e have 19 volunteers working on 3 committees to better serve all the residents of Paradise Island and maintain the financial strength of our community. Each month, committee chairs will bring reports and recommendations to the full board for discussion and approval as needed.

- 1. The Finance Committee is auditing all policies and procedures that are considered business related. All files are being reviewed and organized. Gary Jira, chair.
- 2. The Operations / Infrastructure Committee has been continually active in investigating the short- and long-term infrastructure needs in our community. Priorities are being considered utilizing the Reserve Study that is in the process of being finalized. Roz La Rocco, Chair. The Sunstar FirstCare Ambulance Membership Plan

The Sunstar FirstCare Ambulance Membership Plan is not an insurance plan. It is a Pinellas County government program that works with an individual's (or family's) insurance plan to cover 100 percent of expenses

associated with deductibles and copayments and 50% of cost for Medically Necessary transports denied for non-covered charges by your insurance plan.

Sunstar FirstCare Ambulance Membership Plan Quick Facts:

- Eligibility: The Plan covers medically necessary ambulance transports within the Pinellas County "locality" by Sunstar ambulance units only. The Membership does not cover transports via Sunstar's Mental Health Transport Van. The Family Membership Plan covers family members related by blood, adoption, marriage, or domestic partnership who permanently reside in the same household as the primary member.
- Coverage: If you have insurance, membership will cover the costs that would typically be your responsibility, such as deductibles and/or copays. The membership plan may cover 50 percent of the cost for medically necessary trips denied for non-covered charges by the insurance company. If plan members are uninsured, they receive a 20 percent discount on medically necessary ambulance transportation services.
- Annual Fees: Annual membership fees are \$75 for a single membership; \$114 for a family membership. The average cost of an emergency ambulance transport is \$780.
- No membership cards required
- Coverage period:

New member coverage: Completed applications with payment in full, received prior to the end of the calendar year, will be effective on January 1st. Completed applications with payment in full received after January 1st will be effective on the postmark date.

Renewal member coverage: Completed applications with payment in full, will be effective April 1st. Renewal applications must have a postmark date prior to April 1st in order to avoid an interruption of coverage.



All memberships expire on March 31st of the following year. Members whose applications/ payments are received postmarked after March 31st will not have coverage for a full 12-month period. Membership fees will not be pro-rated.

Concern Reports

oncern Reports are a confidential tool for bringing specific concerns to the attention of the Community Manager. Concern Reports are for communicating maintenance needs around the community such as trip hazards, street lights that are not working, signs that are down, etc. Another purpose of the Concern Reports is to report rule violations that are evi-



denced such as parking on the street overnight without a parking permit sticker, persons living at the address without going through the proper background check or registering at the Co-Op office, a home having mildew on the siding, etc.

Concern Reports are not to be used for neighbor disputes. The Co-Op has no remedy for neighbor disputes. If the issue does not violate a rule or any other established guideline, the Board nor Management has any enforcement capabilities. Neighbor disputes need to be addressed between neighbors in a civil and mature manner.

Concern reports may be submitted by a form located in the office or email the reason for your concern to pimanager@ParadiseIslandLargo.com.

Confidentiality will be maintained for all Concerns brought to the attention of the Community Manager. Receipt will be acknowledged at the time of submission. Specific actions taken will not be communicated. Be assured that steps are taken with appropriate timelines provided for remediation. Working together, we can preserve, protect, and enhance the common elements of our community.

One Source

R esource Property Management provides to all Paradise Island residents a web-based management system called One Source. This system allows you to access valuable and timely information regarding the community and provides a 24/7 access point for maintenance requests, account information and important communications.

As a first-time user you will need the Security Key provided in a letter sent to each resident last summer. If you do not have this letter, please contact Miriam at the Co-Op office 727-535-2172. She will be able to provide for you a copy of the letter with the Security Key.

To log on, go to <u>http://www.resourcepropertymgmt.com/</u> and click on the "One Source Login" link in the upper center of the screen. Each time you log in, the Username will be your e-mail address and the password will be the password used while creating your account for the first time. As a first-time user, you will need to select "Register Your Account".

