

Here is one of my favorites from long time resident Dorothy Beishuizen – originally published in our 2008 cookbook.

BREAD PUDDING

1 loaf French Bread crumbled

4 cups milk

2 cups sugar

1 stick melted butter

2 TBSP vanilla flavoring

1 cup coconut

1 cup chopped nuts

1 TBSP cinnamon

3 eggs beaten



Mix all ingredients together and place in a 9 X 13 pan. Bake at 350° for 1 hour 15 min. Serve warm with ice cream or cool whop if desired.





am lucky enough to be one of a group of dogs who were given a thing called "whistle fit." It is (or rather it was) an experimental gadget that attaches to my collar and works like a fit bit that people use. It is connected to my "parents" smart phone, and tells them how long I walk, sleep, play and more. It tracks some interesting health related things that can also be relayed to my vet. I recommend it to anyone who could use something like this to help care for their pet. (Of course since you usually walk with your pet – it will tell you something about your own walking too)



Some news from the whistle fit info page:

Raise your hand if you've ever looked over at your sleeping dog and said, "That cannot be comfortable." Everyone, right?

All dog sleeping positions are adorable in their own way: maybe your pup sprawls across the couch, curls up like a croissant, or somehow ends up on their back with their head tangled up in their paws. It's as impressive as it is endearing.

The Whistle app tracks your dog sleep to let you know the quality and quantity of sleep they're getting each night. But we wanted to find out more about why dogs sleep in the silly positions they get themselves into. It turns out, dog sleeping positions can be just as varied and



unique as your sweet pup. It's often simply a matter of preference. "They're all individuals and they just do what's comfortable"

Here are some of the most common dog sleeping positions you might notice and what they could mean about your pet:



If your dog sleeps on their stomach - This position could mean that your pup isn't quite down for the count just yet. "That's their ready position where they can spring forward. Sometimes it's just comfortable—more belly contact with a cool floor, for example—and sometimes it's because your dog wants to be able to jump into action if necessary.

If your dog sleeps on their side - This position is pretty common for dogs. And just like you may have one side you prefer to sleep on, your pet probably does, too. "Most dogs tend to sleep on one side or another, I think it's just more comfortable for them." However, if your dog suddenly seems to be favoring one side over the other, you might want to make a note of this with your vet. "That could indicate that maybe they're starting to get sore hips or a sore shoulder."

If your dog sleeps on their back - While this is just a comfortable position for some dogs, it's also a nice compliment to your home—because dogs will only do this when they feel very safe. "If you see a dog who sleeps like that, that's not going to be a dog who's timid or afraid,". Instead, that dog feels safe, secure, and protected in their environment.







VETERAN'S CORNER

Il Veterans, their spouses and caregivers can get COVID-19 vaccinations from VA under the SAVE LIVES Act signed into law March 24.

Covered individuals can receive a vaccine from VA due to the ongoing COVID-19

public health emergency. Under the bill, covered individuals are:

- Veterans who are not eligible to enroll in the VA health care system;
- specified Veterans who are eligible for hospital care, medical services, and nursing home care abroad;
- family caregivers approved as providers of personal care services for Veterans under the VA's Program of Comprehensive Assistance for Family Caregivers;
- caregivers of Veterans participating in the VA's Program of General Caregiver Support Services; and
- caregivers of Veterans participating in the VA's Medical Foster Home Program, Bowel and Bladder Program, Home Based Primary Care Program, or Veteran Directed Care Program.
- Civilian Health and Medical Programs of the Department of Veterans Affairs recipients.
- Veteran spouses.

VA must prioritize the vaccination of (1) Veterans enrolled in the VA health care system, (2) Veterans who fail to enroll but receive hospital care and medical services for specified disabilities in their first 12 months of separation from service, and (3) caregivers accompanying such

prioritized Veterans. Additionally, vaccines furnished abroad are authorized to be furnished in a geographic location other than a state regardless of whether vaccines are needed for the treatment of Veterans with a service-connected disability. This includes those participating in a VA rehabilitation program.

Not sure how many of you are aware of a big change in the MRD for your 401k's? You cannot keep retirement funds in your account indefinitely. You generally have



to start taking withdrawals from your IRA, SIMPLE IRA, SEP IRA, or retirement plan account when you reach age 70½. However, changes were made by the Setting Every Community Up for Retirement Enhancement (SECURE) Act which was part of the Further Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2020, P.L. 116-94, signed by the President on December 20, 2019. Due to changes made by the SECURE Act, if your 70th birthday is July 1, 2019 or later, you do not have to take withdrawals until you reach age 72. Roth IRAs do not require withdrawals until after the death of the owner.

Your **required minimum distribution** is the minimum amount you must withdraw from your account each year.

You can withdraw more than the minimum required amount.

Your withdrawals will be included in your taxable income except for any part that was taxed before (your basis) or that can be received tax-free (such as qualified distributions from designated Roth accounts).

A Nurse's Self Care Toolbox #35

ast month we brought this series on diabetes <u>up to</u> current treatments including medications for diabetes. Some people do suffer from low sugar or hypoglycemia. I can discuss that in another article.

Diabetes is a bit like having a toddler living with you. You can't let the child run the house. I will admit to you all that the biggest obstacle to getting and keeping

blood sugar levels where our body was designed cannot be done solely by relying on medications alone. Best analogy I can think of is trying to push a car when it is in reverse. Remember we can eat most anything if good healthy food. The real questions is how much and what am I going to do when the sugar has been absorbed in the blood and circulating to every cell. All diabetic medications need us to help. The results can be phenomenal when we and are medications are working together.

Ok, let's cover the medications. The first and most basic medication helps the pancreas excrete more insulin. Remember insulin kicks the sugar found in the blood in to each and every cell, 24/7. Metformin is the most common. Our pancreas ages and just simply gets tired even without the constant stress of too much sugar. Upside to these medications is more sugar gets to where it belongs and blood sugar drops. There are two downsides, one is we are asking the pancreas who is already tired to work harder and for at least 14 days we feel lousy. Why do we feel lousy? Our blood sugar hasn't been more normal for a long time, maybe years? Our body is simply saying I don't like this even if it is better. Many people stop taking the medication and don't even tell their doctor. Sad but true. I would tell my diabetic patients who just started on oral meds to call me if they initially feel lousy.

The second most common medications not only help the pancreas make more insulin but also help the sugar get into each body cell easier. Many diabetics over several years begin to have problems just getting more sugar from the blood in to each cell. Sort of like becoming insensitive or ignoring the needed sugar. Again many people feel lousy and stop. Sad again.

There are newer medications that slow down the absorption of sugar in the small intestine (remember that is where almost all the sugar in foods we eat gets broken down and absorbed.)

When oral medications along with doing the hard work of what to eat, when to eat and movement to use the sugar seem to fail and the blood sugar remains high, the physician will then use injectable and still the only way to get real insulin. Supplemental insulin either once a day or more often work with oral medications to get the blood sugar down to prevent further damage to our now fragile arteries.

These are, according to the American Diabetic Association the absolute best "Cut Down's": <u>Cut down</u> on sugar; <u>Cut down</u> on processed meat especially salted varieties; <u>Cut down</u> on energy dense, processed food - such as crisps, cakes, biscuits and pastries and finally <u>Cut down</u> on alcohol. Chew well my friends! Next month I will bother you with other concerns you want to know about though never ask.
