or that need more time and discussion than can be handled in routine board or annual meetings.

There are a couple of things that make special meetings ... well, special. Later this month we will have a Special Membership Meeting to decide on a Material Alteration (moving the mailboxes) and an Amendment to the By-laws (allowing the Board of Directors to negotiate bulk cable and internet services).

First, members must be notified of the exact purpose of the meeting, and the meeting must be limited specifically to achieving this purpose. This is important because people typically decide whether to attend a special meeting based on the issue and how it's being addressed. Therefore, actions taken on issues not listed in the notice will be invalid. In fact, no action can be taken at all, if it was not included in the notice. For example, if the stated purpose of a meeting is "to discuss" a problem, the board cannot actually vote on a solution—at least not in this meeting.

Second, association members—not just the board—can call for a special meeting, if they get a minimum number of signatures on a petition that states exactly what issue or problem they want to address. Homeowners give the petition, with its stated purpose, to a board member who schedules the special meeting. Guidelines for this can be found in chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

Like annual and board meetings, special meetings are open to all association members who wish to attend, and they require a quorum before any business can be conducted. Also, notifying all association members properly is essential; when and how the notice is delivered, what it says, and other requirements must be met.



es, there really is a Social Club in Clearwater Cascade Mobile Home Park. It was incorporated in 1997 and is officially




called Cascade Social Club Inc. The club is governed by

DID YOU KNOW?

H.I.T is an acronym? In the 16th and 17th centuries, everything for export had to be transported by ship. It was also before the invention of commercial fertilizers,



so large shipments of manure were quite common.

It was shipped dry, because in dry form it weighed a lot less than when wet, but once water (at sea) hit it, not only did it become heavier, but the process of fermentation began again, of which a by-product is methane gas. As the stuff was stored below decks in bundles you can see what could (and did) happen. Methane began to build up below decks and the first time someone came below at night with a lantern, BOOOOM!

Several ships were destroyed in this manner before it was determined just what was happening.

After that, the bundles of manure were always stamped with the instruction 'Stow High In Transit' on them, which meant for the sailors to stow it high enough off the lower decks so that any water that came into the hold would not touch this "volatile" cargo and start the production of methane.

Thus evolved the term 'S.H.I.T. (**Stow High In Transit**). "So, it's really not a swear word" which has come down through the centuries and is in use to this very day.
