

Olive's Story

"It's a Wonderful Life."

live Bly was 100 years old on May 16, 2021, and was honored by her daughter, Laurie Bly Young, with a birthday celebration in the Lake Highlander clubhouse. She joined an elite club of Centenarians. They have identified a variety of positive attributes for their longevity, such as not smoking, small body size, diet, regular exercise, avoidance of stress, lifestyle, family connectedness, and a positive attitude toward life. By studying her life, we will learn whether these attributes have been practiced.

She was born on May 16, 1921, the first of three children, to Irish immigrants living in Montreal, Canada. During her childhood, her father needed a job to care for his family, so he left Montreal and headed for Brooklyn, NY, where his brother lived. He found a job as a milkman and an apartment; shortly thereafter the family joined him.

Olive remembers getting teased her first day of school in the U.S. by singing "God Save the Queen" to the school song, "My Country Tis of Thee." She has fond memories of going places with her aunt and uncle -- the circus, Madison Square Garden, Coney Island, and other

points of interest. Olive was active and walked everywhere. Her family had no need for a car.

In high school she was a great student and avid reader. As a senior, Olive strived to achieve the highest scholastic average for a scholarship. One day she was called into the office and told there was good and bad news. She indeed had the highest average, but the scholarship would go to a Jewish student with the highest scholastic average.

After graduation in 1939, Olive accepted a secretarial job with the Avon Corporation, Rockefeller Plaza, where she met many of her closest friends. They attended dances held for active servicemen. It was customary for the young ladies to remain seated until being asked to dance by a serviceman. She talked of the large bands playing music, the dance floors, potted plants encircling the common areas, the gals' nice dresses and servicemen's dress uniforms, and the food and drinks served.

Olive remembers this tall, skinny serviceman approaching her and asking her for a dance. She accepted and after many dances and dates, they were a couple. Ken was in the Coast Guard, stationed at Ellis Island, with the mission of patrolling our Eastern seaboard, keeping it safe from the naval fleets of Axis Power countries. During WWII, Olive remembers using Red Stamps for rationed food -- butter, cheese, fresh meat, bread, and other items. Other than rationing of food, her life changed little during the war. She said that everyone joined the war effort by enlisting in the armed services or going to work producing military goods.

She and Ken were married in 1943. Ken didn't have a trade, so he decided to move the family to West Unity, Ohio, where his father had a farm and auction business. Leaving the bustling city of Brooklyn -- apartment buildings, concrete towers, businesses, roads and bridges, and entertainment opportunities galore -- for a life on a farm was foreign to her. She remembers seeing for the first time -- wide open spaces, cows, pigs, chickens, and other wildlife, crops of corn, soybeans, wheat, orchards of fruit trees and gardens of fresh vegetables. Olive said on her father-in-law's porch was hanging a side of beef. When she tasted the fresh meat, she said it was the best thing she had ever eaten. Ken got three jobs: real estate salesman, auctioneer, and auto insurance representative. When he was auctioneer, Olive served as cashier.

This is where they raised a family of three children. Laurie Bly Young is the youngest of three children. Olive's other daughter, Carol, and son, Bruce, have passed away. She has 9 grandchildren, 16 great-grandchildren, and 2 great-great grandchildren. With his auto insurance job, Ken won many trips abroad. Olive remembers going to Italy, Spain, England, Ireland, Greece, and many other countries. She talks about seeing a balcony Papal address for the faithful. She mentioned his crimson banner was old and tattered and commented that the Papacy should have afforded a better one for his Excellency.

Olive and Ken began wintering in Florida in the late 1970's. In 1980, they bought lot #91 in Lake Highlander. In 1986, they sold #91 and bought #266 where Olive now resides. They became full-time residents in 2002. Olive was active in the Social Club, card games, and sponsored events. Ken played golf and shuffleboard.

In the middle of 1990, a company wanted to purchase Lake Highlander, level and clear out all coaches and erect condominiums. Olive and Ken and the residents of 293 coaches fought against that. The residents of 24 coaches formed a group, called Pioneers. They worked long



hours coming up with a plan to purchase the Park. They faced rent increases averaging 8% per year over the past few years, said Luke Rhoad, resident and president of the Park Corporation. In late August 1990 the residents were given another chance to buy the park; the price had dropped to \$6.8 million, with closing costs the deal escalated to \$7.1 million.

Convincing enough residents to invest \$24,000 into the corporation was the hard part. For that, each resident would get a share of stock in the corporation. The corporation convinced 113 residents—roughly 40%--to buy. The corporation collected \$1.7 million for the down payment. Those who did not purchase a share would continue to pay rent to the corporation. It was expected the other residents would buy into park now that the deal was done. Rhoad's said there were plans to improve the park's infrastructure, saying "We expect to make this the jewel of Pinellas County." Today Lake Highlander Mobile Home Park is 100% resident owned.

Olive's husband, Ken, passed away in 2010 after 67 years of marriage. True to her indomitable spirit, she soldiered on and continues her happy life surrounded by her family and friends. Surviving COVID 19 was hard but Olive stayed busy reading three or more books a week. Laurie and her family visited often--having sit-down meals, playing games, and taking car and golf cart rides.

After reviewing Olive's story, we can conclude her longevity is connected to the positive attributes mentioned in the opening. Olive feels walking is the one healthy habit that is the key to her long life. She is a treasure to be honored every day. An anonymous quote best sums up her life, "A life doesn't have to be perfect to be wonderful."

SAVING WATER TIPS

Te all know that saving water is important on a worldwide basis. Following are simple ways for us all to help save water in the kitchen, bath and laundry:

Kitchen:

- Operate the dishwasher ONLY when you have a full load.
- Scrape, don't rinse, your dishes before loading.
- Buy a water-efficient dishwasher.
- Use garbage disposal sparingly and compost your waste instead.
- Store drinking water in the fridge instead of running the tap while waiting for the water to get cold.
- Thaw frozen food in the fridge or microwave rather than under running water.
- When washing dishes by hand, avoid letting the water run continuously. Instead fill one sink or basin with soapy water and fill the rinsing sink to 1/3 or 1/2 full.

Bathroom:

- Take showers that are 5 minutes or less.
- Don't let the water run when brushing teeth and shaving.
- Turn off water in shower after you are wet and while lathering up or shaving legs, then turn shower back on to rinse off.
- Avoid using hot water when cold water will do.
- Use less water for bathing. Close the drain first and then fill the tub only 1/3 full. The initial burst of cold water will be warmed by the hot water as the tub fills.
- Flush less remember the toilet is not an ashtray or wastebasket. If you still have an older toilet that uses multiple gallons, put a brick in the tank so it uses less water.

Laundry:

- If your washer has a variable setting for water volume, set it for the least amount required per load.
- Operate the washer with full loads only if the load size cannot be set.
- Use the shortest wash cycle for lightly soiled loads since normal and permanent press wash cycles use more water.
- Check hoses regularly for leaks.
- Pretreat stains to avoid rewashing.