Please note that all information loaded into the system is stored at a secure data center with multiple back-up systems. We hope that you will find this system useful and encourage you to become familiar with the functions available. Please take advantage of this service as an additional means of communication.



Birdsong

dentifying birds by sound can be daunting, especially for beginning birders, but one way to make the learning curve a little less steep is to use mnemonic devices. These are fun phrases that sound a bit like bird calls and songs, and that are simple and easy to memorize. Here are some mnemonics that can help get you started.

Carolina Chickadee: "Chickadee-dee-dee" Tufted Titmouse: "Peter peter peter" Carolina Wren: "Tea kettle tea kettle tea kettle" American Robin: "Cheerup, cheerily, cheerily" Eastern Towhee: "Drink your teaaaaa" Eastern Wood Pewee: "Pee-o-wee" Red-headed Woodpecker: "Kweer, kweer" Northern Parula Warbler: "Zeeeee-up" Black-and-white Warbler: "Wheezy, wheezy, wheezy" Northern Bobwhite: "Bob-white"



There are other tips and tricks you can use as well. Make sure to listen to cues, such as whether songs are ascending or descending in pitch, and listen for repeated elements. Northern Mockingbirds and Brown Thrashers, for example, have a wide repertoire of complicated phrases but thrashers always repeat each phrase twice while mockingbirds repeat three or more times. You can also find bird sounds online in the species profiles on Cornell's <u>All About Birds</u> site.

VETERAN'S CORNER

ow many of you would like to learn to play guitar? Established in 2007, Guitars for Vets, a non-profit organization, came together when Marine Corps Veteran Dan Van Buskirk took months of guitar lessons from Patrick Nettesheim. Through their lessons, Van Buskirk was able to learn to play the guitar and since then, the two became

friends. Both realized that these lessons created an outlet for expression as well as provided a positive interaction. Together they went to the Clement J. Zablocki VA Medical Center in Milwaukee, Wisconsin to share their story. Since then, Guitars for Vets, or G4V, has expanded to be operating out of 110 VA chapters in 40 states. The G4V guitar instruction program can help Veterans working through physical injuries, post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) and other forms of emotional distress. Music therapy is an evidence-based clinical treatment designed to help Veterans through music. The therapy can help improve Veterans' communication, coordination and interpersonal skills. Nettesheim also developed the G4V "four-way path," which consists of Patience, Acceptance, Gratitude and Empathy (PAGE). These are the guiding principles used throughout the program. The G4V program starts with a 10-week instruction period. During this time Veterans are given one-on-one individualized lessons. They promote teaching the music that appeals to the student and works at the students' pace. After completing the lessons, the graduation process involves receiving a free acoustic guitar and guitar accessory kit. The next step is to continue practicing and learning. Each month there are group sessions organized by one of the 110 chapters and growing. The group sessions develop a community of fellow Veterans and guitarist. To date, GV4 has provided over 4,000 guitars to Veterans. Enrollment in G4V requires a referral from a case or social worker to a local VA office that offers a G4V program. G4V does not control admission into the program. To find a local chapter they offer a locator tool on their site https://guitars4vets.org/about-us/find-a-chapter/.

Users will be able to access information about VA benefits and services through a single site rather than through multiple locations. All benefits-related features previously located in the eBenefits web portal will be available on VA.gov. Veterans are encouraged to start logging into the site using their current Digital Service (DS) Logon or creating a new account using ID.me. "VA.gov offers Veterans an enhanced site in terms of usability and security with the implementation of two-factor authentication," said Acting VA Under Secretary for Benefits Thomas Murphy. "The most frequently used features are now readily accessible on one website to include the ability to file a disability claim, check the status of a claim or change direct deposit and payment history." The eBenefits site will remain functional through March 31, 2022, to give Veterans an opportunity to complete claims started on the platform. Thereafter, VA.gov becomes the single source solution to access VA benefit and service information online. U.S. Digital Service worked with thousands of Veterans to test the new and improved VA.gov. The department wanted to ensure Veterans deemed the site functional before migrating Veterans' data.




