I have been asked to pass on several items of concern/information from the Board of Directors.

This has been addressed in the past, however, the Board would like to reiterate that any work that is done on or around the home site must have written permission from the office prior to any work being started. If you do need a permit from the City, we will let you know. Even if you do not need a permit from the City, you still need our construction request form filled out and approved prior to any work being started. We have also seen the 'old' construction request forms coming into the office. We must be using the revised forms. If you turn in an old form, you will be asked to resubmit it on the current form. This request form is to be used for anything and everything that you wish to do. This includes any painting and covers painting driveways.

Parking at the clubhouse has gotten out of control. You must have a parking pass from the office to park. Our rules state 72-hour parking is permitted. Getting "verbal" permission from a Board member does not help the office to know whose vehicle is in the lot and may result in towing if the proper process has not been done. If you do not obtain a pass, we have no way of knowing whose vehicle it is and could have it towed. Please make sure you plan and come



to the office between 9-3 to get your parking pass.

As most of you know by now, the Golden Corral site has been cleaned up. The City of Largo now has a trespass permission in place. If you see anyone up there, please call the Largo PD. They now have the authority to get people out of there.

If you are using the laundry facilities please make sure you are cleaning out the lint traps. The dryers will be very costly to replace if they burn up due to negligence.

If you are planning to have guests, please be reminded that we are a no pet community. If your guests intend to bring an assistance animal with them, they must have first obtained the packet that we send to our attorney for them to be properly vetted and verified that they have in fact an assistance animal. They cannot bring "Fluffy" or "Fido" on vacation with them. You, as the unit owner, are responsible for informing any guest of this rule and obtaining the assistance animal paperwork from the office for them and their medical provider to have filled out and returned to the office. Once the office has official word from our attorneys, we will contact the guest and the unit owner to inform them of the attorney's findings.

If you are using the pool noodles and weights, once you are done with them, make sure you are closing the lids on the storage containers. If not, they will continue to draw bugs. There are holes drilled in the bottoms of these containers to allow the water to drain. We cannot keep emptying them completely out each day to get rid of the bugs.

The security gate installation is making progress. We expect that to be finished by mid-May. Once it is installed you will be given instructions on how to obtain your access code.

Violation letters will be going out in the next few days. I am sending much fewer letters on violations than in the past and **I thank you all for your efforts.** Please remember that even though you may not be here, you still have the obligation to ensure that you are following our rules on the appearance of your home site. The Board will be reviewing this rule and potentially making changes and creating policies to ensure this and other rules are being observed. More will be announced as information becomes available.

Permission was given to SAC to host a pool party in April. Although the Board is aware that you all want to get back to normal as possible, further 'functions' in the clubhouse will not be allowed at this time. The hope is for things to be opened by fall.

We have also repaired the floors in the outdoor restrooms and the pool shower as well. While the floor was in process, it was discovered that walls were damaged, so a facelift was needed. It all looks very nice!







ARE YOU LEAVING THE PARK SOON?

(Use this as a checklist)

o many things need to be done before you close up your home for the summer. Probably the worse job is emptying the refrigerator! Some folks actually leave



their refrigerators plugged in and full of food, just always be mindful that if the power goes off during the summer and items defrost and then refreeze, you should discard everything when you come back in the fall. Better be safe than sorry!

- The second most important thing to remember Be sure to turn off your water.
- Store all outdoor furniture in your shed or porch heavy summer winds can cause items to be blown around.
- Remove fake flowers from your planters they only fade or blow away during hot & windy summer months.
- Take in and store your door mats and park mail pouch. Remove your flag and store away until you come back.
- Be sure to put a change of address/stop delivery with the US Post Office. And tape/tie your mailbox closed.
- If you have the newspaper delivered be sure to call them and give a stop date.
- Store your garbage and recycle buckets in your shed.
- Make arrangements for your planter to be weeded and shrubs trimmed while you are away. Notify the office with the name and phone number of the person/company who will take care of the weeds.
- Give a trusted neighbor a house key and ask them to check on your place once a month. Always good to have someone watching over things while you are away.
- Be sure to lock your windows and doors and shed door.
- Don't leave items like landscape lights or decorative items in your lawn. Difficult for the lawnmowers to mow around such items. Put your landscape lights in the planters looks nice at night in the summer when folks are out on their evening walk.
- Check your awnings now (before you have to leave) and put new fixtures on them if necessary. Be sure to lower and secure them when you leave. We saw what happened when Hurricane Irma came through last fall. It's such an easy way to secure your home and hopefully prevent serious damage.







LITTLE REMINDERS TO SAVE BIG HEADACHES

his is a good time of the year to clean not only your house but your wallet. Place ALL cards from your wallet on a scanner. COPY then flip the same cards over & scan the back. WHY? Because the back side is where all the contact numbers are located....You can't call to report them missing when they have gone missing also!! Be sure to make at least 2 copies & date them. Put at least one copy in a safe place. Recopy and date whenever a change is made.

Next: Make a couple hard copies of all your passwords & date it (redate it whenever you make a change). Put a copy in a secure place that important individuals have access. Yes, there are all



sorts of password vaults out there but things happen. When you may need your sharp memory it abandons you under stress. (There are also several apps to keep your passwords all in one place – check out KeePass).

It was a sad day when a friend's husband died suddenly & she had NO idea to the password to their computer. That meant she had NO access to the bank account or other important accounts!! After a fashion they got some access but she really could have done without the stress.

Changing passwords so you don't use the same one for all accounts can be challenging to remember. Try this: Use the name of the town & zip code you lived in TWO moves ago. When you change it just add a numeral to either the beginning or end. Then change only the numeral when updating. Example: Hoosick12089 to update it Hoosick120891 or 1Hoosick12089. (I've never used any of these).
