reetings Teakwood: First off, the BOD was just as surprised as the rest of the residents about the 90 day notice of the Proposed Rule Change. This is a proper notice in accordance with Section 723,037, Florida Statutes, and Rule 61B-32,002, Florida Administration Code.

The BOD has received complaints and phone calls about the timing of this proposed rule change. They are concerned about contracts they have with renters in the coming months and next year. The Board will be meeting with John on April 12 to discuss this and other issues that have come to the attention of the Board. As you know, the media deadline is the 10th of the month so I will include any information I learn in next month's article.

A couple of the residents said they have contacted their renters and are returning the deposits in the hope they might find other mobile parks that will still rent to them and are hoping to sell their homes in Teakwood before the rush to sell.

I'd like to say that it was great to see the snowbirds that were able to make the trek to Florida this season. It wasn't the typical busy season, but we are glad that the people that wanted to get the COVID vaccination were at least able to do that.

GARDENING NOTES:

o you want to attract butterflies to your garden!? I'm no authority on this subject but I did work at McGow Nature Park and the Botanical Gardens off and on for a year. They both have wonderful butterfly gardens. You can have one too...give it a try.



Two very important things to know before planting. 1) pick the right plant for your garden location. Make sure you have enough sunshine for the plants

you choose and room for your plants to grow & bloom. 2)You will have to learn to NOT use insecticides. The caterpillars you see feeding on plant leaves may be a gorgeous Monarch butterfly in its next life. Using poisonous sprays will also harm the very pollinators you are trying to attract.

Just about any flowering plant is good and will attract some butterflies and other pollinators but here are ones recommended by the University of Florida Extension Service: Milk weed (Butterfly weed), Blue plumbago, Blanket flower (Gaillardia Daisy), Aster, Coneflower, Bahama Cassie and Correopsis will provide nectar and pollen to the butterflies. Coontie, Canna Lilly and Bahama Cassie are good host plants for the caterpillars and larvae. The best colors to attract butterflies are yellow, white, purple and blue; second best are deep red, orange and pink. NOTE: Wilcox Nursery at Indian Rocks Road has Butterfly Bush, also known as false lilac, and other Florida friendly plants that will attract pollinators.

Before starting it would be a good idea to improve the soil by adding organic matter and a little ...continued on page 16



fertilizer. After planting I would use an organic mulch to help conserve moisture and keep weeds down. Organic mulch will eventually break down and add nutrients to your soil.

That's it...you have yourself a butterfly garden! Remember, the right plant in the right place will make for a happy gardener.

NEW SCAM ALERT:

he other day I got an e-mail stating that the Norton Protection for my computer would automatically renew in 24 to 48 hours and that \$350 would be charged to my account. It looked very official with invoice number and all. If I wished to cancel, I was to call



888-207-2799. My first reaction was \$350!!!! Heavens no! I did a reverse phone number look up and it came back that no such number was found in the U.S. I realized that this was probably a scam as my computer Guru does a diagnostic of my PC and renews my subscription to Norton and to Malware once a year. As this was just done in February, I sent him an e-mail just to confirm my suspicions. He assured me there were no other charges than what I had already paid him for the renewals, that I should NOT call the enclosed number and should delete the e-mail. Another recent scam I received was a text on my cell number informing me that my data has been corrupted and that I should tap the link in the text that would take me to a website to correct this problem.

Just by calling the number or responding by e-mail or text you can open up a whole can of worms that can infect your phone and personal data. Scammers are now using legitimate company names like Amazon, FedEx, UPS, Norton and AT&T in an attempt to lure you into responding to their contact by phone, email or text. If you don't remember ordering an item and are not expecting a delivery, go straight to the legitimate Customer Service number on the company's website to make inquiries. If a deal via phone sounds too good to be true, it probably isn't. Always check things out!! Keep your personal data safe.





FROM THE EDITORS - MAY 2021

appy May everyone. The time of new growth with flowers blooming and the lawn green and ready to cut. Time to start planting gardens here in the north and planning summer outings. Well, as much as this pandemic lets us make any plans!

Ontario has been in another lockdown for most of April and could continue well into May with the latest "wave" being the worst we have seen so far. Our numbers recently – cases per million population- are higher than US numbers at their worst. We lag far behind many countries in the percent-



age of population being vaccinated. It's difficult to stay positive in this atmosphere, however it is imperative that we get past that and look to a more promising future.

There are many ways to keep busy and active during this stressful time and we each have to find what works for us. Al and I have taken up new hobbies and continued to participate in some tried and true stuff.

One of the things that we have done was instigated by my niece. Barb has three active, busy kids who weren't able to participate in their usual extra-curricular activities. She came up with a plan that they would keep track of their steps every day, add them all together and start walking across Canada. It was very soon obvious that this was a huge undertaking that they might need some help with, in order to keep the kids interested and engaged. Out went the call to extended family and several of us jumped aboard to help out. A Facebook page was started in order to keep track of totals and have a forum for discussion. We now have a group of 25 or so family and friends who submit their total number of steps per day to push us across Canada. We started at the beginning of January and have walked from Newfoundland to Victoria BC and back to Toronto. A journey of over 12,000 KM. As we walked, one of our members kept track of our daily step totals and converted that to Km. Barb would then put those on the map to determine our location and post interesting facts about the area we had landed in. Members of the group would add what they know about the area and reminisce about experiences etc. I am easily distracted and can be convinced to do something besides walking in the snow or rain. This group has encouraged me to get out almost every day since the beginning of January. Many in the group walk 10 km per day, I am happy to get 4-5 km daily and Al averages around 3km. But its not just about the numbers. Its the support from other members of the group and the interesting facts we've learned about Canada. 1 Tbsp fresh lemon juice


1 tsp chopped fresh parsley
