

appy Father's Day – June 20th, Happy Father's Day! MANAGER On April 24th, 1972, President Nixon officially making Father's Day La federal holiday celebrated on the third Sunday in June. It honors all fathers, grandfathers, great-grandfathers, and father figures for their contributions. Hurricane Season - Hurricane Season begins June 1st and lasts through

November 30th. As a reminder, all mobile home residents are required to evacuate. Emergency services will not respond to calls when wind speed reaches 35 mph. If you need assistance evacuating, we have Special Needs forms in the office. To view a short video on what the worst would happen if a hurricane hit Pinellas County, type Hurricane Phoenix 2.0 into your internet browser. This video is a simulation, it will certainly make you think!

<u>Spectrum Cable & Internet</u> – As you probably know by now, a majority of the members have voted to give the board of directors the authority to negotiate a bulk communication agreement. In a few months Spectrum will begin replacing the underground cabling throughout the community. The start process will take a few months. All residents will be provided with



a high-definition cable box and a DVR box.

<u>Mailboxes</u> – New mailboxes will be installed at the laundry facilities. The postal worker will continue delivering mail to the old mailbox kiosks until the new mailboxes are delivered and installed at the laundries. Once the new ones are in place, the old buildings will be demolished.

<u>Canal Committee</u> – We have a newly formed Ad Hoc Committee that will be researching options on how to prevent more erosion along the canal.

Safety Mirrors – Four traffic mirrors have been installed around the community in areas where it was hard to see on-coming vehicles. These make it easier for drivers to see residents walking or biking.

<u>Sidewalks & Walkways</u> – Showcase Concrete Coatings did a great job; our walkways and sidewalks look beautiful, what a difference.


<u>Butterfly Garden</u> – Our beautiful butterfly garden in front of the business office is attracting lots of butterflies; they make me smile when I walk by. According to an article in the Tampa Bay Times, entitled "If you plant it, they will come," butterflies are specific to their host plants to lay eggs for their caterpillars. The type of plant depends on what type of butterfly you want to attract. For example, to attract monarch butterflies, you only need one milkweed plant and one larger flowering nectar plant to start. This can be done in one pot, placed outside. A suggestion for the flowering plant is Tropical Sage, especially the red ones. The article goes on to say, if you plant them, the monarchs will find you with no effort on your part.

<u>Thank you</u> – I want to thank Debbie Creighton, Chair of the Communication Committee, Karl Miller, Marcia Manzi, Theresa Parsons, Connie Luka, Maggie Holt, and Mary Yale for helping to remind residents to complete and return their proxies last month. 

Reaching Others When Disasters Strike

The first thing many of us do during or immediately following a natural disaster is to call family and friends. Unfortunately, in the minutes and hours after a disaster, overloaded cell phone networks can make it difficult—if not impossible—to reach others. While there is no guarantee, the following tips can increase your chances of getting through when it matters most.



- * Even if you have a traditional landline, keep a corded phone in your home. It will work even if you lose power.
- * Keep a list of emergency phone numbers in your cell phone and near your home phone.
- * Prepare a family contact sheet with at least one out-of-town person who can serve as your family's emergency contact. Often, it's easier to make long distance rather than local calls during an emergency.
- * Have charged batteries and car phone chargers for back-up power.
- * Subscribe to text alert services from local or state governments and schools to receive emergency alerts.
- * Use text messaging, e-mail or social networks such as Facebook and Twitter instead of making calls on your cell phone. Texts and e-mails are less likely to experience network congestion. You can use social media to let family and friends know you're okay.
- * Keep phone calls brief to avoid tying up voice networks.
- * Conserve your cell phone battery by reducing screen brightness and closing apps you are not using.
- * Limit streaming videos, downloading music or playing video games on cell phones after a disaster to help emergency calls get through to 911.
- * Call 911 only if you have a life-threatening emergency.
