BOARD BUSINESS and UPDATES

TREASURER, Infrastructure, Roads and Grounds Al Hartin

I just want to remind everyone about the changes the Community voted for at the Annual Meeting in December about the Monthly Assessments (maintenance fees). Listed below is the revised version of Section#13 of our By-Laws:

"Regular monthly assessments shall be paid in advance on the first day of each month. If payment is not received within fifteen (15) days after the due date, a late fee of \$25.00 will be charged in addition to interest in the maximum amount permitted by law. If payment has not been received within ninety (90) days from the original due date the Association will proceed with collection efforts in accordance with Section 718.116 of the Florida Statutes".

This policy will be enforced beginning July 1, 2021.
